
BELVOIR CASTLE

The name Belvoir – meaning 'beautiful view' in French, pronounced as 'beaver', is the ancestral home of the Duke of Rutland, where the family has lived in an unbroken line for almost a thousand years.

The land at Belvoir was a gift from William the Conqueror to the family's first recorded ancestor Robert de Todeni, who began building the first Castle here in 1067. By 1464, the Wars of the Roses had taken their toll on the first castle, and it was more or less in ruins. Belvoir rose again 60 years later with the construction of the second Castle, which was destroyed during the Civil War. The third Castle was created for John the 8th Earl and was completed in 1668 to a design by John Webb. James Wyatt, famous for his improvements at Windsor Castle, designed the fourth Castle. Still standing proudly above the Vale of Belvoir, it was built between 1801–1832 for the 5th Duke and Duchess of Rutland.


Two decades before the Castle was built, the famous architect of the 18th century, Capability Brown, was making landscape designs, which ended up forgotten in the Castle's archives for almost 200 years. They were discovered back in 2014 by the 11th Duchess, when the Royal family decided to bring back in life Brown's vision of the Belvoir Castle.

The Castle sits in an estate of almost 15,000 acres (61 km²) and has been home to popular series 'The Crown' as well as films 'The Young Victoria' and 'Victoria & Abdul'. Stained glass windows, painted ceilings, ornate chandeliers and gothic archways create an elegant setting which will give you a feeling of being a part of a fairytale. Wherever you look you will find something to admire.



























MAP **GROUND FLOOR**






BELVOIR GIN

A British crafted gin, born in 2019 by Her Grace the Duchess of Rutland. This gin has a crystal clear appearance, and is styled with piney juniper, coriander, angelica, organs peel and liquorice. It has delicate notes of fig, vanilla and chamomile setting it apart and making it suitably stately. The embossed label of the gin represents the chinoiserie wallpaper of the eminent Chinese rooms at Belvoir, whilst the round bottle shape resembles the magnificent central tower designed by the leading Gothic romantic architect of his day, James Wyatt.




AFTERNOON **TEA**

In the 19th centuries the meals were traditionally only taken twice a day, once in the morning and the second mid evening. The Duchess of Bedford would call for a pot of tea accompanied with both savory and sweet delicate refreshments around mid afternoon to stave off the hunger before the evening meal.


MICHELIN STAR CHEF

FALCONRY

Belvoir Castle is home to 3 birds of prey – Scooby and Rodney are 7-year-old Harris Hawks, and Persil is an 11-year-old tame barn owl. They live in converted game larders situated in the Castle's central courtyard. The birds are looked after by an enthusiastic and dedicated team of handlers, led by Rhi Clark. Every day they are carefully weighed, checked, cleaned, fed and flown. They have an important day job – chasing pigeons off the Castle's lead roof, but they also regularly attend local charity events. You will watch the birds soar through the air right in front of the Castle. If you are feeling adventurous, you can wear the glove and the handler will let them land on your arm.



TRAIL HUNTING

(SEPTEMBER TO MID-MARCH)

A private trail hunting with one of England's finest and most rare packs of Old English Foxhounds. Ride to hounds, enjoy the Vale of Belvoir on horseback and learn about the hounds and how they hunt from the Master himself. Ride up front with the Huntsman one by one to understand his role and see the hounds at work on the scent first hand. During this activity the appropriate hunting kit attire has to be worn.



HOUND EXERCISE (MARCH TO AUGUST)

Depending on the time of the year, you will ride out with the Hounds on either bikes (March to May) or on horses (June and July). During this activity you will see the Vale of Belvoir at its best with the hounds trotting along in front of you and then have a tour of the Kennels by the Master and Huntsman. The tour ends with watching the hounds being fed post exercise – a truly intimate experience.






GAME SHOOTING

(SEPTEMBER TO FEBRUARY)

Experience game shooting followed by a delicious lunch in the Shoot Room at Belvoir Castle. This activity is available during autumn and winters months, from September to February.

MOSCAR LODGE STAY & GROUSE SHOOTING (AUGUST - FEBRUARY)

Moscar Lodge is a unique palatial Victorian house that nestles idyllically amidst the undulating countryside of the Peak District National Park, close to the village of Bamford. The brilliance of it flows to the outside – the impressive 6000 acres of moorlands, where you can go grouse shooting. Some of Moscar Lodge amenities include an outdoor swimming pool, a tennis court, games room with a snooker table and a cinema room.

CLAY SHOOTING


This hunting activity is available all year long, and it involves shooting clays in the grounds of Belvoir Castle with experienced teachers. The activity includes a two-course lunch, guns and cartridges, and is suitable for all ages.





HORSE **RIDING**

This activity includes horse riding around the Castle grounds followed by a picnic next to Frog Hollow Lake or in the Parkland with a private butler included. You have an opportunity to ride with Lady Alice or The Duchess herself as well. More experienced riders have an opportunity to go on a cross country course with Emilie Chandler, a five-star event rider and coach.






BICYCLE TOUR WITH A PICNIC

Many native and exotic tree species are spread over 1600 acres of beautiful woodland which belongs to the Belvoir Castle, and some of them are as old as the history of this place. You will get an opportunity to go hiking with an experienced countryside leader across the Estate. There are multiple routes and lengths with stops for picnics in folly's across the estate. The leader would be an expert in the environment and flora and fauna, so you would learn as you walk and enjoy the stunning scenery.



CARRIAGE RIDES

Enjoy a calming, relaxing ride around the Estate in a stunning Horse and Carriage, while appreciating the beautiful surroundings. The ride ends with a picnic in the Parkland overlooking the Castle with a private butler included for the day.

MASSEUSE, **BEAUTICIAN & HAIRDRESSER**










PRIVATE TOUR CHATSWORTH HOUSE AND GARDENS






