

### **ABOUT**

Long before its reputation as a glamorous ski town for the world's jet-set, Aspen's origins trace back to the Victorian era. The town's remote location is deep in frontier country, nearly 8,000 feet in altitude and nestled between the Rockies' Sawatch and Elk mountain ranges. Originally a silver camp, this former mining outpost was named after the abundant Aspen trees surrounding it. Synonymous with savage beauty, immersive mountain views, and virgin forests, its remote location inspired America's counterculture. John Denver and Hunter S. Thompson are among the town's former residents. Hedonism is baked into the DNA of this charming mountain town.

Four mountains dominate the terrain of the glamorous Snowmass ski resort. The town's exhaustive winter recreation options, from cross country skiing to hot air ballooning, are the perfect counterpoint to a blossoming culinary, and apres-ski dining scene. Aspen has become one of the leading luxury mountain resort towns, its ethereal magnetic energy dazzling the world's elite for more than three decades. Today, the name alone carries the same caché as Malibu, the Hamptons or lbiza as a premier getaway destination. Summer is known to offer as much adrenaline-pumping excitement as winter. Everything from rafting, hiking, biking, fishing, golf, and horseback riding is available for your pleasure, while Aspen's extensive cultural identity keeps things fresh and exciting year round. Guests come for the natural beauty and stay for the town's charms, a laid-back ambiance, and thriving arts and wellness scenes.






From the "Rodeo Drive" upscale shopping of the downtown core, to the charming Victorian–era homes of the West End, Aspen's neighborhoods abound with a distinct personality. Victorian throwback architecture in the historic downtown offers a glimpse into the Elk Mountains' storied mining–boom era. Equally embraced by the majestic Rockies, each area speaks to a different take on natural beauty, the divine surroundings inspiring some of the country's most exorbitant villas and residences. With a mix of updated Victorian mining cabins in Aspen's eclectic West End, the city's past merges into its future. Outside downtown, in greater Pitkin County, larger custom homes loom amid the wilderness on greater parcels of land offering expansive mountain views. Cattle and hay ranches neighbor "gentleman" and lifestyle ranches within a short and scenic drive of this former frontier town's historic core. Aspen's neighborhoods strive to surpass a new type of frontier, – that of luxury residential living.






Aspen Highlands is actually a range of mountains. The Highlands has some of Colorado's best steep, big-mountain skiing in the Highland Bowl, Olympic Bowl and Steeplechase. Visitors love the sense of discovery at every turn: uncrowded cruisers, long and challenging steeps, and untracked sections in the bowls. The Highlands isn't just for expert skiers. Check out the mid-mountain beginner and intermediate terrain and the lower mountain steeps.






The downtown area of Aspen is full of high-end shops like Gucci and Prada. It's also replete with restaurants, art galleries, quaint cafes all fronting beautiful red and black brick sidewalks. Spend a lovely afternoon shopping for the finer things in life. It's also a great place to hike up the Smuggler Mountain Mine Trail. With all this going for it, the downtown area is the ideal place to lay down roots while in Aspen.






Aspen's East End neighborhood is a smorgasbord of new huge homes, scattered housing projects for locals, and older condos. The views of Aspen Mountain from the East End are impeccable and Snyder Park, in the heart of the neighborhood, complete with waterfalls and a tiny jungle gym, is a veritable paradise for kids and picnickers. If you enjoy riding a bike, downtown is just a quick spin away.





Red Mountain is an island of mansions perched on a hill above Aspen. Red Mountain Road winds up the mountain, with roads leading off the main drag to gated communities of palatial estates with jaw-dropping views of the area. Low-end homes on Red Mountain will fetch in the neighborhood of \$7-8 million, while high-end homes can command more than \$20 million.





With air as clear as fine crystal, perfect temperatures and incomparable beauty, it's no wonder people keep returning to Snowmass. It's one of those mountain towns that not only heartily receives visitors in the winter months, but also in summer; especially if you're seeking rugged-but-luxe experiences like hiking, mountain biking, fly fishing, horseback riding and water rafting.




#### **STARWOOD**

Starwood is one of the only private home developments in Aspen offering 24-hour gated security. Spread out across a high mesa just less than three miles northwest of Aspen, Starwood encompasses 960 acres of some of the most stunning Colorado ranchland ever to be bought, subdivided, and sold. Starwood residents have run the gamut from actors to musicians to athletes to media moguls, best-selling authors, film producers and highly successful business people. Today, the mix also includes second homeowners, retirees, a few long-time locals, young families, newcomers to the valley, and even some returnees who grew up in Aspen but settled elsewhere after college.




#### **WEST END**

This area of Aspen is full of beauty and charm. Victorian homes sit on perfectly manicured lawns. At one time it was alive with kids, parents mowing lawns, cocktail parties and picnics. Today, most of the homes are owned by those who live there only a few weeks a year. The West End is also home to the Aspen Institute and the Aspen Music Festival and School. The institute holds a world-renowned Ideas Fest every July, attracting a plethora of dignitaries and royalty, and the music festival is a nine-week classical program each summer attracting music lovers of all ages.





- 4. Buttermilk






Aspen Highlands is noted for some of the steepest inbound terrains in North America, making it particularly attractive for advanced skiers seeking adrenaline-pumping steeps and bumps. Three high-speed quadruple chairlifts service 131 runs spread across 790 acres of skiable terrain. Highlands are blessed with generous snowfall reaching up to 300 inches annually.





Aspen Mountain, formerly known as Ajax, is a local favorite. Its exceptional 673 acres of terrain is a delight for intermediate and expert skiers. No friend of the beginner, the notoriously difficult runs of Aspen mountain were the site of the world's most extended ski lift in 1947. The iconic Silver Queen gondola services the mountain bringing skiers directly from downtown to the slopes. Elevated at 11,212 feet, awe-inspiring views of the town and the Elk mountains abound from the summit.





The largest of the four mountains, Snowmass also offers the longest top-to-bottom run in the U.S. spanning a whopping 5.3 miles of terrain. Eighty-four runs are featured on more than 3,000 skiable acres. Defined by a family-friendly ambiance, Snowmass features everything from groomed cruiser runs to extreme terrain in generous quantities. Snowmass Village provides world-class amenities, dining, and lodging and is only 12 miles from Aspen.



#### **BUTTERMILK**

Known as the beginner's paradise, Buttermilk is the go-to for novices to intermediate skiers and snowboarders. This reputation has made Buttermilk compete with Snowmass despite occupying a mere 420 acres of skiable terrain. Popularized by ESPN's Winter X games, this mountain hosts some of the best terrain park features in the country, from the beginner Panda Pipe to the notorious X Games Superpipe. The Cliffhouse restaurant on the summit is a delectable feature of this peak.






Fifty years ago, it would be unthinkable that Aspen would become a global culinary hub. Yet today, its boxy boomtown facades and Victorian–era homes reveal some of the country's most reputable dining establishments. Acting as a lightning rod for the nation's most celebrated chefs, Aspen has become an unlikely incubator of the culinary arts; look no further than the annual Food and Wine Classic held every September! Creative fervor overshadows geographic limitations, with the town famous for world–class seafood, Mediterranean, and Asian fusion restaurants. Motivated by the appetites of some of the most distinguished globetrotting guests and the curiosity of locals, more than 80 restaurants operate in the downtown core alone. Aspen is just as much of a culinary capital as it is a ski town.

### **BETULA ASPEN | FRENCH**

Betula ia newer endeavor of French chef Laurent Cantineaux and Venezuelan architect and restaurateur Juan Carlos Pérez Febres. The restaurant offers French Pan-American cuisine with rotisserie dishes – a delectable combination mastered flawlessly by Cantineaux himself. This well-regarded chef has made a name for himself over decades via innovative cuisine crafted with French techniques and American experiences.






Clark's Aspen is the second location of McGuire Moorman's popular neighborhood oyster bar set in the historic and beloved former Little Annie's location. The Clark's team has worked to uphold much of the charm of the previous establishment including fully restoring its oak bar. Clark's also features a bustling open kitchen and alpine version of its dock-side aesthetic.



#### **CHEFS CLUB ASPEN | INTERNATIONAL**

Chefs Club at The St. Regis Aspen Resort is a beautifully-appointed space dominated by an open kitchen and an air of winter-wonderland chic. This restaurant group features some of the world's best chefs in four iconic locations. Chefs spend between three and six months at each restaurant, completely taking over the space and menu. Chefs Club is a culinary infrastructure provider offering chefs the opportunity to operate their own restaurant without any of the usual obstacles, so menus are continually changing.





Element 47 is Aspen's finest spot to wine, dine and unwind. Tucked inside The Little Nell, Element 47 serves Colorado contemporary cuisine emphasizing local Wagyu beef, house-made pastas and seasonal produce. The name Element 47 pays tribute to silver, the precious metal that first put Aspen on the map.



#### FRENCH ALPINE BISTRO | INTERNATIONAL

The romantic ambiance of French Alpine Bistro has put the restaurant into the top five best romantic restaurants in the U.S. as voted by the Food Network. Family heirlooms adorn the walls, while soft sheepskins cover the comfy chairs. A heated patio and a street–level lounge invite guests to relax with a glass of wine while taking in the spectacular mountain views. Signature dishes include their version of steak tartare and terrine de foie gras.








#### WILD FIG | MEDITERRANEAN

Fundamental in providing the Aspen Idea, Industrialist Walter Paepcke foresaw a vision of Aspen becoming a bastion of arts and culture in North America. Today haute cuisine, art galleries, cultural institutions, and music schools provide the lifeblood of a small city acting well beyond its size as a transnational hub of expression. Winter is reserved for the slopes, while milder weather beckons a full itinerary of festivals, workshops, and conferences often hosting the world's brightest minds.

The Aspen Art Museum (AAM) was founded in 1979. It's a non-collecting museum and presents the newest offerings in international contemporary art. AAM's mission is to offer timely exhibitions, education, public programs, and immersive activities to engage audiences in thought-provoking experiences of art, culture and society. AAM has a café for you to grab a bite and a beverage after pondering all those works of art.





The Aspen Music Festival and School is regarded as one of the top classical music festivals in the U.S., noted for its concert programming and its musical training of primarily young adult music students. The eight-week summer season includes classical music events, solo and chamber music performances, fully-staged opera productions, master classes, lectures, and children's programming.





The Baldwin Gallery has been touted as one of the finest galleries in Aspen and is on par with the most esteemed galleries and museums in major cities such as New York, Los Angeles and San Francisco and is also very well-respected in international art circles. Located in downtown Aspen, the gallery represents artists like Will Cotton, Eric Fischl, Robert Mapplethorpe, Marilyn Minter, Tom Sachs, and James Turrell. It is a favorite spot for skiers, socialites, and art aficionados alike.





Before Aspen became well-known for its skiing, people flocked to the mountains here to mine silver. Before it was filled with trendy shops, luxury hotels and expensive homes, the Roaring Fork Valley was riddled with ranches. Both mines and ranches have all but disappeared, but visitors can get a glimpse of those eras at the Holden/Marolt Mining and Ranching Museum.



#### **MARIANNE BOESKY GALLERY**

The Marianne Boesky Gallery (Marianne Boesky is a well-known art dealer) represents and supports the work of contemporary international artists of all media. Among those artists whose early careers were supported by the gallery are Lisa Yuskavage, Sarah Sze, Takashi Murakami, Yoshitomo Nara, and Barnaby Furnas. With a gallery already established in New York, a 3,000-square-foot space in Aspen was opened in 2017. You're sure to find just the right piece to add to your collection.






Aspen is a mountain destination loved and known around the world for its stunning scenic offerings, world-class skiing, and year-round events. Immersed in unspoiled alpine splendor, Aspen offers the sort of outdoor events you'd expect from a beautiful mountain town alongside the type of culturally progressive festivals and gatherings that are usually associated with major cities. Thus, Aspen and the surrounding ski resorts serve up a thrilling roster of races, concerts, parties and other events — each drawing spectacular crowds and rave reviews.



#### **ASPEN SNOWMASS FREESKIING OPEN**

The Rev Tour at the Snowmass Open focuses on freeskiing athletes between the ages of 13–19. Top competitors are invited to compete in the U.S. Grand Prix, Junior Worlds and in Project Gold camps. This event is open to pre-qualified athletes, but there are additional ways to earn a chance to compete. The open is a dual-sanctioned event, falling under the umbrella of both the Association of Freeskiing Professionals and the International Ski Federation.



#### **WINTER X GAMES ASPEN**

Each winter, the largest and most influential alternative snow sports event in the world unfolds on Aspen's Buttermilk Mountain. This thrilling event features 200 of the world's most talented and accomplished winter action sports athletes competing for medals and prize money. X Games Aspen is a phenomenal event to attend for families or if you're an avid fan of winter sports like snowboarding or snowmobiling. The games typically are held at the end of January each year.





Snowmass Luminescence is an interactive art and light display brought to you by Snowmass Tourism and Aspen Snowmass and it will immerse you and your family in a dazzling world of light and art. It runs from December 17th through February 27th from sunset to 9 p.m. daily.






So many travelers just wait for the snow to fly and temperatures to plummet so they can get to those places where they can enjoy their favorite winter activities like skiing, heli-skiing, snowboarding, skating, tobogganing, or snowmobiling. We'd be remiss if we didn't mention cuddling up under a blanket in a sleigh being pulled by beautiful horses or Alaskan and Siberian huskies. Imagine sitting in front of a roaring fire with a mug of hot cocoa embellished by coffee liqueur and whipped cream. It may be cold outside, but winter can be a real heart warmer when it comes to special times.





With such an extensive volume of slopes, you could spend your entire trip covering new terrain every single day. In Aspen ski resort, you can ski the same route that has hosted World Cup finals, ride through gladed powder stashes or burn your legs racing from top to bottom on some of the longest pistes you can find.





Until 2001, Aspen mountain ski resort banned all snowboarders from its slopes. Now all of Aspen's mountains welcome boarders and offer a special ride-guide leaflet for all four mountains. At two miles, Snowmass has the longest terrain park in North America. There are three man-made half-pipes and five terrain parks, as well as lots of slopes that are naturally appealing to boarders.





Year after year, Snowmass' terrain parks are consistently placed at the top of Transworld Snowboarding Magazine's annual rankings. Snowmass will keep you busy with approximately 100 features, including a 22-foot Zaugg-cut superpipe. Three terrain parks and two halfpipes cater to riders and skiers of all abilities.





The town's cross country center services nearly 40 miles of trails as part of the Snowmass trail network. The cross country center is ideal for gear demonstrations, lessons, or guided tours, while a post-ski lounge presents an enticing venue to unwind from the day's activity.



#### **DOG SLEDDING**

An exciting journey in the pristine Snowmass backcountry via dog sledding provides an unforgettable experience for the whole family. A single sled which accommodates two adults and child, is pulled by between eight to 10 Alaskan Huskies led by a musher. Experience the tremendous white expanse as the pioneers and aboriginals did, followed by hearty Colorado meal in a remote log cabin beside the comforts of a blazing fire. An adrenaline rush with no physical exertion, dogsledding will be one of the coolest and most riveting experiences you'll have in Aspen.





Enjoy a favorite summer pastime on a ski holiday. Hop on a fat bike to discover a wide range of trails and terrain. With its non-traditional appeal, far biking provides a high-octane workout perfect if you're seeking to discover sites beyond the beaten path. The Rio Grande Trail, Independence Pass, the Aspen Fat Bike Loop, Maroon Bells, and the Smuggler Mountain Road await adventurers.





The Roaring Fork Valley presents some of the most abundant and consistent winter fly fishing in the country. A great activity when taking a break from the slopes, Aspen provides excellent guided winter fly fishing trips. Few other activities allow you to immerse yourself so thoroughly in the elements than fly fishing. This Aspen activity would be a shame to miss.
