
An area often falling below the radar, the beach of La Bocca is a quiet alternative to the hustle and bustle of Croisette. Situated west of the city center, this stretch of shoreline is a go-to for families seeking a leisurely day in the sun. Featuring dramatic boulders and evenly-spaced kiosks, Plage La Bocca offers plenty of amenities. On the periphery of the glitz and glamor, La Bocca is where the locals live, allowing guests to soak up the everyday spirit of Cannes.





LE SUQUET

The historic center of Le Suquet, known for its steep cobblestoned winding streets, is a key tourist attraction. Once the medieval residential area of the fisherman who inhabited Cannes, the compact old quarter surprises with a host of jazz bars, speakeasies, and fine restaurants. Landmarks include a clock tower and church facing east at the top of the hill, offering lovely city and ocean views.










SUPER CANNES

Just above La Californie lies Super Cannes. This ultra-exclusive residential area sits at a higher vantage point between Cannes and Vallauris. As the name may imply, Super Cannes is for the very wealthy with peak luxury embraced by a pristine wooded area and sweeping ocean views.



MOUGINS

This stunning bohemian village perched in the hills presents a wonderful pastoral retreat. It's surrounded by the pristine Valmasque forests on a fragrant terrain plush with umbrella pines, olive groves, and sprinkled with Cypress trees. The medieval origins of the area are still intact, and its luscious panoramic views and history have inspired the lives of many well-known artist residents. Jean Cocteau, Edith Piaf, Winston Churchill, Catherine Deneuve, and Jacques Brel are but a few who have resided or lived in Mougins. Serene and calm, the village is lauded for its proud culinary heritage.





Found at the crossroads of Cannes, Nice, and Juan Les Pins and Antibes, Vallauris has risen in prominence as Picasso's place of residence during his mid-late career. Small, quiet, and residential, Vallauris packs an incredibly robust cultural itinerary. It's home to a national museum, Picasso's public war and peace sculpture, and a museum of ceramics, marking the region's most representative art medium. Flush with workshops, and galleries this quaint town is a lovely pit stop on the way to Antibes.







On La Croisette, just a few metres from the Five Seas Hotel, soak up the sun and make the most of the oldest and above all the most elegant private beach in Cannes: the Plage du Festival. It was redesigned by Architect Jean Michel Wilmotte making the place resolutely elegant. With touches of white, green, and blue, and bioclimatic pergolas, this is an ideal setting for a day of reverie and indulgence.



CARLTON CANNES BEACH CLUB

The legend of the Côte d'Azur hotel industry, located in the heart of the Croisette, is the Carlton Cannes Beach Club. MIRAMAR BEACH


LA GUERITE BEACH & RESTAURANT, sainte-marguerite island


MICHELIN-STARRED RESTAURANTS

L'OR BLEU * | MODERN, MEDITERRANEAN

Located in the Tiara Yaktsa Hotel, Michelin-starred L'Or Bleu serves fine Mediterranean cuisine using the freshest ingredients inspired by local harvests yet infused with the spicy flavors of remote islands. Whether choosing a table on the glamorous terrace with views of the bay or in the coolness of the interior, a deliciously savory meal awaits. L'Or Bleu is a true epicurean discovery.



LE ROOF (SEA SENS) RESTAURANT * | MEDITERRANEAN

On the fifth floor of the Five Seas Hotel, Sea Sens recently received its first Michelin star. The beautiful rooftop terrace setting has one of the most amazing views of Cannes. The dining room features an elegant east-west décor of settee sofas and white tablecloths with the ceiling strewn with illuminated lanterns. 

LA PETITE MAISON | NIÇOISE/ FRENCH MEDITERRANEAN

This legendary Old Nice eatery is a favorite of French presidents, movie stars and rock stars alike. Nice's fashionable hotspot, La Petite Maison keeps its return guests satisfied with a delicious roster of regional specialties. The Provençal menu, based on a "sharing" philosophy, includes dishes like stuffed Mediterranean vegetables, Niçoise salad, salt-crusted sea bass, succulent veal chops, roast baby chicken with lemon, grilled eggplant with shrimps and pissaladière, a caramelized onion tart with anchovies. The mouthwatering meals are served in an airy and elegant dining room with giant windows, pale rustic wood floors, cream walls and high ceilings, that simply complement the overall feeling of comfort and ease.



L'OASIS | CREATIVE

L'Oasis is the epitome of fine dining. Imagine sitting down to a meal of lobster medallions served with salty butter, accompanied by a lobster sauce with hints of orange and basil and artisanal linguini served with a creamy seafood emulsion. The culinary gem on the menu is Mediterranean rockfish soup with saffron – an authentic bouillabaisse, while a curated wine list will satisfy wine connoisseurs.



MIDO | JAPANESE

When you're craving sushi while in Cannes, Mido is the place to get your fill of it. Inspired by the finest Japanese recipes, Mido offers exceptional choices of signature sushi and other fish dishes prepared with care and delicacy. The sashimi, nigiri and gunkan taste like they are fresh catch-to-table. In addition to fish, the Wagyu beef is delicious. You must try the black cod spring rolls and the royal maki otoro caviar.



MAMO MICHELANGELO | ITALIAN

It seems celebrities like to frequent Mamo in Antibes, perhaps in part to chat with owner and restaurateur Peppino Mammoliti. The restaurant is best known locally as "Chez Mamo," and everyone who passes through its doors is seated in one of four cozy rooms. It is in the old cellar of the Domaine d'Ott with old stones steeped in history that you can taste the famous truffle raviolinis, the excellent spalla d'agnello (lamb shoulder grilled over a wood fire), grilled rabbit with herbs or the unforgettable truffle focaccia. For dessert try the tiramisu or a slice of lemon pie!




LES VIEUX MURS | HAUTE FRENCH


LA COLOMBE D'OR | FRENCH CLASSIC





MARCHÉ FORVILLE

For a different kind of shopping experience with a very local feel, Marche Forville, is the gastronomic heart of the town. Cannes' large covered market is near the Old Port boardwalk and at the foot of the ancient neighborhood of Le Suquet. It is a local institution. With seasonal vegetables, fish (fresh off the boat) and handmade local delicacies, there's plenty to choose from. Pick up some fresh fish, meat, vegetables and fruit and have LVH arrange a private chef to create a feast for you when you get back to your home.



THE BOULEVARD LA CROISETTE

One of the eternal places for haute couture shopping in Cannes is, without a doubt, Boulevard la Croisette. It exudes a unique mix of luxury and delight along its three kilometres. This boulevard is home to a dizzying array of high-end designer shops tucked in between an equal number of famous and very exclusive hotels. The lovely palm-lined promenade, set on the doorstep of the Bay of Cannes 9, is a true Mecca of luxury shopping – shoes and views, what more could you ask for? This famous boulevard is where the largest designer houses, like Dior, Chanel and Yves-Saint-Laurent, have chosen to set up shop and jostle for your attention, many represented with flagship stores. Unmissable leather brands such as Lancel, Vuitton, Fendu, Gucci and Hermès will meet your accessory needs, and jewellers aren't left out either, with Cartier, Chopard and Ferret, among others.



RUE D'ANTIBES

Rue d'Antibes stands like a jewel in Cannes' shopping crown. Parallel to the Croisette, It vies with the boulevard, offering a myriad of beautiful shops: perfumeries, jewellers, florists, fashion boutiques, confectionery, tea rooms, beauty institutes and interior design shops. All of France's favourite High Street names are there. The best confiseries or chocolatiers and delicatessens are on Rue d'Antibes. One of the most adored bakeries in all of France, Ladurée, stands out like a beautiful green beacon of hope for all macaroon lovers on 79 Rue d'Antibes.



BATHROOM GRAFFITI

High-end, unique gift ideas are teeming at Bathroom Graffiti. The shop has become the concept store in Cannes prescribing trends for 40 years. Here, you can find everything from art deco prints to books on popular luxe destinations like Cannes, Miami, Mykonos and St. Tropez. The sweet Lucie Kaas coconut wood figurines of Coco Chanel, Karl Lagerfeld and Frida Kahlo are worth consideration.




CANNOLIVE

POTTERY & CERAMICS FROM VALLAURIS

A listed "Town of Artisans" thanks to its internationally-renowned ceramics tradition, Vallauris overflows with creativity and attracts crowds of talented artists. Pottery has been made there since ancient times. The area grew as a pottery centre in the late 19th century, and many companies have flourished there since then, notably those of Massier and Foucard–Jourdan. Modern Vallauris is lead–glazed earthenware, often highly coloured; the Mediterranean location sometimes showing its influence. Domestic tableware and cooking pots feature prominently.



Both seasoned and fledgling collectors will discover the great names of modern art, some post-impressionist treasures and favorite contemporaries at Galerie Hurtebize.



GALERIE NEEL

Located close to Croisette, the Galerie Neel excels in exhibitions of contemporary art spread across several mediums such as sculpture, painting and photography. In the past, the gallery has played host to artists such as Michael Rauscher, Enrique Etievan and Yves Aubry, among several others. If you're a collector you just might find the one piece here that will add immense emotional worth to your collection.



BEL-AIR FINE ART GALLERY

Founded 20 years ago, Bel-Air Fine Art is now established as one of the leading contemporary art galleries group in Europe. The group has settled 22 exhibition spaces in the most prestigious locations in Switzerland, France, Italy, Belgium and United States. Bel-Air Fine Art is followed by more than 30.000 art lovers, including 10,000 active collectors around the world. While you're strolling around Cannes looking for "the art to wash away the dust of everyday life from the soul" pay a visit to Bel-Air Fine Art gallery.



CENTRE D'ART LA MALMAISON

This museum, located on the popular La Croisette, is a well-liked spot for art lovers. With different exhibitions showing annually, La Malmaison has seen the traffic of big names in the art industry. Ozenfant, Matisse, and the undeniable Picasso are the most prominent of the honored artists. The building used to be a hotel built in the 1860s.



GALERIE VIECELI

If you're into contemporary, pop, or street art or perhaps works of the masters, then you must open the door to Galerie Vieceli. The gallery showcases works of significant artists of the 20th century and today's emblematic French artists. Among the artists represented here are Loilier, Oscar Rabine, Fusaro, Taupin, and Bernard Buffet.




GALERIES BARTOUX

Galeries Bartoux is an international group with 18 galleries in France, Monaco, London, New York and Miami representing a whole new generation of artists. The artistic approach is to interact with you by opening a window on new and exciting cultural values. Galleries are open spaces for collectors and those passionate about art. The Bartoux Galleries are open spaces of exchange and meeting between passionate people from often different horizons. 
The villa and grounds are influenced by Italian style and were built in 1934 on land Jean-Gabriel Domergue bought at the end of Avenue de la Californie. Domergue designed the building and its interior design down to the last detail while his sculptor wife created the terraced gardens with ponds and waterfalls. Jean-Gabriel Domergue died in 1962 and Odette Maudrange-Domergue left the property to Cannes Town Hall in 1973. The gardens are magical and a must-see while in Cannes.






MUSEUMS

There is enough history and culture in Cannes to keep you busy for days if you so choose. Museums provide rich fodder for thought. Not only Cannes – but the entire French Riviera – is full of wonderful places and attractions, and among them, museums that signify the importance of arts and culture in the region. The list of artists who have painted the Riviera reads like a Who's Who of 20th century art. Picasso, Chagall, Renoir, Bonnard, Matisse, Braque, Cocteau, Dufy, Leger, and many others lived and worked here and raved about the region's wonderful light. Many of the museums were designed to blend pieces with the surrounding views, gardens. In this list, we will take you on a journey to the best art museums in and around Cannes.






THE UNDERWATER MUSEUM OF CANNES

Off the coast of the island of Sainte-Marguerite, you'll find one of the world's only underwater art installations – the underwater "Eco Museum," by award-winning British artist Jason deCaires Taylor. The six sculptures in this permanent installation are constructed using pH-neutral, environmentally-sensitive materials to instigate natural growth and the subsequent changes intended to explore the aesthetics of decay, rebirth and metamorphosis. The location is now cordoned off from boats, making it a safe place to dive. Located just off the shore it is easily accessible for anyone who wants to see it.



MUSEUM OF THE SEA

Museum of the Sea or Musée de la Mer or Museum of the Sea is located in the exceptional natural site of the Île Sainte-Marguerite, the largest and wildest of the Lérins islands, the museum offers visitors collections based on underwater and land archeology. Collections are housed in the former Vauban-type Fort Royal, which once protected the bay of Cannes from barbarian attacks and attempted invasions.



CASTRE MUSEUM

Castre Museum (Musée de la Castre) is home to a wide collection of antiquities, particularly from the Mediterranean and the Middle East. Situated in a medieval castle atop Le Suquet, the chateau itself is a historical monument. The art collections and objects from Oceania, the Himalayas and the Americas are presented in small rooms surrounded by gardens. The 12th century Saint Anne Chapel houses a remarkable collection of musical instruments from Asia, Africa, the America, and Oceania. A few rooms dedicated to 19th century Provencal paintings of Riviera landscapes open out onto the courtyard and a square tower displaying spectacular views.




THE MACM - MOUGINS MUSEUM OF CLASSICAL ART

The MACM, the Mougins Museum of Classical Art (Musée d'Art Classique de Mougins) is an art museum located in the village of Mougins and not only does it boast an impressive and diverse collection of antiquities including Roman, Greek and Egyptian sculpture, vases, coins, and jewelry but also the world's largest private collection of ancient arms and armor. These ancient artworks are interspersed with classically inspired paintings, drawings, and sculptures by artists such as Picasso, Matisse, Chagall, Dufy, Cézanne, Rodin, Dali, Andy Warhol, Marc Quinn, Antony Gormley, and Damien Hirst, to name but a few.



MAGNELLI MUSEUM - CERAMICS MUSEUM AT VALLAURIS CHATEAU

Here you have three museums in one: The Château de Vallauris, formerly the Abbaye de Lérins priory, was rebuilt in the 16th century and is one of the region's very few Renaissance-era buildings. It is home to the "War and Peace" National Picasso Museum in the Romanesque chapel and the Magnelli Museum and the Ceramics Museum. Alberto Magnelli (1888–1971) was a contemporary of Picasso, a painter from Florence and pioneer of abstract art. Upon the artist's death, Susi Magnelli, his widow, donated the collection to the museum in Vallauris. The magnificent Renaissance-era staircase leads to the Ceramics Museum on the first floor. Split into several rooms, this museum helps visitors understand how ceramics and pottery in Vallauris developed through its key periods.






In Antibes, the Grimaldi Castle was turned into the Picasso Museum in 1966. In 1946, Picasso, who was living nearby in Golfe-Juan with Françoise Gilot, accepted an offer to set up his studio in the Castle. Picasso created many works, sketches and paintings here, including Les Clés d'Antibes (The Keys of Antibes), covering an entire wall surface. When he decided to move back to Paris, he left 23 paintings and 44 sketches in the castle's custody. Various donations and purchases as well as the custody pieces conferred by Jacqueline Picasso, have significantly enriched the collection.



FERNAND LÉGER NATIONAL MUSEUM

After more than half a century of existence, the Fernand Léger National Museum in St. Paul de Vence is a place of reference for the work of this artist. Throughout the year a rich program of exhibitions, lectures, film screenings and educational workshops are offered to visitors. The building has a huge mosaic facade, originally planned by Leger for decorating the stadium in Hanover, but never realized. On the evening of May 13, 1960, a unique event inaugurated the museum Fernand Léger in Biot. More than 5,000 guests attended the opening of the first monographic museum in the region. Under the patronage of Picasso, Braque and Chagall, the inauguration brought together celebrities from the literary and artistic worlds, film stars and politicians.



THE MAEGHT FOUNDATION

La Fondation Maeght is the early 1960s brainchild of some of the most well-known names of 20th century European sculpture, including Joan Miro, Georges Braque and Alberto Giacometti – along with visionaries, publishers and art dealers Aimé and Marguerite Maeght. The foundation has become France's most important and is a global leader in cultural institutions. La Fondation Maeght is not a museum. It's an exceptional place for modern art and has one of the largest collections in Europe of works by renowned 20th century figures including Pierre Bonnard, Georges Braque, Alexander Calder, Marc Chagall, Diego Giacometti, Wassily Kandinsky, Barbara Hepworth, Fernand Léger, Joan Miró, Pierre Tal Coat, Germaine Richier, and Raul Ubac.







Emblematic painter of Impressionism Auguste Renoir was also a sculptor who lived for many years at Domaine des Collettes in Cagnes-sur-Mer, on the French Riviera and that is where, Renoir Museum (Musée Renoir) is situated. A visit to the Renoir Museum, established in this residence, allows you to discover the atmosphere in which the artist lived during his last years. The works on display and the rooms where Renoir lived and worked, make this museum an exceptional place with an intimate vibe.



MARC CHAGALL MUSEUM

The Marc Chagall Museum is located on the Cimiez hill, in Nice. The building, opened to the public in 1973 under the strict supervision of Chagall, who was living in the village of Saint-Paul de Vence. The artist donated the artworks which form the core of the collection and was directly involved in the creation of the building's decorative apparatus. The strong connection between architecture and collection and Chagall's involvement is also visible in the large decorative windows of the auditorium and in the mosaic overlooking the museum's pool. The museum's collection is made of donations by Chagall himself; whereas the centerpiece of the collection is the famous Bible Cycle (aka Biblical Message), consisting of seventeen paintings – depicting the Genesis, the Exodus and the Song of Songs – made by Chagall in the early 1950s. Over time, the museum's collection has been expanded through acquisitions and bequests making it one of the world's largest collections exclusively focused on Chagall's works.





Once you've hit the town, there can be no doubt Cannes is one of the foremost places for exclusive and indulgent nightlife. Come sundown, Cannes seemingly bursts at the seams with life and excitement. It's in the darkness that the real glamor and sophistication of this gorgeous city presents itself. Whether you're looking for the dulcet tones of a piano bar or a shoulder-to-shoulder packed to the rafters bar brimming with locals, you're sure to find exactly what your mood is craving. These venues have savvy mixologists creating inventive cocktails and also have a wide variety of wine and beer. Dress beautifully and step out of a luxury vehicle, immaculately coiffed, into some of the most glitzy clubs in the world. It's time to paint the town red!


THE ROOF | ROOFTOP BAR


BAR GALERIE DU FOUQUET'S CANNES | COCKTAIL BAR

The flagship cocktails of La Mome include The Freshness made from gin, Saint-Germain, rose liqueur, fresh mint leaves, cucumber and Aegean Tonic; the RawBerries with vodka, raspberry puree, lime juice, vanilla syrup, egg white; a surprise a La Mome mix; or the Mome Moineau with Champagne, Chambord, raspberry puree and vodka. Whether you're having a tête à tête or are with friends, you will appreciate this venue's very well-prepared creations.



L'ARC | POP-UP NIGHTCLUB

L'Arc, the most famous club in Paris, transits to the Côte d'Azur as a pop-up nightclub for one of the most important events in the cinema world, the Cannes Film Festival. In this luxurious and cutting-edge setting, music oscillates between festive and elegant house, mastered electro or energetic and soaring hip-hop. Just a few meters from the Palais des Festivals, L'Arc Cannes, will bring the heat to the Croisette thanks to the sound of the best DJs and create memorable parties. For two weeks, it will be the most vibrant venue. Eclectic and daring, but always tasteful and well-advised, L'Arc Paris and now L'Arc Cannes is a must for nocturnal partiers.





CHRYSTIE | NIGHTCLUB

Chrystie labels itself a bar, but it's more like a nightclub. A world-renowned bartender here runs the show with extra soul and puts the passion of an artist into his talent. If cocktail is an art, sensory delight is the paint that Jérémie uses to create a masterpiece. He seeks out new flavors and textures to craft a cocktail menu that takes you on a voyage of discovery. This place never stands still and transforms as the night goes on. Every weeknight Chrystie turns into a vibrant showcase for music, cabaret and wine tasting. It's an exciting way to get the Cannes nightlife scene buzzing.



THE SPEAKEASY | PIANO BAR

The Speakeasy piano bar and restaurant, a stone's throw from the Croisette, pulls you in and seduces you with its jazzy atmosphere. The red velvet decor creates a chic and intimate ambiance. International soul, jazz and blues artists elevate the your night out. This place is reminiscent of American speakeasies and Miss Parker's Algonquin Round Table of the prohibition era.



MARTINEZ BAR | JAZZ BAR

Martinez Bar is an old-school cocktail lounge hidden inside the Hotel Martinez. The martini-sipping clientele mingle as lounge musicians take their turns at tickling the ivory of the grand piano that has been played by Frank Sinatra. 

CANNES FILM FESTIVAL


The Festival de Cannes or the Cannes Film Festival is the piece de resistance of all film festivals. The festival's mandate is to draw attention to and raise the profile of films to contribute to the development of cinema, boost the film industry worldwide, and celebrate cinema at an international level. No other film festival is as prestigious, and none has the swagger from being held on the world-renowned Cannes' Croisette.

AMFAR GALA CANNES 2022 (CHARITY AUCTION AND PARTY)

The American Foundation for Aids Research (amfAR)'s annual fundraiser in Cannes is not to be missed. The charity gala is consistently one of the most glamorous and has the most exciting and diverse guest list of any party held in Cannes. The legendary live auction has included a trip to space with Leonardo DiCaprio, a private performance by legendary rock icons Duran Duran, a family portrait sitting with Annie Leibovitz, the opportunity to star in a short film by Karl Lagerfeld, and works from Andy Warhol, and Damien Hirst, among others.

THE FETE DE LA MUSIQUE (MARKING THE SUMMER SOLSTICE - JUNE 21)

The Fete de la Musique takes place every year on the Summer Solstice, June 21. The festival is a free-spirit event in Cannes that overflows from bars and restaurants onto the streets and includes all musical genres – from local amateur teen bands to professional classical musicians, from club DJs to traditional folk bands. All performances are free to the public and none of the artists are paid. The Fête de la Musique is now celebrated globally, known as World Music Day. Fête de la Musique is one of those nights when French authorities waive normal licensing laws, allowing the revelry to continue as long as there are people with the stamina to enjoy it.

Every summer since 1967 the French Riviera enjoys spectacular displays of lights, sounds, and colors during the Cannes Fireworks Festival (Festival d'Art Pyrotechnique Cannes). Every July and August, the bay of Cannes lights up when participants from different countries show their most artistic and majestic music and pyrotechnic fireworks performances and compete against each other. It is set to the delightful backdrop of the Mediterranean Sea. The musical track, choreography, and the symbolism of the theme all orchestrate with the feu d'artifice. The themes, set by the organizers of the show, vary each year and participants must strictly follow them.





CANNES YACHTING FESTIVAL


According to the Yachting Festival organizers, this is the most eclectic show in the world. Close to 600 boats brought in by more than 400 exhibitors are on hand for sailing enthusiasts to view. The Cannes Yachting Festival is held at two port locations: Porto/Pierre Canto – a "brokerage" area for pre-owned boats from 22 meters up. It is also the site for the "toys" and serves as the sail area with 100 large sailing boats. The Vieux Port, on the other hand, is for the nautical motor and yacht industry exhibit where you'll see large motorized yachts. This makes it the largest sailing exhibition in the world. Covered maritime shuttles connect the two ports about every 15 minutes. There is also the trade show with displays for luxury and lifestyle brands in the Luxury Gallery, inside the Palais des Festivals. All in all, this festival is a must-attend event if you're a yacht owner or a yachting enthusiast.

THE FRENCH RIVIERA MARATHON

This sporting event is one of the biggest of the marathons held all over the world. The French Riviera Marathon or Marathon des Alpes-Maritimes Nice-Cannes takes place once per year in the dreamy setting of the French Riviera, between the cities of Nice and Cannes. The 42-kilometer course offers a unique challenge, particularly around the stretch at Cap d'Antibes. The number of expected runners is more than 13,000 coming from almost 60 countries each year. Spectators and participants anticipate the incredible seaside route and the perfect Autumn climate. Palm trees, the sea, and the mountains are scenic additions to the thrill of the competition. An exhibit dedicated to running in a safe environment is also present thanks to the Running Expo Village.




Organized every two years at the Festival Palace (Palais des Festivals et des Congrès), the Cannes Dance Festival owes its international reputation to an exceptional programme, resolutely turned towards the contemporary. It is an exciting and passionate biennial; an anthology of world creations, French premieres and discoveries.





Cannes is famed for its international film festival. Its Boulevard de la Croisette, curving along the coast, upmarket boutiques and palatial hotels. It's also home to the Festival Place (Palais des Festivals et des Congrès), a modern building complete with red carpet and Allée des Étoiles – Cannes' walk of fame. And not to forget the marvelous Old Port and Le Suquet quarter with its gothic-style stone church of Notre Dame and imposing Bell Tower which beautifully adorns a postcard-perfect picture of Cannes.


The Palace of Festivals or The Palais des Festivals et des Congrès has been created to accommodate the largest festival of cinema in the world. Built in haste to host the second edition of the festival, the first building was replaced in 1982 at the place of the municipal casino, at the western end of the Croisette, near the Old Port. The Cannes Film Festival – for which the hall was created – is the cultural event with the most media coverage in the world. Only two sporting events – the Football World Cup and the Summer Olympic Games – are ahead in the media.














CYCLING & CANNONDALE MOUNTAIN BIKING


A VOYAGE/FLIGHT TO THE PORQUEROLLES ISLAND THE VILLA & FONDATION CARMIGNAC







LÉRINS ISLANDS AND ABBEY VISIT



Grasse France might be the sweetest smelling city in Europe, widely known as the perfume capital of the world. Grasse still enjoys an international reputation in the perfume industry and is the home of dozens of fragrance companies. Even the flowers used for making the world-famous Chanel N°5 are grown and harvested here. In addition to the perfume industry, Grasse also provides travelers a break from the crowded Riviera coastal towns and offers a glimpse of the real Riviera away from the tourist route. 


JAUNTS

STUNNING FRENCH VILLAGES

Not far from the grandeur what is Cannes lies a set of picturesque village know as *village perché* (perched villages). Most of them are centrifugal and roosted on hilltops, hence the umbrella name.

- ☐ Biot This quaint medieval hilltop village enchants visitors with its narrow cobblestone streets, quiet alleyways, and pleasant little squares. Built on the slopes of a steep hill it features many pedestrian staircases that lead up to viewpoints and reward visitors with lovely panoramas.
- □ St Paul de Vence –one of the most beautiful and the most visited village in France. It has been inhabited since 400 B.C., making it one of the oldest towns of the French Riviera. It has a population of about 3,500 (300 inside the old walled town). The village captivates visitors by the mesmerizing natural beauty and the art by numerous 20th century masters it harbors within its walls.
- □ Gourdon the archetype of a perched village, sitting like an eagle's nest at the end of a rocky spur, enjoying a truly exceptional panoramic view over more than 80 kilometres of coastline. It also forms a remarkably harmonious ensemble of white stone–built medieval houses, nestling around the feudal castle, all of which are beautifully restored and maintained.

The shallow depth and close proximity to shore make the site easily accessible and the crystal-clear waters provide ideal snorkelling and diving conditions.







Palm Beach is the only official kitesurfing/kiteboarding spot in the Alpes-Maritimes and the only spot in Cannes where the sports are permitted. So, Palm Beach is popular with local surfers. On good days everyone congregates at Palm Beach – you need to get there early to find space on the water. The wind whips up decent ramps, and there's even a rideable break on a shoal 300 meters offshore.











WATER

You can rent seabobs and check out the world beneath the surface. You could also use a seabob with scuba gear if you don't want to keep coming back up to the surface.

FLITEBOARD EFOIL

A fliteboard efoil is an electric-driven, fast, agile and silent hydrofoil that gives the sensation of flying over water. A fliteboard carves like a snowboard in fresh powder but with the freedom to ride anywhere, anytime, without wind or waves. It's fast, quiet, and emission-free. You won't ever forget your first time foiling. Anyone can learn, yet fliteboard is engaging for even the most experienced water sports aficionados.







A Schiller bike is designed to glide across the water to get your adrenaline going. It achieves a speed of up to 10 m/ph. Take it out for a solo spin or even better, race a sailboat and leave them in your wake. Experience the water like never before in a unique and mindful way to reconnect with nature.





JETLEV



HOVERBOARD



STAND-UP PADDLEBOARD (SUP) YOGA



TOWED BUOYS & FLYFISH


