LOVINA BEACH

Lovina Beach is the perfect getaway for beachgoers looking to escape from Bali's bustling south. It offers beautiful black-sand shores, a laid-back nightlife scene and calm waves that are ideal for swimming or surfing. Spanning 1.2 miles in North Bali regency - Kalibukbuk Village is its epicenter – Lovina boasts stunning sunsets framed by the 'Dolphin Statue', which proudly stands as an unofficial landmark. Although relatively quiet after dusk, it houses many cozy cafés and seafood restaurants along with ample parking spaces nearby making this coast idyllic no matter what time you visit!



CANGGU & BEYOND

The once–exclusive oasis of Canggu – or the Gu, as locals call it – has transformed into a bustling destination for travelers from all backgrounds. 


SEMINYAK




ULUWATU & BUKIT PENINSULA


NUSA DUA & TANJUNG BENOA


SANUR


UBUD


NUSA ISLANDS (LEMBONGAN, CENINGAN & PENIDA)






BALIAN BEACH

Balian Beach is a spectacular destination, nestled in a small village surrounded by lush rice fields and located on the west coast at the mouth of the Balian River. The beach is a paradise for surfers, boasting soft black sand, with a few patches of smooth volcanic rocks and powerful swells with strong rip currents that make for an exhilarating surfing experience. With a lot fewer crowds than Kuta or the Bukit, it's the perfect place for surfers seeking an exciting yet peaceful ride. But that's not all – in August, the windy weather brings with it an opportunity for kite surfing that can't be found anywhere else! And the stunning sunsets make Balian Beach the ideal spot for a romantic escape.





Seminyak Beach is an absolute hedonistic paradise! This picturesque white-sandy beach is Bali's most fashionable, home to some of the island's most luxurious accommodations and boasting an array of fine restaurants and boutiques. But that's not all; with its great wave perfect for surfing, Seminyak Beach is favored by many surfers and thrill-seekers who come to conquer the waves and experience their own surf adventures.





This beach is set in South Kuta and is best for all touristy things. Set at the heart of Kuta, this mile-and-a-half-long golden sand beach is a popular destination for locals, ex-pats, and international tourists alike. It is the perfect spot for sunbathing, swimming, surfing, and other water sports, ideal for surfing or enjoying the sun. BALANGAN BEACH




Tucked away behind striking limestone formations, Suluban Beach is one of Bali's most unique beaches. Nicknamed 'Blue Point,' the beach lies at the end of Jalan Mamo, in Labuan Sait – the same area that houses the famed Padang Padang and Uluwatu. Accessed via steps and log ramps, visitors can find a small beach shaded by a towering cliff face. Although not the best spot for sunbathers, pro surfers flock here to ride the nearby reef breaks and make use of the beach as a launch pad.



PANDAWAS BEACH

Take a journey to the secluded Five Pandawas Beach, a mere five miles from Nusa Dua. The half-a-mile-long stretch of stunning shoreline, shielded by limestone cliffs, offers awe-inspiring views of the horizon. Sunbathers and thrill-seekers alike can make the most of the area, with plenty of water sports such as jet skiing, banana boating, and parasailing to enjoy, plus delicious local beach shacks to savor. Still, it's the cliffs that face the ocean that will capture your attention – deeply carved into them are heroes of the great epic Mahabharata, making the beach truly special.



GEGER BEACH

Lurking at the bottom of a steep stair path, the pristine beauty of Geger Beach is an enchanting secret revealed only to those who take the time to explore. Often listed amongst the top beaches in Nusa Dua, the fine white sand and crystal clear waters provide a gorgeous backdrop for any photographer. However, what truly sets this beach apart from the others is its rich cultural and historic ambiance, a remnant of its past life as a seaweed farmers' village, now surrounded by high-end resorts. Let Geger Beach captivate you with its sublime horizon views and unforgettable memories.





Nusa Dua beach, arguably one of the best beaches, is known locally as Pantai Mengiat. Its tranquil waters, perfect for swimming and snorkeling are bordered by high-end accommodations. For the more adventurous, the waters farther from the shore offer great opportunities for surfing. Tour operators also offer glass-bottom boat trips, as well as locals who head out to sea in their wooden boats. If you're an early bird, you'll be rewarded with the stunning view of a magical crimson sunrise against the blue waters.




SAMUH BEACH


SUNDAYS BEACH CLUB


MÏNOO BEACH CLUB


REEF BEACH CLUB


JUNGLE FISH


PURA ULUN DANU BERATAN


GUNUNG KAWI


BESAKIH TEMPLE (MOTHER TEMPLE)


TANAH LOT



A site of spiritual worship since the 16th century, it continues to entice visitors from all corners of the globe. Exploring the twisting pathways up to the temple's entrance, visitors can marvel at the breathtaking sunsets while appreciating this unique facet of Balinese culture.



ULUWATU TEMPLE

Perched atop a majestic cliff on Bali's Bukit Peninsula and surrounded by lush jungle, Uluwatu Temple has been a venerated site since the 11th century when it was first built as a spiritual sanctuary to honor Balinese gods and goddesses. This grand complex is filled with several ancient shrines and statues dedicated to the Balinese sea gods and their families, making it a popular destination for both spiritual worship and sightseeing. Admire the intricate carvings and sculptures from below, or take many winding staircases to get a closer look at these sacred shrines. Witnessing the sunset's glowing orange and red hues cascading over the Indian Ocean from Uluwatu Temple creates an awe-inspiring setting.





ARTS




MUSEUM PASIFIKA

Delve into the Museum Pasifika's unique collection of historical artifacts, and cultural and artistic items from over 200 artists from 25 countries, with a particular emphasis on Balinese life themes. Be sure to check out works from acclaimed Balinese painter Nyoman Gunarsa and Javanese artist Raden Saleh, two of Indonesia's most notable figures in art. Out of 11 display rooms, rooms one to five house an eclectic array of art, ranging from Indonesian and Italian to Dutch, French, and Indo-European works. The rest host rotating exhibitions featuring items from Southeast Asia, such as the captivating 'tapa' bark artwork of Oceania and the Pacific, as well as exotic paintings from China and Japan.



NYAMAN GALLERY

In the heart of Seminyak, Nyaman Gallery offers a unique display of artworks crafted by renowned artists from around the world. You can explore a wide array of captivating paintings, beautiful wood carvings, and awe-inspiring sculptures. Among the remarkable items on display are regal ceremonial headdresses from Sumatra, Bali and Papua, intricately hand-carved wooden betel containers from Sumba, war spears from Borneo, and many other beautiful pieces lovingly crafted by Indonesian artisans. Plus, it's the perfect place to pick up a souvenir – you can even have the artwork packed and shipped right to your doorstep! At Nyaman Gallery, the goal is to preserve the mythical Indonesian culture by showcasing an amazing array of original contemporary art as well as a superbly curated collection of traditional Indonesian arts.




CUSHCUSH GALLERY

Hidden away in the heart of Denpasar, CushCush Gallery Bali opened its doors in 2016 with a vision to become a platform of innovative collaboration between art and design. CushCush Gallery offers a unique and alternative experience, celebrating the variety of creativity in art, design, material, technique, and craft. It is the ultimate expression of the CushCush family, a design business co-founded by Suriawati Qiu and Jindee Chua. The gallery presents a range of well-known and up-and-coming artists, both domestically and internationally, in order to highlight cutting-edge and excellent modern design and art programs intended to revitalize the Balinese art business.



TITIK DUA

Nestled away behind two traditional Balinese buildings, Titik Dua gallery and exhibition space stands out as an awe-inspiring, relatively new landmark in Ubud. Titik Dua, with its captivating four-storey complex, harmoniously brings together the elements of water, wind, earth and space. Striking red bricks, a hallmark of Balinese temples, evoke a strong sense of place, while lush gardens meld with serene bodies of water. Industrial aspects, such as iron structures and stark black surfaces, reveal Ubud's metropolitan identity. Inaugurated in August 2020, Titik Dua had become a beacon of hope for Ubud, with ongoing exhibitions and events – even when many galleries had to go into hibernation.





The charming and cultural hub of Ubud, ARMA, is renowned for its artistic and architectural splendor. It is a great place to gain insight into Balinese art, both classic and modern. Featuring an impressive array of talented Indonesian, particularly Balinese, artists from all over the archipelago, many of whom are reinventing traditional styles, ARMA regularly hosts cultural evenings with enchanting traditional dance and music performances.






The fine art gallery founded and curated by Koman Wahyu Suteja, the son of Wayan Suteja Neka – who built the Neka Art Museum – focuses on young and modern artists from Bali, Indonesia, and South East Asia. Spanning two floors, the first is dedicated to contemporary artworks in traditional styles, while the second offers more modern pieces. Additionally, the gallery features an art library with art reference books available to borrow and purchase.




DON ANTONIO BLANCO MUSEUM

Venture to Don Antonio Blanco Museum, a vibrant cultural hub devoted to the artist, his creations, and his role in the art history of Bali. The abode he designed for his family — a wonderful fusion of Balinese and Spanish architecture — harbors a captivating collection of pieces created throughout his long career. The resplendent studio is constructed on top of a mountain with a breathtaking view of the Campuhan River and the idyllic countryside that had a profound influence on the painter's works. Boasting a "Catalan charisma," Blanco earned himself the moniker of "The Fabulous Blanco", a title that truly captures his remarkable talent for invention.



JASON DECAIRES TAYLOR' THE NEST

The Gili Meno statues, described as "hauntingly beautiful", have skyrocketed in popularity as a sought-after snorkeling and diving destination. Nest, the project of artful statues created by renowned British sculptor Jason deCaires Taylor, was commissioned by the eco-resort BASK, to which they stand before. These 48 life-size sculptures, emblematic of life and continuity, are arranged in a circle, with embracing figures curling around curled-up statues beneath the waves. Each sculpture was made with the molds of actual people, making them even more one-of-a-kind.


GATE OF HEAVEN AT PURA LEMPUYANG


TEGALALANG RICE TERRACE
