





GRAND TARGHEE RESORT

Grand Targhee Resort is a year-round destination on the western slopes of the Teton Mountains in the Caribou-Targhee National Forest, just a beautiful one-hour drive from Jackson Hole. A hidden skier and snowboarders' paradise, Grand Targhee Resort offers 2,602 skiable acres and Wyoming's only cat-skiing. The ski area is a paradise for powder lovers and home to an excellent trail system full of diverse and exciting terrain for all skiing abilities.



TETON VILLAGE & JACKSON HOLE MOUNTAIN RESORT

Teton Village, or just "The Village," with its distinct pioneer feel, is a small town that surrounds the base of Jackson Hole Mountain Resort (JHMR). Come winter, the resort is a paradise for skiers, especially those at the upper end of the skill spectrum. Between the daunting summit of 10,450 feet and the base of 6,311 feet, some of the finest skiing in North America happens. Ninety percent of the 133 runs are intermediate or expert! Not only is the area adored by skiers and snowboarders, but it shouldn't be ruled out as a summer destination too! The village is one of the most scenic and popular four-season recreation areas in the US. Ride the Jackson Hole Aerial Tram for an incredible view of the Tetons, valley, and surrounding mountain ranges. Local activities are at your fingertips – hiking trails, horseback riding, golf, hot air balloon rides, hunting, and float trips!




THE TOWN OF JACKSON

Jackson Hole is a magnificent western-style town between the true wilderness of Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks. This small town has a unique history shaped by original settlers in the area in the past 120 years. This spectacular town is nestled between several merging, large mountain ranges at a base elevation of slightly more than 6,000 feet. Boardwalks around the downtown area have been maintained to preserve its western character. The town's recognizable landmark is the unique square with elk antler arches on each corner. WILSON

Wilson is a charming little hamlet, a historic town where warm hospitality and numerous activities make it a must-visit destination. The town was founded in 1899 by Nick Wilson, one of Wyoming's first Pony Express couriers. It is just seven miles from the Town Square and nine miles from Teton Village, home of JHMR and world-famous alpine skiing. There are two beautiful drives to the north and south of Wilson's: Fish Creek Road and Fall Creek Road, allowing you to see another side of the town: riparian habitat, meandering streams, ranches, and lush mountain views. In Wilson, the sleepy side of the valley also proves to be one of the most charming.




SNOW KING RESORT

Nestled at the base of Snow King Mountain and conveniently located not far from Town Square, showcasing Jackson's famous antler arches, Snow King Resort boasts a location unlike any other Jackson Hole resort. It is nine miles from Jackson Hole airport and within minutes from Grand Teton National Park. With plenty of adventures to be found, Snow King aka 'Town Hill" is also the oldest ski resort in Wyoming. From the base elevation of 6,237 feet, the three lifts give you access to the 32 runs and two terrain parks spread out over 400 skiable acres. If you're looking for more things to do than just skiing and snowboarding, the only night skiing in the area is in the Snow King Resort, as is "King Tubes" — their snow tubing park, as well as a roller coaster — The Winter Cowboy Coaster with almost one mile of twists and turns. It will take you right past skiers and snowboarders as you descend the equivalent of a 45-story building.





When paired with farmstead cheese, the proper accouterments, and a glass of wine, it's a stellar way to start a meal.



IL VILLAGGIO OSTERIA | ITALIAN

Il Villaggio Osteria is a vibrant, authentic Italian restaurant nestled at the base of the JHMR. The eatery – reminiscent of the comfortable, community-focused restaurants that pepper the Italian countryside – makes you feel like you've traveled to one of Italy's hidden gems. Focusing on rustic flavors, including homemade pasta, wood-fired pizzas, salumi, seasonal salads, and wines, Il Villaggio Osteria serves Italian classics. A salumi bar, pizza oven, and cozy main dining room marry seamlessly to complement the authentic flavors of the expansive menu, while an outdoor fireplace warms during the sometimes chilly nights. Come for a quiet, relaxed lunch away from the crowds, or enjoy the bustling dining room for dinner.



SUDACHI | JAPANESE

Named for the zesty and versatile Japanese citrus fruit, Sudachi celebrates the best flavors and qualities of Japanese cuisine, driven by the desire to provide a world-class sushi experience in the small mountain town of Wilson near JHMR. Dishes, cocktails, and an environment have been created to honor the passion for freshness and sustainability. A carefully-crafted seasonal menu features the edomae (fish and rice: nigiri, sashimi, maki, and temaki) or the sosaku (creative; fish plus other ingredients to enhance flavors). On offer are many izakaya-style (Japanese pub) fried, pan-seared, and salad dishes, too.






AMANGANI GRILL I AMERICAN




BISTRO AT THE CLOUDVEIL | AMERICAN

Enjoy a large outdoor terrace during the long summer nights or warm up in the cozy main dining room in winter.



LOCAL | AMERICAN STEAKHOUSE

Local is a modern American steakhouse and bar in the town square. The menu features both classic and specialty cuts of locally-ranched meats and game alongside fresh seafood, shellfish, house-ground burgers, and seasonally-inspired food. Owned and operated by chef Will Bradof of Trio: An American Bistro and his wife, Jennifer, Local also features an extensive wine list and an abundance of locally-sourced products. The restaurant is the perfect spot to grab a burger for lunch or to have drinks and dinner with friends.





Settled on King Street in downtown Jackson, this log cabin is decorated with fish-inspired art and serves pressed sushi, specialty sashimi, and creative house rolls like the JuJu, with green apple, avocado, hamachi, and smoked sea salt. The décor includes three-dimensional paintings on the ceiling, booths of tapestry and leather, and a double fireplace of moss-rock and log walls. Seasonal creations and artistic delights may include seared venison carpaccio, Australian sea bass, and tender steak. THE RESTAURANT @ WHITE BUFFALO CLUB | STEAKHOUSE




ALPYN BEAUTY

Alpyn Beauty became the first and only skincare line to sustainably harvest wildcrafted ingredients directly from the source at Jackson Hole and infuse them into skin care products. 

Myers enjoys experimenting with unique flavor combinations to surprise folks with creative dishes, while Baki has an incredible background in baked goods and is the mastermind behind Provisions' secret donut recipe.



WOMENFOLK

Womenfolk is a local consignment store stocked with gently-loved vintage wares (fringed leather pants, chambray shirts, Fair Isle sweaters, and cowboy boots). Clothes are sourced and curated from vintage designer clothing from around the town. You might stumble upon pieces like an Isabel Marant shearling coat and a never-been-worn pair of Montelliana snow boots. Clothes displayed in Womenfolk and their style can be described as "functional but also sentimental," as the owners say. Since vintage clothing is a form of self-expression – it has sentimental value that accrues over lifetimes even as their tag value decreases.





The visionary and owner of the prestigious Tayloe Piggott Gallery, Tayloe Piggott, has created a collector's jewelry box of sorts, seeking out the most exciting and alluring designs from the world's top jewelry designers. Part of her bright and light-filled gallery features a thoughtful curation of fine jewelry (Monique Pean, Gabriella Kiss, Eria Cortney, Nicholas Varney, Todd Reed, Victor Velyan, and Bibi van der Velden). The owner believes gemstones adorn the canvases offered by precious metals like the paints of an artist's palette. Whether fine art or jewels, Tayloe's selections weave together a picture of modern luxury and timeless style.





Items in the shop are a smartly curated collection of women's clothing and accessories that truly capture the town's easy, cozy sensibility. There are racks of Re/Done T-shirts that you'll live in year-round, super soft cashmere from Elder Statesman, perfectly faded Frank and Eileen chambray, and one-off hats by milliner Nick Fouquet. 


STIO MOUNTAIN STUDIO

As a town rooted in year-round outdoor pursuits, it's no surprise that a mountain lifestyle gear store like Stio opened. It is a store with an adrenaline-seeking, active customer in mind. Stio was launched in 2012, and the line has grown to include men's, women's, and kids' items, making it a one-stop shop for recreation. The sustainably-produced line runs the gamut from more hard-core waterproof gear to merino wool hoodies and thin down jackets you can wear to and fro around town or layer under a heavy-duty shell on the mountain. The line is sold only online or at the flagship location in town. The chances of someone having the same ensemble are slim.





Mountain Dandy is a locally-owned shop located on Pearl., The shop features a wide array of handmade and vintage items with a masculine aesthetic. Pieces add distinguished character to any environment. A selection of some favorite items is available through their online store. Visit to see the complete collection of men's and household items.





Bodega is a one-stop shop offering a vast assortment of craft beer and Jackson's own Roadhouse brews, carefully selected wines from around the world, and a complete collection of spirits. There are also plenty of fancy gourmet condiments, cheeses, charcuterie, bovine and swine sausages, and more to fill your pantry. It's a good pit stop on your way from the mountain back into town, especially if you're staying in a house or condo with a group. In warmer months, a food truck, selling fried chicken sandwiches and tacos is parked outside.






NATIONAL MUSEUM OF WILDLIFE ART

With a collection of more than 5,000 cataloged works of art, this museum strives to strengthen humanity's relationship with nature through its collections, exhibitions, research, educational programs, and publications. The museum includes work by artists such as Georgia O'Keeffe, Andy Warhol, and Robert Kuhn, holding more than 5,000 years of history. The beautiful building housing the museum is on a butte overlooking the 20,000-acre National Elk Refuge and is en route to Grand Teton National and Yellowstone National Parks. You'll stand face-to-face with lifesize sculptures on the museum's outdoor trail, taking in vistas of the National Elk Refuge, and experience the wildlife of the world through the art of all mediums in the curated collection and exhibits.



VISIT MAMA MIMI AT R PARK

Troll like a local and visit "Mama Mimi" at Rendezvous Park. Thomas Dambo, Danish artist and recycling activist, led a team of workers to build a wonder in R Park in Jackson Hole for all the enjoy. A giant troll emerges from the banks of Rendezvous Park's (R Park) pond to engage and delight all who visit. The troll – officially named "Mama Mimi" – was built by the artist, produced by Jackson Hole Public Art, and hosted at Jackson Hole Land Trust's community conservation property, R Park. The "Mama Mimi" installation was created from locally sourced recycled and renewable materials. "Mama Mimi" is the 80th addition to the larger family of trolls scattered throughout the United States and the world. You can learn how these "art trolls" are interconnected in Dambo's global fairytale, "The Great Story of the Little People," at trollmap.com.



WILCOX GALLERY

Wilcox Gallery is not one but two fine art galleries representing 50 of the most well-known artists in western art with more than 6,000 square feet of fine art on display, established in 1969, The gallery is the home and bears the name of the renowned landscape painter, Jim Wilcox. He opened his first gallery more than half a century ago to showcase his work and that of kindred artists, those who focus on the traditional landscapes and wildlife of Wyoming and the rest of the outdoor world. An innovative and extensive collection with a serene atmosphere sets this gallery apart. A trip to either of the Wilcox Galleries gives people a chance to see views of the Tetons and Yellowstone National Park, bear and moose, American Indians, and a variety of other typically Western scenes.




TAYLOE PIGGOTT GALLERY

Tayloe Piggott Gallery defines its artistic program through the work of modern and contemporary artists and world-class jewelry designers. Specializing in modern and contemporary art, Tayloe Piggott Gallery expresses a sharp appreciation for exceptional aesthetic vision. The gallery showcases sophisticated, unique artworks in a modern setting. Mindful and thought-provoking, Tayloe Piggott Gallery aims to enrich cultural dialogue by bringing remarkable artists into a flourishing arts community. HORIZON FINE ART GALLERY

Located one block from Town Square, Horizon Fine Art Gallery showcases the finest in western art, as well as Contemporary and International art, portraying all facets of the west and beyond. At Horizon Fine Art Gallery, you'll find paintings, photography, and art depicting breathtaking scenes of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks and its diverse wildlife of bears, buffalo, moose, and more, as well as landscapes and scenes from around the world. The gallery features both well–known and emerging artists whose mediums include painting, sculpture, ceramics, wood carving, jewelry, and more. You are invited to marvel at the beauty and vision of represented artists and to take a little bit of that vision home with you.



PUBLIC ART

Jackson Hole Public Art places temporary and permanent artworks and produces community-minded, artist-driven projects for public spaces. In 2019 the valley was named the number-one small arts community in the nation. While the valley has had art galleries since the 1960s and the National Museum of Wildlife Art since 1987, its public art is an equally important part of the art scene. Many large- and small-scale pieces, abstract and realistic, temporary and permanent live throughout the valley. Public art invigorates and transforms, welcoming locals and visitors to a collective experience that builds rapport. Some of the noteworthy previous temporary and permanent public art exhibitions include:

- Finders Keepers Patrick Dougherty is an American environmental artist best known for his sculptures and installations built with sticks and saplings. Finders Keepers is a site-specific sculpture constructed over three weeks with the help of many local volunteers.
- Sculpture Trail The National Museum of Wildlife Art has this three-quarter-mile art installation with about 30 pieces of artwork along its length. Award-winning landscape architect Walter Hood designed the outdoor art venue.
- Art Spot The Art Spot has hosted many inspiring, curious, extravagant installations. The Art Spot invites regional artists to create site-specific installations inspiring moments of discovery and joy for the more than 30,000 daily drivers that pass by.





Known for live music, good eats, and being the best place to let loose after a day on the mountain, the Moose quickly became THE spot. The Moose has been a premiere live music venue since it opened 50 years ago. The stage has hosted rock gods and local legends and boasted a jam-packed schedule of shows each season.





One of the most popular restaurants, The Handle Bar is an American pub and beer hall with a wide selection of national and international beers, whiskeys, and provisions. It is the ideal spot for hungry skiers and travelers. Set inside the Four Seasons Hotel in Teton Village, you will discover why it's a favorite apres ski venue once you step inside.



THE SPUR | COCKTAIL BAR

Inside the Teton Mountain Lodge & Spa hides The Spur, a bar that welcomes guests with a dedicated team, offering an unmatched experience in a vibrant atmosphere. It has been named "The Place to Après," by *SKI* magazine and is a local hot spot any day of the week. Enjoy its heated, covered patio or relax inside by the fire and enjoy one of several local brews on tap or a signature cocktail from Spur's amazing mixologists.




ZINC BAR @AMAGNANI | COCKTAIL BAR

With its rugged sandstone columns, redwood paneling, and panoramic views over the snowfields, the Zinc Bar is an intimate and atmospheric aprés ski destination. Locally brewed beer and spirits distilled in the area are highlights of the drinks menu, and the bar team is renowned for their seasonal creative cocktails, such as the huckleberry martini and the spicy hibiscus margarita.



THE MILLION DOLLAR COWBOY | BAR

The historic Cowboy Bar with the iconic neon cowboy on the roof is a must-stop. Wyoming's landmark watering hole, The Million Dollar Cowboy Bar, is in the town square. The Million Dollar Cowboy Bar is a unique Western drinking and entertainment venue established in 1937. True to its name, this bar is no ordinary one. The museum-like space is covered from floor to ceiling in genuine cowboy memorabilia, from wildlife mounts to cowboy murals, original wrangling equipment, knobbled-pine details, and genuine saddle barstools. The bar is internationally famous for its country-western line dancing and live entertainment. World-renowned musicians like Waylon Jennings, Hank Williams Jr., Glen Campbell, and even Willie Nelson have graced the stage. Few places in the world can compete with the authentic experience at the Million Dollar Cowboy Bar.



THE ROSE | COCKTAIL BAR

This unique venue – a swanky New York–style cocktail lounge that meets Southern ski bum, opened in 2012. The idea of a craft cocktail bar was to bring a taste of a city different from the current nightlife offerings to Jackson. New hip restaurants were opening, and the town needed a bar to match it. The Rose was the first craft cocktail bar attached to a music venue in the country. The quality of cocktails has remained up par while the bar has become a local spot to experience local culture and events. If you're looking for fun culture and exceptional cocktails, the Rose is your go–to destination.



SNAKE RIVER BREWERY

Snake River is Wyoming's oldest and largest craft beer brewery. It prides itself on crafting world-class beers to match the world-class scenery that surrounds it. A magnet for many awards at national and international competitions, Snake River makes a bevy of tasty brews. Located less than a half mile from Town Square in a concrete, steel, and glass building, this large, bright two-story venue enjoys a remodeled interior putting diners and imbibers right in the middle of the brewing experience with a monumental copper mash tun taking center stage.



ROADHOUSE BREWING

The Roadhouse Brewing Co. was founded in 2012 by Homebrewer/Entrepreneur Colby Cox and noted Chef/Restaurateur Gavin Fine over a passion for craft beer and craft cuisine. It said of the Roadhouse Brewing Co. that it "captures the soul of Jackson Hole in every beer they produce." In 2017, Roadhouse Brewing Company expanded into its current state-of-the-art brewing facility, located just outside the downtown core. They also recently opened a new restaurant – Roadhouse Pub & Eatery, showcasing the brewery's flagship beers paired with locally-sourced, seasonal gastropub cuisine.






BIN 22 | WINE BAR





A VISIT TO JACKSON HOLE WINERY

Jackson Hole Winery was founded in 2009 when Anthony Schroth, a winemaker based in both California and Wyoming, came up with the maverick concept — to explore the benefits of making wine at high altitudes. Jackson Hole Winery sits at the base of the Grand Teton Range at 6,229 feet and is one of the highest–altitude wineries in North America. Today, the winery produces about 4,000 cases of wine made from premium grapes grown by the winemaker Anthony Schroth in Sonoma County, California. Upon harvest, the grapes are transported immediately to Jackson Hole, where they are crushed, fermented, pressed into the wine, and left to barrel age. The cool alpine air slows fermentation and aging, cultivating distinctive personality and potent aromatics, resulting in award–winning wines with 18% less oxygen. Tasting tours are by appointment only.





World-class terrain lies just outside the boundaries of JHMR. Skiers and riders from far and wide yearn to explore this visually striking, accessible landscape. JHMR expert backcountry guides cultivate a safe and joyful learning environment, giving you the confidence and knowledge to exceed the boundaries of what you thought was possible on snow.



SNOWCAT ADVENTURES IN GRAND TARGHEE

One of the things that makes Grand Targhee stand out is its cat skiing. On Peaked Mountain, they have more than 600 acres set aside for it. Each of the two snowcats has room for ten passengers. You can grab an individual seat, or you and nine friends can book a cat to yourselves and enjoy the open bowls and steep tree pitches to your heart's content. Don't miss one of the greatest thrills in North America and the best cat skiing in Wyoming.





Replete with natural wonders, pristine watersheds, and abundant wildlife, these woods are an ode to the sublime. TETON NATIONAL PARK

Grand Teton National Park spans a wondrous 126,000 hectares of enchanting alpine valleys, boundless mountain meadows, and crystalline lakes before the serrated peaks of a majestic mountain range. Guests are transported back in time to the furthest bounds of the American frontier, with spellbinding landscapes evoking epic legends of Indigenous tribes and early American explorers. 
The National Elk Refuge was established in 1912 after Stephen Leek's photography inspired public interest in preserving a part of the traditional winter range of the area's elk population. Today thousands of elk winter in the refuge just north of Jackson. Elk migrate out of the high meadows in the fall, usually after the first snowstorm. They stay in the refuge through the spring when food becomes more abundant.



HOT SPRINGS

The area around Jackson Hole is famous for its national parks and abundance of wild rivers. Other Incredible features of America's west and its natural surroundings are numerous hot springs, including several in this area. There are also a few natural mineral pools near the Teton Pass in Idaho. Some notable hot springs within easy reach from your vacation homes are::

- Granite Hot Springs set at 7,000 feet above sea level, the springs treat visitors to a fantastic view while relaxing in the ultimate forest thermal baths, just an hour from Jackson. The Granite Hot Spring pool is an artificial structure built in 1933 filled with soothing, steamy natural mineral waters that average 93°F in the summer and 112°F in the winter. Tucked away in the Gros Ventre Mountains, in winter months, access to Granite Hot Springs is limited to cross-country skiers, snowmobiles, and dog sleds, adding to its appeal.
- Astoria Hot Springs a beautiful natural swimming area with five manufactured pools filled with natural thermal water. Set on the Snake River, the pools have different temperatures, with the children's one being the coolest and the shallowest at two feet deep. Astoria Hot Springs is one of the area's most unique attractions and caters to families and outdoor enthusiasts alike.





LANDMARKS

Every destination has unique monuments and landmarks. That's part of the allure of travel. Whether your vacation takes you to exotic mountainous terrains or areas replete with sand dunes, bustling urban centers or rural backcountry, the symbolism and power of landmarks put a strong and indelible mark on your vacation. Here are a couple of distinctive ones in and around Jackson Hole.



LANDMARKS

MORMON ROW

Thinking of Wyoming and Jackson Hole immediately paints a mental image of the Grand Tetons and Mormon Row. It is one of the unmissable landmarks in the area. The four-mile stretch includes 27 homesteads and ranch houses known as Antelope Flats in the valley, which a group of Mormons in the early 1900s called home. This historic district in Teton County is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It has become an icon to landscape photographers and fine art painters from around the world. There's hardly a photo gallery in Jackson Hole without a picture or a few of a Moulton barn or Chambers homestead.



LANDMARKS



The Gondola opened at the start of the 2016–17 winter season offering greater access to the Casper Mountain area, including many intermediate and beginner trails. The gondola provides a fast two-minute ride to mid-mountain in a covered conveyance, making it easy for skiers and snowboarders to access this terrain right from the base.



LANDMARKS

THE AERIAL TRAM

The Jackson Hole Aerial Tram in Teton Village is the gateway to your national park experience. Known to locals as "the box," "the red heli," or "big red," the Aerial Tram can carry 100 people to the top of Rendezvous Peak (10,450 feet) in just 12 minutes! Before docking at the top of the mountain, the tram passes directly above to view one of the most challenging ski runs at Jackson Hole — and maybe even in the world — Corbet's Couloir! 
THE TOWN SQUARE ELK ANTLER ARCHES

A visit to downtown Jackson won't be complete without seeing and walking through Town Square and the historic elk antler arches. The four iconic arches guarding the corners of the town's George Washington Memorial Park, more commonly called the Town Square, have become well-known to many visitors. They've been featured in thousands of family photos over the years. The arches are built entirely from local elk antlers. Each arch, weighing 14,000 pounds or comprising more than 2,000 antlers, is supported by a steel framework and constructed by hand. The arches are held together mostly by friction and gravity and must be rebuilt about every 50 years.


ELKFEST

Every spring, thousands of elk wintering on the National Elk Refuge lose their antlers before they migrate to their summer range. The Boy Scouts assist the refuge with harvesting the shed antlers and auctioning them to bidders from around the world who make furniture, wall decorations, jewelry, and food products from them. This annual event, which includes the High Noon Chili Cook-Off and the Mountain Man Rendezvous kick-off, supports the National Elk Refuge, with a large portion of auction proceeds returning to habitat enhancement refuge projects.




WILD WALLS


THE TOWN SQUARE SHOOTOUT




GETTING THERE

BY AIR

Jackson Hole Airport has a runway length of 1,920 meters (6,300 feet). The runway length is suitable for all aircraft types, but only stage III jets are allowed to land at the airport due to noise restrictions. There is a dedicated private jet charter terminal at Jackson Hole Airport.

There are also a couple of airports, all within a 50-mile radius of the city. They are:

- Kinky Creek Divide Airport (Dubois, Wyoming),
- Alpine Airport (Alpine, Wyoming),
- Star Valley Ranch Airport (Thayne, Wyoming), and
- Driggs-Reed Memorial Airport (DIJ) (Driggs, Idaho).
