

#### **ABOUT**



#### **NEW PROVIDENCE ISLAND**

#### HARBOUR ISLAND

The rich history of Harbour Island dates back as far as the 1700s. Warm, clear ocean waters provide excellent diving, fishing, and boating, while outlying reefs provide safe swimming and snorkeling. 






If you don't mind sharing your beach space with guests of some major resorts in Nassau, Cabbage Beach might be your tanning spot. It has been consistently included as one of the top 10 beaches globally with nearly two miles of soft white sand dotted with swaying coconut and palm trees, making it picture-perfect. Just a hint: If you want to be free of the crowd, walk a little further east along the shore.





The beach is named as a tribute to 'Jaws Revenge', which was shot at this location. Jaws Beach is probably the most picturesque beach in Nassau. It's not every day you get to bask in the sunshine at a **world-famous movie set**! Jaws beach is more off the beaten track for its remote location and that is the exact reason why it's loved by locals.






Spanish Wells is a quiet fishing village where you can enjoy modern conveniences but still relax on a gorgeous pink-sand beach that feels like it's on your own private island fringed by water as clear as glass. Stretching from Spanish Wells to the northeast tip of Eleuthera is the beautiful Devil's Backbone barrier reef, which is fantastic for snorkeling.




#### **PINK SANDS BEACH**

Pink sand. It's stunning. When the turquoise water runs to the shore, you'll think you're standing in a watercolor painting. The light rose color results from foraminifera – a marine animal – and its red shell, which crushes and later mixes with the white sand. This unusual, elegant beach provides ultimate relaxation. You can go swimming, snorkeling, and fishing. You might want to stick around a while to visit the town in the evening and enjoy its exciting nightlife.






Lighthouse beach on Eleuthera Island is the definition of serenity. Kick back and watch the waves lap against the shore as you regain clarity, peace, and parts of yourself long forgotten in the chaos of everyday life. A 4x4 may be required to get to the beach, as the road is quite rugged, but once you get there, it is well-worth the effort.





This beach is not only one of the most beautiful beaches in the Caribbean, but it is a popular site for kite surfing, wind surfing, and snorkeling. When the tide goes out on this beach, you can walk out almost half a mile on the sand, in water that's about ankle deep. Many visitors use this opportunity to collect sand dollars, which are in abundance on this beach.





Also known as Pelican Beach, Tropic of Cancer Beach is a crescent of sand as soft and white as powdered sugar bordering translucent turquoise water along the coast of Little Exuma. The longest beach on the island, it's also the prettiest, and chances are, you'll have it all to yourself. The beach gets its name from the meridian line located at 23N '75 35W, defining the northern extent of the tropics that crosses right through it. This beach is one of Exuma's well-kept secrets.






A visit to Treasure Cay Beach will help you realize dreams do come true! This more than three-mile beach is absolute heaven and consists of sugary white sand complemented by azure water. Now, for one of the best parts: little to no tourists. This beach is almost undiscovered. There will be plenty of room for you to enjoy the surroundings in privacy. There are no crowds, no ogling spectators, just you, the sand, and the water as you relax on a lounge chair.





Many people who visit Cape Santa Maria describe it and the most tranquil, relaxing place they've ever been. The four-mile talcum powder sand beach is outstanding. It's the perfect beach for water sports and you can even rent a catamaran. If you love shelling, you'll find lots of treasures here. This beach is lovely for families since the water is also ideal for swimming.






#### **ELBOW CAY**

Greeted by the Hope Town Lighthouse (one of the most photogenic spots in Elbow Cay Bahamas), visitors are treated to a tiny village made of wooden colonial-style cottages and a lot of greenery; this is Hope Town Bahamas of Elbow Cay. It is the 'artsy' cay – a home to BIFF (Bahamas International Film Festival), The Hummingbird Cottage and The Johnston Art Foundry, to name a few. On September 1, 2019 Hurricane Dorian made landfall on Elbow Cay as a Category 5 hurricane, making it the worst natural disaster the country has ever seen. The cay is slowly rebuilding to its former glory.



#### **ARAWAK CAY**

Due to its popularity of local seafood, Arawak Cay is also known as The Fish Fry. You can get all sorts of Bahamian seafood here. Just a 10-minute ride from Nassau's hub, and you'll feel like you're in a different world at Arawak. This seaside stretch is filled with hand-painted wooden stands, dinged-up food trucks, and rainbow-hued stand-alone restaurants, all with deep roots in Caribbean history. The Fish Fry is a place for Bahamians to come together to share the unique flavors of home and for visitors to sample everything from guava duffs to conch salads and fish from steamed to "cracked."





If conch is among your favorite seafood, you have to visit Potters Cay. Under the soaring overpass connecting Nassau to Paradise Island are the sleepy fishing docks, lively fruit markets, and brightly-colored conch shacks of Potters Cay. All day long, roughly 40 chefs in 40 different shacks cook fresh conch dishes in 40 different ways. How do you know what to try? Before heading to the cay, ask a local which stall is their favorite!





One of the best places in the Exumas to swim with the nurse sharks is in Compass Cay. Nurse sharks that live in warm and shallow waters of the Exuma Cays are friendly animals and, for the most part, harmless to swimmers and divers. Local fishermen feed them, so they're accustomed to humans and welcome a pat on the back.





This island is part of the Exuma Cays. If you are looking for something different from touristy, bustling settings like Nassau, the Exuma Cays is the right place to head. Staniel Cay is the place to see the infamous swimming pigs. You can spend the day snorkeling and taking pics with these adorable animals.

#### SAPODILLA | CARIBBEAN, SEAFOOD

Sapodilla Estate is home to Sapodilla Fine Dining Restaurant, featuring several dining rooms. You can listen to the tunes of a world-class pianist and musicians. If privacy is your preference, then you will find the ideal venue nestled in the heart of the lush gardens here. Share an intimate dinner for two in the privacy of a cabana with personalized chef and butler services. Allow award winning world-renowned chefs to excite your palate with signature European and Bahamian gourmet fusion cuisine.



If you're happy to hop on a culinary adventure, Cleo is for you. Enjoy delicious shareable plates, mezzes, flatbreads, and handcrafted cocktails in an intimate, warm, yet lively atmosphere. Give your palate a workout with a delicious Moroccan tagine. How about saffron chicken with preserved lemon, almonds, olives, roasted tomato, and saffron rice? For a less adventurous choice, ask for the catch of the day pan-seared to perfection and enhanced with a fresh citrus sauce.





The secret recipes at Graycliff have resulted in sumptuous, unique dishes. Guests' experiences at Graycliff begin in the parlor with its high ceilings and tranquil feeling. 
#### **NOBU | JAPANESE, SEAFOOD**

Nobu, at the Atlantis, is the Bahamian outpost of acclaimed master chef Nobu Matsuhisa. The mini tacos, filled with seafood or steak, are a fun starter, and for entrees, one of Nobu's signature dishes is a black cod that has been bathed for three days in a marinade of miso and sake, the result is sweet, buttery and unforgettable. Dinner here often begins (and sometimes ends) at the magnificent bar, and if you have the chance, visit the sake cellar, one of only a few in the Western Hemisphere.





Lauded as the chicest dining spot on the island, Dune has plenty of choices for Caribbean-inspired cuisine. After enjoying a conch salad, lobster-topped pizza or roasted grouper with Malaysian chili sauce and basil, take a walk around the beautiful breezy grounds, including an exquisite Versailles-style garden.



#### THE LANDING | CONTEMPORARY

With its contemporary menu and opulent ambiance, The Landing is the favorite place for dinner for many locals and vacationers. Chef Madelene Pedican consistently gets top reviews for her flavorful dishes using only fresh produce and freshly-caught local fish and seafood. Among the popular dinner offerings are gingered lobster with lemongrass risotto cake, asparagus, and sprouts. If you've still got room, end your delicious meal with banana brown sugar upside-down cake with rum raisin ice cream.





Rock House serves eclectic fare ranging from fresh seafood to Italian classics of linguine with pesto and even includes dishes with a Bahamian flair, like lamb chops with pineapple, mango, and banana fruit curry. There is an extensive wine list for any wine enthusiast. There are signature cocktails, martinis, and Bahamian classics, like the Goombay Smash. All in all, the ambiance is lively but refined, and the food is top-notch.





There are many bars, lounges, and casinos in the Bahamas to provide excitement after the sun goes down. From classy, exclusive spots in Nassau and Paradise Island to rustic beach venues playing local beats, Bahamas nightlife offers you a world of contrasts. Party with locals after basking in the sunshine or head to the city for a world of clubbing, casinos, and cocktails.




Sea Glass, in The Cove at Atlantis casino, is the ideal place to enjoy delicious drinks as colorful as the stunning Bahamian sunsets. Play table games like blackjack and roulette or relax while nibbling dainty, tasty tapas, sip signature cocktails and fruity martinis like the Covetini, a refreshing mix of raspberry rum, mango jasmine puree, and raspberries with a touch of lime.





Aura is the most upscale club on the island. It's a little bit of the Vegas, South Beach, and New York party scenes rolled into one venue. With its 9,000 square feet, it has DJs spinning beats until the wee hours. The dazzling glass dance floor is surrounded by plush banquet seating. Two bars serve unique, refreshing cocktails, and VIP areas are ideal for private parties and watching the crowd.














Bahamians enjoy sharing their culture and their love of the arts with visitors. Most people still equate the Bahamas with sun, sand, and sea, yet it has a thriving art scene that continues to be recognized on the global stage. The Bahamas has long had a vibrant arts community encompassing artists working in a wide variety of creative fields. The National Art Gallery of The Bahamas features an extensive collection of primarily Bahamian art, including paintings by Amos Ferguson, sculptures by Antonius Roberts, and pencil drawings of historic Nassau from the 18th century. Other galleries and Bahamas artist studios are located in Nassau and throughout other Bahama islands.

#### **HUMMINGBIRD COTTAGE ART CENTRE**

The Hummingbird Cottage Art Centre might be one of the most remote art galleries in the world. It's located in Hope Town, a district with roughly 500 inhabitants and part of the Great Abaco archipelago in the north. Despite the challenging geographical location, Hummingbird represents a group of talented painters, however small, whose work is strongly inspired by the distinctive natural and urban landscape: picturesque, colonial houses; leafy palms; lush, colorful flowers. Hope Town's art centre is inside two lovely, quirky wooden cottages with pink walls, specifically constructed to house the collection.



#### THE JOHNSTON ART FOUNDRY

The late Randolph W. Johnston settled in Little Harbour, Abaco, in 1952 with his wife Margot and three sons Bill, Dennis, and Peter. An artist and professor, he created the first and only art foundry in the Bahamas. When Randolph passed away, his son Peter took over the foundry, adding it to his already thriving business, the famous Pete's Pub in Little Harbour. Quench your thirst and get your fill of fresh fish done to perfection at the pub after visiting the foundry, where you can choose a one-of-a-kind sculpture for your home or office.





Sacred Space, a sculptural installation on The Cove Peninsula, was created by acclaimed Bahamian artist Antonius Roberts. Carved from the Madeira tree, the seven dancing figures, represent the artist's deep-seated respect for the sanctity and significance of the country's trees and forests.






The National Art Gallery of the Bahamas (NAGB) collects, preserves, exhibits, and interprets historical and contemporary Bahamian arts. The museum educates, uplifts, and inspires. There are several national, rotating, and online exhibits. Natalie Willis, artist and NAGB curator, says "art is not just integral to understanding our unique culture here in the Bahamas and the Caribbean, it is vital to understanding who we are and what our history means for us today."



#### **HERITAGE MUSEUM OF THE BAHAMAS**

Located in Mountbatten House, itself an interesting building and once the summer home of Lord Louis Mountbatten, Admiral of the Fleet for Great Britain and the last Viceroy of India, the Heritage Museum of the Bahamas is part of the Graycliff Heritage Village. A large part of the museum's collection belongs to the British antique dealer Hamilton White. Exhibits range from a slice of meteorite (about 4.5 billion years old), artifacts dating to the era of Christopher Columbus in the late 15th century, to a slave bench with iron ankle shackles that brings plantation life into sharp focus.





Some luxury travelers head to the Bahamas, especially for the shopping experiences. Whether you're set on high-end boutiques in palatial shopping centers or looking for a piece from a well-known Bahamian artist, the shopping choices are endless. The luxurious Crystal Coral Shops provide a blend of the globe's best fashion boutiques, while a visit to the Bay Street Straw Market – dating back from the 1940s – is an entirely different experience. The Bahamas is definitely for shoppers who love the finer things in life.

#### JOHN WATLING'S DISTILLERY

John Watling's rum has been called the Spirit of the Bahamas. If you're a fan of this libation, you can tour the Buena Vista Estate in Nassau, where the distillery makes it home. Founded in 1789, the estate features a free production and museum-like tour along with shopping and signature cocktails in its on-site tavern. It is rumored the Bahama Mama originated in 1963 at Nassau's Pink Elephant Club. The distillery crafts its version from the original recipe using John Watling's amber rum, coffee liqueur, coconut rum, Gun Cay 151° rum, pineapple, and lime juices, and two dashes of grenadine.





If you're a lover of fine cigars and fine chocolates, then you'll have to make a stop here. This place was initially a cigar factory, but the proprietors also started selling unique, decadent chocolates. Take in the mesmerizing cigar and chocolate-making processes. Discover tobacco chocolate bars that taste better than they sound. Uncover unique goodies in the chocolate factory like cigar-shaped chocolates in mint, Nutella and cherry brandy, and a tasty chocolate tea. You can also line your luggage with some very impressive, exclusive cigar brands.





You will find world-class shopping in one large shoppers' paradise at Atlantis. There is no need to head to Rodeo Drive or 5th Avenue to find luxury items in the most exclusive stores. From the latest Bahamian, Italian, and French fashions to Cuban cigars, trendy handbags, beachwear, and more, it's all here. Crystal Court shops offer the finest in women's and men's fashions, featuring Amici, Cole's of Nassau, Michael Kors, Gucci, Tory Burch, David Yurman, Versace, and others.






We all love beautiful jewelry, so if you're looking for something special that will bring back memories of your magical Bahamian vacation, you may be able to find the perfect necklace or bauble at the Craft Cottage. The shop has everything from quirky items to classy pieces made by local artists who love and value their art.



#### **BAHAMA HAND PRINTS**

In 1966 two artists Helen Astarita and Berta Sands, established Bahama Hand Prints, mastering the traditional method of hand screen printing transferring their gorgeous designs onto fabric. If you want to take away a genuine piece of Bahamian style, you can choose from their large selection of prints, and they will design and create a personal outfit or piece for you. Most creations are sewn in-house by talented seamstresses and tailors.





Androsia Hand Made Batik was started on the beach in the late 1960s by Rosi Birch. Some of the same designs birthed by Birch decades ago are still used by the company today. All stamps are hand-carved, all garments are hand-dyed and dried under the Bahamian sun and sewn on Andros. The factory is committed to creating vibrant and playful textiles, garments and experiences. Every yard of product is stamped with the company's signature – a sign you've bought a unique piece of art.





Popular events in the Bahamas, like festivals, are closely related to the country's cultural wealth. There are more than 700 islands that make up the whole of the Bahamas, but only 24 are inhabited, but that's enough for the nation to have a complete festivities' calendar. The population in the Bahamas is made up of a melting pot of different native customs, so festivals are colorful and varied. The population is predominantly of African origin, so events have fundamental traditional roots. Whatever is being celebrated, the Bahamian people welcome visitors with open arms and open hearts, so you're sure to have a fantastic time.

#### **JUNKANOO**

Every Dec. 26 and Jan. 1, Nassau's central Bay Street is inundated, from the early hours in the morning until dawn, by streams of cheering Bahamians parading down the street dancing to the rhythms of upbeat music, cowbells, and whistles. They celebrate Junkanoo, a carnival-style parade with roots in the country's past of slavery (slaves used to have only those two days off a year). The Junkanoo Expo museum displays a collection of the exuberant, colorful masks and costumes Bahamians wear on the festive occasion. These items can be so intricate and sophisticated that they have become genuine pieces of folk art.





Party Like A Royal is the Atlantis Resort's New Year's Eve bash, and it's a huge party! Say goodbye to the old and ring in the new, listening to A-list entertainers. Past performers have included Bebe Rexha and the Jonas Brothers. While you get ready for a brand new start to a brand new year, you'll have access to a premium top-shelf open bar and a fantastic dessert experience. A midnight fireworks spectacular seals the deal.





The annual Caribbean Muzik Festival is a star-studded event showcasing more than 25 of the region's most renowned and exciting entertainers. You'll enjoy a variety of music such as calypso, dancehall, and reggae. The festival has become a fixture among Bahamians and visitors who look forward to this most prestigious annual display of Caribbean culture.



### **EVENTS**

#### **FOX HILL DAY FESTIVAL**

The Fox Hill Day Festival is the oldest in the country, held the second Tuesday in August every year. It commemorates the freeing of enslaved Africans in The Bahamas, and residents of Fox Hill celebrate the 1838 emancipation of their ancestors from slavery by the British. The event begins with church services, and after giving thanks, children "plait the maypole," with ribbons while men try to climb it for a monetary prize. There's plenty of Bahamian food to sample, music to stir your senses, and the thing that makes the Bahamas so special – everyone dancing in the streets.


#### **CLIFTON HERITAGE NATIONAL PARK**

Clifton Heritage National Park pays homage to three essential groups that impacted the country: the Lucayans, the Loyalists, and the Africans. A walk along the winding trails throughout the park will reveal a variety of ecosystems, such as cliffs, coastal wetlands, dunes, rocky shorelines, sandy beaches, and offshore coral reefs. Local fauna includes songbirds, wading birds, seabirds, and other wildlife. Swim, fish, hike, camp, snorkel, birdwatch and have a picnic. There are plenty of activities to keep you riveted and increasingly appreciative of being in this paradise.





Pig Beach is one experience most travelers have on their Bahamas itineraries – swimming with pigs. Wonder how the pigs got to Pig Beach on Exuma? No one knows for sure. Big Major Cay is uninhabited, and the pigs are not native to the island. Wherever they came from, there are now about 20 pigs and piglets living the easy life, with daily visits from Bahamians and tourists. They make the most adorable photos and will happily swim alongside you.



### **SWIMMING WITH NURSE SHARKS**

Compass Cay is home to the incredible nurse shark experience. Swimming with these pet nurse sharks is one of the most popular things in the Exuma Cays. These sharks move slowly, are mostly bottom dwellers, and are generally harmless to humans. However, if they feel threatened, they still have the jaw strength to crunch right through their regular diets of coral and shellfish, so it's advised to be respectful around them.





Little dinosaurs roam the land on Bitter Guana Cay. You can visit endangered Bahamian Rock Iguanas on a day trip to the Exuma Cays and Staniel Cay. They are mild-mannered and not easily angered, and they will readily take food from your hand. However, keep in mind that they are wild creatures and should be treated with respect and fed with caution. On your visit, you're encouraged to ask how you can help resurrect this dying breed.



### **BLUE HOLES NATIONAL PARK**

The park's 33,235 acres protects a large number of blue holes and freshwater reservoirs. Surrounding pine and coppice forests are also protected. Sign up for a park expedition to visit three different blue holes and two very diverse forest areas by walking, swimming and snorkeling. One of the stops is at Cousteau's Blue Hole, where Jacques Cousteau went to dive in the 1960s. By snorkeling, you'll be able to explore this magical underworld that fascinated the oceanographer legend so many years ago.






The Bahamian seas are magical. Life underneath the surf only allows glimpses into its rich color and offers few pictures of its alien-like creatures. You can get a sense of this mystical realm by snorkeling and diving in areas rich with marine life. On the water, set your senses free with activities like kitesurfing, kiteboarding, and kayaking. Here are eight water activities to whet your adventurous appetite.





The crystal waters and balmy temperatures make the Bahamas an irresistible place for boating, and Bahamas' Out Islands are little pieces of nirvana. Like road trips on the sea, boating can take you to as many of the Bahama's 700 islands as you want. Stop for scuba diving or snorkeling. Hop across this incredible archipelago from Grand Bahama Island to the Exumas and relish every moment.



#### **DIVING WITH WILD REEF SHARKS**

Stuart's Cove is a long-time fixture in Nassau, famous for its shark diving encounters. This adventure is a must for any scuba diver excited to get up close with wild reef sharks. First, you'll get to explore the reef where the sharks congregate, so you can swim alongside them. A second dive is a feeding experience where you'll rest on the seafloor while the divemaster chums sharks. Stuart's Cove also offers a two-day underwater shark feeder program teaching you how to safely feed these amazing creatures.



#### **DIVING AT LUCAYAN NATIONAL PARK**

Lucayan National Park has six ecosystems and two caves in very close proximity. The dive site is a cave known as Ben's Cave, and it extends for almost nine miles underwater. Encounter stalactites, stalagmites, a halocline, fossilized conch shells, and bivalves. Divers will experience an amazing adventure that takes them back in time. After the dive, continue the adventure through six different ecosystems. Enjoy lunch on gorgeous Fortune Bay Beach surrounded by Coconut palms facing the turquoise sea.





The Bahamas is the ideal location for a stingray experience eco-tour. On a private tour you'll visit several snorkeling spots along Grand Bahama's reef system. With depths averaging four to 12 feet, you'll see various marine life, including getting up close and personal with graceful stingrays.






The local surfers here are generous, perhaps more generous with their waves than anywhere else in the world. The men are the unofficial ambassadors of Surfer's Beach. They eagerly take the role of surf instructor, lifeguard, and friend to visitors who have found themselves in the presence of waves that seem too big to belong here.





Paddle a special glass-bottomed kayak out to Cabo San Lucas' most famous landmark, El Arco, and the famed Land's End, where two oceans meet – the warm waters of the Sea of Cortez and the cool waters of the mighty Pacific. 




Kitesurfing and kiteboarding are now mainstream sports worldwide, but are still pretty low-key in the Bahamas and that's to your advantage. Throughout the islands, there is so much space and so many amazing flat-water opportunities, and you probably won't even see another kitesurfer or kiteboarder on a windy day, depending on which island you are on. Many people use the terms kiteboarding and kitesurfing interchangeably. But they are two different styles of kite-sports. Kiteboarders typically use a twin tip board, which is great for flat water riding and jumping. Kitesurfers ride a strapless surfboard and go out to the reef to surf waves. Either way, there are a number of pros available to teach you and to make sure you're having a great time.





For a completely different perspective of the Bahamas and its Out Islands, you have a take to the sky. Like the native Bahama Parrot, soar over pine and coppice forests, dive over the azure sea breathing air as pristine as the white sands. Instead of island hopping by boat, charter a plane to see as many of the 700 cays as you can. For more remote locations, getting there by seaplane would be ideal. There are several day trips you could take to create memories that would last a lifetime. For instance, you could fly from Nassau to Staniel Cay in the Exumas to frolic with the famous swimming pigs. See sharks, feed iguanas, visit Sand Bars and Thunderball Grotto. There is just so much to do, and getting there by air is quick and easy.




#### **PARASAILING**


# ARDASTRA GARDENS & WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CENTER
