




CORSO ITALIA

POCOL



It holds a poignant place in history as the final resting place for countless Italian soldiers who bravely fought and lost their lives during World War I. Beyond its historical significance, Pocol also offers a wealth of recreational activities. Winter sports enthusiasts flock to this idyllic village to ski and snowboard on its renowned slopes.



FRAINA

Fraina, a locality within Cortina d'Ampezzo, sits at an elevation of 1318 meters. This quaint village is part of the province of Belluno in the Veneto region and is situated close to Coiana. The history of this area is deeply rooted in ancient legends and beliefs. For instance, Faloria, a mountain in the vicinity, was considered sacred as it was believed to be a gateway to the god Silvanus. Moreover, Fraina is thought to be one of the first human settlements in the Ampezzo valley.

One of the best ways to explore Fraina and its surroundings is by embarking on a walk through the Mandres larch forest. This easy trek takes you through verdant landscapes and brings you close to Fattoria Meneguto, an agritourism venue at the foot of the slopes that rise steeply up to Monte Faloria. The walk, which covers a distance of 2 mi and takes about 1 hour and 45 minutes, offers a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in the natural beauty of the area and learn about its ancient legends.



ZUEL

At an impressive height of 4,124 feet lies a charming corner of the Italian Alps, surrounded by breathtaking vistas and neighboring localities of Fraina and Cojana. This enchanting area, known as Zuel, is a piece of the storied fabric of Cortina d'Ampezzo's past, with its roots tracing back to the 6th century AD. Legend and drama have graced this town since its first settlements in the valley, and its modern history has been shaped by the dazzling 1956 Olympic games, the first to be televised. It boasts rich connection to the Winter Olympics, with iconic structures like the Ice Stadium and Ski Jump Trampoline Italia still standing tall. These remarkable landmarks serve as a testament to the area's enduring love for sports and its enduring allure as a premier winter destination. So come, explore the magic of Zuel, and be a part of its timeless tale of triumph and beauty.






SKI AREAS



LAGAZUOI-5 TORRI




FALZAREGO/CINQUE TORRI


PARISH CHURCH OF SAINTS FILIPPO AND GIACOMO


ASTRONOMICAL OBSERVATORY
