


### **ABOUT**

Part of the government protected Parque National del Este, the seas around the island are rich in marine life with numerous species of tropical fish. But the real draw is Palmilla beach, essentially a natural offshore sandbar perfect for swimming and snorkeling, and marveling at the numerous starfish found in the waist-deep waters.


#### SBG | MEDITERRANEAN, CONTEMPORARY EUROPEAN





# ALTOS DE CHAVON - REGIONAL MUSEUM OF ARCHAEOLOGY

With a home in the stunning replica 16th century Mediterranean village of Altos de Chavon, the Regional Museum of Archaeology fits right in even though relics inside go back earlier than the 16th century. The museum focuses on artifacts and artwork from when the Dominican Republic and Haiti were known as Hispaniola. Thousands of pieces from this pre–Columbian era, excavated from the nearby region that borders the Chavon River, are housed here. Many artifacts were left behind by the Tainos, an indigenous group drastically affected by the arrival of Christopher Columbus in the late 1400s, which led to devastation for the population.





Designed like a Grecian amphitheater, this spectacular 5,000-seat open-air facility hosts concerts, and performances from Dominican and international artists. Aside from its 1982 inaugural event with Frank Sinatra live, past performances have included entertainers ranging from Juan Luis Guerra and Shakira, to Sting and Elton John.




#### **AMBER WORLD MUSEUM**

Personalized service sets this restaurant apart from the others. For dinner, try the fresh snapper. Bartenders here are top-notch with island cocktails. But overall, the atmosphere makes the place – an idyllic beachfront with ocean views, a balmy breeze, and comfortable seating make this a "must-do" restaurant.





Onno's is a restaurant/bar duo offering a wide selection of bar food such as tapas, pizza, wings, tacos. Then there are more unique offerings such as avocado fries with sriracha aioli or chicharron (pork belly with a garlic sriracha glaze). They can whip up a classic beverage like a mint julep or mai tai, but they also have their own "tiki tails" like passion, pineapple, Bacardi rum, and mango; el cielo, a mix of licor menta, Curacao, rum, and Limon. They also offer shots, wine, champagne, and beer.

People have been partying at the Genesis Nightclub since its inception in the 1970s. It is the place to go in Casa de Campo for upscale cocktails, music, and dancing. The club was revamped with a new layout, sound system, lights, and infrastructure now on par with top clubs globally. 





#### NATIONAL BIENNIAL OF VISUAL ARTS

The National Biennale of Visual Arts is one of the most important artistic events in the Dominican Republic, consisting of a large central exhibition space in the Museum of Modern Art in Santo Domingo. A panel of judges selects the winners. The event emphasizes the development and exposure of national talent and advancement in the field of artistic research. It is open to citizens and foreign artists who have been living in the Dominican Republic for a minimum of five years. Winners are featured at The Gallery in Altos de Chavon where locals and visitors can view them.





This trendy festival is a celebration and journey of discovery for cigar enthusiasts. Following a stay in Casa de Campo, cigar aficionados will journey into the heart of cigar country – Santiago de los Caballeros, about 160 miles from La Romana – to choose from several options, including cigar factory tours to General Cigar, Davidoff, Matasa, La Aurora and Tabaquisa; beer and rum factory tours; city tours; merengue lessons; seminars; sailing on a catamaran along the north coast; playing a round of golf or just relaxing in the tropical scenery and breezes of Puerto Plata beach.




#### **OUTDOOR SHOOTING CENTER**

You can have an authentic Wild West shooting experience while in Casa de Campo. Facilities include an on-site 245-acre shooting center, with more than 200 stations for trap, skeet, sporting clays, and pigeon rings. You'll also find a 110-foot tower that projects sporting clays – one of the largest in the world. Shooters of all ages and skill levels will appreciate the flexibility of the layout and the realistic conditions that simulate shooting wild games in their natural habitat. The course is designed so you can progress from station to station in tournaments or individually for a challenging and exciting activity. Experienced shooters can look forward to "Driven Shoots" which take place at Rancho Peligro, a wild bird reserve outside of Casa de Campo.





The Purdey Five Stand Shooting Facility is in the Outdoor Shooting Center. It has everything you'd want in a fun, challenging shooting experience. Featuring a line of five 'stands' for shooting, it's more exciting than trap, throws a broader variety of patterns than skeet, and is faster than sporting clays. You'll have the chance to work on shots that simulate rabbit, duck, and quail hunting.





Two are individually fenced show courts, their action viewable from the patio or the terraced, red-brick seating area. 

The Links was completely overhauled in 2012 to make it as challenging as the other courses at Casa de Campo and every bit as scenic.






This course has it all -27 holes, 7,740 yards; seven scenic cliffside holes dropping 300 feet to the Chavon River below; and breathtaking 360-degree views. No matter what your skill level, you'll enjoy this course - know that holes 12 and 15 are the most challenging par 3s in the world due to their length. But you'll be playing them on the stunning beauty of a cliffside.





The challenging Teeth of the Dog is ranked the number one golf course in the Caribbean. Its motto is, "all bite, no bark," giving you some idea how this 18 will challenge your skills. The course has been meticulously hand-carved from the rugged rock and coral of the Dominican coastline. The course is brimming with stunning natural landscapes, historical undertones, and the chance to play your best game yet!





Night golf happens at the Teeth of the Dog Driving Range every Saturday from 7–11 p.m. You'll have loads of food and drinks, golf balls that light up on impact, and a social seating area filled with LED-lit tables and chairs. Your whole family will get into this engaging activity.





There is no denying the importance of leaving our made environments for the vast expanse of nature. Imagine the lingering sense of ozone on your jacket as a marker that you've borne the elements – delight in the refreshing breeze against your face bringing with it the scents of local flora. Feel the earth sink beneath you as you stray off the beaten path to truly explore the land.





Your whole family will relish the adrenalin-rush of a zip-lining escapade. The zip lining park in Casa de Campo has 18 platforms with 12 zip lines that will have you whizzing through the air in no time. Expert guides are on hand to explain everything and hook you up to each of these crazy fun circuits. Once you get up to cable six, you can reach a speed of up to 55 km/h, cable nine is the highest, and cable 11 is the only parallel cable in the country that's 800 meters long! Also, during the circuit, you can visit the coconut house to sample fresh organic products and see how coconut oil is made.






#### **GOLF CART RIDES**

#### **SCUBA DIVING**










Basic riding lessons are available for beginners of all ages. Riders six years old and up may ride by themselves. Professionals can transform you from a beginner to an experienced rider.






#### LAS MARAVILLAS CAVE (CAVE OF MIRACLES)

The Cueva de las Maravillas (Cave of Miracles) in La Romana features ancient Dominican history in the form of about 250 Taino Indian cave paintings. To say this cave is fascinating would be an understatement. Not only will you see historic paintings, but you'll be transported to the outer-space-like surroundings of stalactites and stalagmites, most still in their drop-by-drop calcium-rich formation after thousands of years. The dim light casts an ethereal glow over the rocks and you can imagine the native Tainos running wild as their fires bathed the walls in dancing, otherworldly shadows. If you appreciate history, relish exploration and want a unique cultural experience while in Casa de Campo, the Cave of Miracles is it!





The Tabacalera de Garcia was established in 1971 It is the world's largest hand-rolled cigar factory with a long and varied history, making it an absolute must to visit for avid cigar lovers or casual aficionados. During the tour, visitors are led through the entire cigar-making process and learn all about the different types of tobacco that go into making fine cigars and how they are blended to keep a consistent flavor. The factory is enormous. Every stage of production is done by hand – the old-fashioned, traditional way.




