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




PEDASI, PANAMA

Let your days start with a stunning view of the coastline and the soothing sounds of crashing waves while you witness one of the most breathtaking sunsets over the ocean, for which the peninsula is widely known.



































CABINS FLOOR PLAN






POOL HOUSE FLOOR PLAN







LOS DESTILADEROS




PLAYA PUERTO ESCONDIDO

The shimmering coastlines of Pedasi and Tuna Coast, set on the remarkable Azuero Peninsula, are one of Panama's grandest gifts. Casa Loro is graced with a private path to Playa Puerto Escondido (reachable via footpath through manicured Casa Loro's garden). Overshadowed by grand trees and filled with the presence of local fishers, the beach only bustles during Carnival (Sunday and Monday). For a peaceful retreat, it is advised to explore Playa La Miel during this festive holiday.



PLAYA PANAMAES

With its long shoreline and nearly deserted sands, even in the high season it delivers a revered sense of seclusion and boundless space. Favored amongst families and surfers, this wild beach embodies the spirit of the Azuero Peninsula. Playa Panamaes is just 2-minute drive or a 10-minute walk from Casa Loro.




PLAYA LA MIEL

Just a ten-minute drive away lies the tranquil beach of Playa La Miel; a secret oasis with no other visitors in sight. Here, the majestic La Miel river empties into the shore, offering up the perfect opportunity for a paddle boarding or kayaking excursion through the surrounding mangrove system.









EQUESTRIAN CENTER & STABLES

On the sprawling grounds of the Azuero Peninsula, where the house and the jungle reserve meet, lies the perfect blend of old-world sporting and laid-back tropical ranch life. Six beautiful horses are housed in state-of-the-art sustainable stables, complete with an infinity edge drinking troughs that frame a staging area, as well as a dressing room with storage and showers. Pre- and post-ride, both indoor and outdoor seating areas provide the perfect place to relax. A bar and lounge are the centerpieces of this tranquil paradise, with an equestrian program designed to both support and enhance the land conservation efforts and promote the wellbeing of both the horses and the forest.





TENNIS CLUB


The gentleman's game is alive and well, with world-class acrylic hard courts beckoning a rousing dual in sublime tropical surroundings. Perfect that serve with professional instruction and re-discover the beauty of tennis cradled by the balmy sea breeze and tropical floral fragrance. Whether you're seeking some friendly or not-so-friendly competition, this traditional recreation option is an idyllic afternoon activity for your Azuero Peninsula luxury getaway. The tennis club offers a magnificent, open-air, thatched-roof space, complete with a bar and comfortable lounge furniture, hammocks, and other amenities. An acrylic hard court, categorized as medium-slow (category 2), is available and is fully equipped with rackets, new tennis balls, towels, and cold drinks and snacks. Plus, the club's locker rooms provide plenty of storage and showers for your convenience.





HORSEBACK RIDING


Soak in the beauty of Panama's Pacific coast accompanied by a noble steed. For an unforgettable exploration experience, it is highly recommend to take a horseback ride through the estate with Casa Loro's guide. Take in the stunning ocean views, discover the diverse wildlife, explore old–growth and conservation forests, and take a closer look at the farming areas and reforestation project. Starting and ending at the luxury equestrian center, this is an afternoon activity that starts at 4:30 p.m. and ends at 6:30 p.m.





GUIDED HIKING

A single journey has been known to seduce weathered adventurers with the sheer beauty of Panama's wild pacific landscapes. Embark on an unforgettable journey through the breathtaking rolling hills and lush forest of the Reserva Ecologica Panameas natural reserve. You can explore the hills, river systems, old–growth forest, reforestation areas, mangroves and coastal ecosystems using our network of over 12 miles of biking / hiking trails. This will provide a close up view of the property and the wildlife which inhabit the forest areas, including howler monkeys, iguanas, birds, caimans, and rabbits. This activity should start either at 8:00 a.m. or 4:00 p.m. Length of time will depend on your stamina. This time is recommended in order to maximize the potential of seeing animals in the wild.





CONSERVATION PROGRAM

Casa Loro, part of Reserva Ecologica Panamaes (REP), offers a unique conservation programming activity that comprises a network of trails created to both deliver an immersive experience for visitors and protect the native flora and fauna. Intended to restore and maintain the sustainability of the ecosystem, the trails give visitors the opportunity to explore and learn about the local wildlife while participating in the conservation programming activity.





SEA TURTLE RELEASE (SEASONAL)

In 2015, a sea turtle conservation project was launched that included a protected nesting area. During the nesting and hatching season (September – February) biologists work tirelessly through the night to locate sea turtles that ventured to shore in order to nest. Afterwards, the eggs are carefully relocated to a safe and secure area. Observing the incredible moment of the turtles hatching and then setting them free with the biologists is a magical experience. None have proven impervious to the charms of the Peninsula's newest and most adorable residents as they waddle from their sandy burrows to the magical moment they reach the Pacific.





BIKING

The Azuero Peninsula delivers plenty of thrills for those seeking an excursion on two wheels. A robust network of off road biking trails embodies the off-the-beaten-track spirit, with the peninsula's forested heartland brimming with surprises. Ride from the coastal lowlands through hilly rainforests, zipping past a unique ecosystem. Encounters with howler monkeys, iguanas, exotic birds, and caimans are all in a day's work as you gain a unique perspective of this natural paradise.





BIRD WATCHING

Over 136 bird species have been spotted at the reserve and you are welcomed to explore the property at your own pace. This is a self-guided activity with an access to the reserve's bird database found on the e-bird and iNaturalist apps. The best time to enjoy this activity is between January and March because in addition to spotting resident birds they will also enjoy spotting migratory birds.





SHOPPING AT STUDIO TLALLI

Studio Tlalli is a high-end design studio that produces furniture and objects made from sustainable materials harvested from the private ecological reserve – Reserva Ecologica Panameas. Their mission is to create beautiful, functional, and sustainable pieces that bring the natural world into everyday life. Only sustainably harvested wood and other natural materials such as rattan, bamboo, and jute are used. Once the materials are selected, skilled artisans at the studio craft them into unique pieces of furniture and objects. The artisans use traditional hand-building techniques such as weaving, carving, and joinery to ensure that each piece is one-of-a-kind. The end product is beautiful and sustainable pieces to last for generations to come.





PEDASI TOWN TOUR

Take a leisurely stroll through charming streets of Pedasi – home to some of the best restaurants around, adorable cafes, and even a museum dedicated to Mireya Moscoso, Panama's first and only female president from 1999 to 2004. So close to town center is an array of beaches — Playa Arenal, ideal for swimming during the 'winter' season when the waves are tame. Whereas Playa El Toro and Playa Lagarto, are a go-to beaches for an authentic experience. Excellent waves roll in making it a paradise for surfers, while rustic cabanas offer a picturesque alfresco spot.





PLAYA VENAO TOWN TOUR

Playa Venao is a quaint beach town situated along the stunning Pacific Coast. Its serene atmosphere and countless adventure opportunities make it the perfect place to surf, swim, or just lounge by the shore and marvel at the ocean's rolling waves. The surrounding jungle is rich with wildlife, giving you plenty of chances to explore. With an abundance of eateries and drinking establishments spanning the world's cuisines and cultures and warm and inviting locals, Playa Venao is an idyllic escape from the everyday hustle and bustle, offering much-needed relaxation.







SURFING & SURF LESSONS

With plenty of idyllic, pristine shores, balmy waters, and passionate teachers, the Azuero Peninsula offers idyllic conditions to perfect your technique or merely balance the board. Whether you're a novice or a weathered wave rider, a devoted team of instructors will mindfully guide your progress for optimal growth and progress. With a 10-minute stroll down Panamaes beach, you can easily find yourself in front of the villa with a beach break and strong waves perfect for playing in the whitewater and challenging the most experienced riders. Cusi, our adventure guide and surf coach, can also take you to the renowned Playa Venao, just 45 minutes down the coast, where you can expect consistent waves, making it a truly ideal spot for all surfing levels.







The Azuero Peninsula is exceptionally poised for spotting nature's most majestic marine animal. Few experiences match the beauty of seeing these gorgeous creatures in their element. It is a must–witness encounter for any anyone visiting between August and October. Just 500 meters away, they can be spotted from Casa Loro promising wondrous encounters with these colossal and dignified creatures.





KAYAKING

Move inland or head into the open sea, kayaking is the ideal activity for wrangling the Azuero Peninsula's diversity of waterways. Enjoy a thorough workout while soaking in the verdure of the region's riparian zones led by a dedicated team of guides that will ensure no part of the journey lies unfulfilled. PADDLE-BOARDING



Once the big catch is reeled in, Casa Loro's team of expert chefs prepares it to perfection, serving it up in the way you like - be it sushi or grilled - to make your fishing trip an even more memorable experience!





CORAL REEF SNORKELING

An underwater adventure awaits, riddled with electrifying marine life and rare treasures. Isla Iguana offers some of Latin America's finest snorkeling venues, bringing guests in contact with the Gulf of Panama's well-preserved coral reefs. SCUBA DIVE AT COIBA UNESCO HERITAGE SITE

Known as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Coiba National Park is a world-renowned marine reserve, just an hour away by seaplane from Panama City a bit less from Pedasi. Comprised of 38 islands, including Isla Coiba, and its surrounding Pacific Ocean waters, this special spot is protected from the damaging wind and El Niño disturbances making it the perfect place for Scuba excursions. The island is flanked by one of the most expansive coral reefs in the Americas, teeming with an abundance of marine life. The Indo-Pacific current sweeping through the Gulf of Chiriqui creates a magical underwater experience, transporting with it a profusion of Pacific tropical fish and exotic mammals – humpback whales, sharks, whale sharks, orcas, tiger sharks, sperm whales, sea turtles, angel rays, and giant schools of fish more – that you wouldn't typically find along the Pacific Coast.

Getting There

From Pedasi to Coiba Islands you need to take a propeller plane flight (\sim 1 h 30') to Santa Catalina and then a boat ride (\sim 1 h 15') from Santa Catalina in Veraguas.








SNORKELING AT ISLA IGUANA




REFORESTATION HEIGHTENS THE BEAUTY


