### **ABOUT**



#### **SKI RESORTS**

Lake Tahoe is home to some of the most famous ski resorts worldwide. Beautiful views, exciting slopes, and an average daily maximum winter temperature of 45° F (7.2°C) make Lake Tahoe a perfect destination for winter sports. Every Lake Tahoe ski area has its unique personality and attractions. The concentration of Lake Tahoe ski resorts in California and Nevada (a total of 15) may make it difficult to choose the best one for you. Nevertheless, more popular resorts we recommend include:

They all offer sunny skies, excellent snow conditions and gorgeous scenery. Some resorts offer more family fun off the ski hills than others.






#### **NORTHSTAR-AT-TAHOE**

Northstar Ski Resort sits at the north side of Lake Tahoe, on an extinct volcano. A staple for ardent skiers, Northstar California offers unmatched park-style skiing, on-mountain champagne toasts, and a virtual mountain assistant called Emma, an Al assistant eager to answer your every mountain query. With more than 3,000 acres for 100 impeccably groomed runs accessed by 20 lifts, Northstar attracts many. There are quite a few beginners and intermediate-level runs here for ski newbies, making it a family-friendly ski resort. Northstar is also known for its snowboarding terrain parks, including The Straits for a variety of jumps and Pinball for boarders who like jibs. The tradition of après-ski at Northstar is one of pure freedom. They have dedicated the entire lower level of the village to moments created around the après scene.




### **DIAMOND PEAK**

Located in Incline Village, Nevada, Diamond Peak has a little something for everyone, although the stunning views of Lake Tahoe alone are reason enough to visit this fantastic destination. The mountain is teeming with opportunities for beginners with its gentle slopes and wide runs, while experts can experience the challenging terrain of Solitude Canyon. There are 655 skiable acres accessed by six lifts, with 30 runs, including fantastic tree skiing and open glades. The summit is at an elevation of 8,540 feet and it has a vertical drop of 1,840 feet, the fourth-longest drop in the Lake Tahoe area.






Homewood Ski Resort spans more than 1,260 acres on the west shore of Lake Tahoe and boasts beautiful views of the lake from every slope. Sixty breathtaking runs are immaculately groomed and protected from high-ridge winds by Ellis Peak, helping it to create some of earth's most delicate powder. Homewood is also home to two terrain parks for all levels of expertise, from beginners to future X Games competitors, and boasting stunning lake views.



#### **TAHOE PALISADES**

Palisades Tahoe (formerly called Squaw Valley Alpine Meadows) are two resorts combined into one, whose sprawling terrain amounts to a mind-boggling 245 ski runs on 6,000 acres of skiable terrain, pleasing to skiers and snowboarders of various skill levels. There are options for cross-country skiing or dog sledding for those who prefer to stay off the slopes. Tahoe Palisades brings an exciting challenge to any level of skier or snowboarder. From easy-riding progression parks to wide-open bowls, it has all. It's known for the longest snow season of any Lake Tahoe ski resort and for the powder that lingers for days. Tahoe Palisades is true to its roots of putting the skier and skiing first.



#### **HEAVENLY**

High above the sapphire-blue waters of Lake Tahoe, Heavenly Mountain Resort is in the class by itself. The resort features 34 miles of wide-open, groomed slopes, double-black-diamond canyons and the most outrageous tree skiing in North America. Straddling the border of California and Nevada, skiers can shred the gnar on a piste in Nevada and finish off in California. The views alone will take your breath away, add to that the immaculate skiing and snowboarding conditions on 4,800 acres of ski terrain, including 97 different trails accessed by 28 ski lifts and your perfect day just got better. Heavenly also offers diverse shopping opportunities, exciting nightlife, great entertainment in the Heavenly Village and nearby South Lake Tahoe's casinos and restaurants.



- 4. Spooner Lake & Backcountry Nevada State Park






Ed Z'berg Sugar Pine Point State Park is on the west shore of Lake Tahoe, along Highway 89, 10 miles south of Tahoe City. With two miles of unspoiled lakefront, the park is an example of what the lake was like so many years ago. A dense forest of juniper, pine, fir, and aspen blankets the park's 2,000 acres.






This breathtakingly beautiful park on the western shore of Lake Tahoe is just 17 miles south of Tahoe City on Highway 89 and a few miles north of Emerald Bay and covers 1,830 acres. The park has a wonderful interpretive visitor center with wildlife displays, campgrounds, beaches and hiking trails.







Inspiration Point overlooks the great sheltered cove of Emerald Bay, with its towering pine trees and water that gently laps the shore. Inspiration Point is a must spot to visit on any trip to the region. If you stand at 600 feet (180 meters) above the biggest alpine lake in North America you will definitely appreciate the peace provided by the incredible vista!





Nestled in the Lake Tahoe Basin, this state park is a widespread recreational and natural oasis with a lake surrounded by aspens and more than 12,000 acres of forested, and open space. The park features 50 miles of hiking, equestrian and mountain biking trails and primitive roads.






Lake Tahoe is known for its skiing, casinos and shopping, but it also has some very nice beaches. 

- 3. Pope Beach4. Baldwin Beach





The permanent wall utilizes auto-belays and is 25 feet tall with 15 defined climbing routes varying in difficulty, so all ability and experience levels are welcome!





Lake Tahoe offers multiple places for mountain biking. Easy rides around the lake basin or extreme terrain for adventure seekers. Tahoe houses the world famous Flume Trail, enjoyed by all levels of mountain bikers.






Enjoy incredible views of Lake Tahoe as you glide through the sky on Heavenly's two parallel 3,300-foot-long zip lines. With top speeds of 50 m/ph, this is a great way to experience the most spectacular views in the area with a starting elevation of about 10,000 feet.





South Lake Tahoe offers some of the most serene horseback riding trails for a most unforgettable trip! No need to be put off if you don't have any equestrian experience. Trail horses are calm, gentle creatures and tour guides are helpful in providing the perfect horse-rider combination for first-timers.





Get up into the Sierra Nevada Mountain Range to experience Lake Tahoe off roading. These trails such as Rubicon, Cascade Falls, Fallen Leaf Lake, and Eagle Lake offer stunning beauty whether they're easy strolls or epic day trips. 

The Rubicon Trail is a 22-mile-long route, part road and part 4x4 trail in Sierra Nevada due west of Lake Tahoe. Running alongside and above the shore of Lake Tahoe from D.L. Bliss to Eagle Point on Emerald Bay, the Rubicon Trail offers spectacular views of the cobalt blue lake; the distant mountains; and shallow, aquamarine-colored bays.


• Length: 22 miles





The Eagle Lake Trail, beginning at spectacular Eagle Falls, has several options for trail length. A good choice is the scenic trail to Eagle Lake. This is one of the most popular hikes on the southwest shore of Lake Tahoe and frequently busy, but it's definitely worth doing.

• Length: 5.5 miles





This short hike leads to a scenic inland lake with a pleasant shoreline and views of the surrounding mountains. The trail to the lake is just a simple walk, but you can extend the hike and follow the path along the shoreline to the right.


• Length: 7.7 miles





The short hike to Cascade Falls is the perfect trail for many reasons. The mountainside path is scenic the entire way, the falls are stunning, and the view over Cascade Lake is incomparable. This is just a two-mile round-trip hike with very little elevation gain, so it's not overwhelming for most children and families.

• Length: 2 miles





It may be cold outside, but winter can be a real heart warmer for special times. Many travelers just wait for the snow to fly and temperatures to plummet to get to those places where they can enjoy their favorite winter activities like skiing, heli-skiing, snowboarding, skating, tobogganing, or snowmobiling. Depending on Lake Tahoe's resort, you can find a variety of other exhilarating activities, including a Mountain Coaster, scenic gondola rides, loads of opportunities for tubing, extreme adventures like avalanche training or winter survival and much more. We'd be remiss if we didn't mention cuddling up under a blanket in a sleigh being pulled by beautiful horses or husky dogs while the moon lights the way. Imagine sitting in front of a roaring fire with a mug of hot cocoa embellished by coffee liqueur and whipped cream.





With 300 bluebird days and 400 inches of fine powder snow, gorgeous mountain scenery and a relaxed California attitude, Lake Tahoe has the ingredients for a perfect ski vacation. Lake Tahoe rests under the towering Sierra Nevada Mountain range and there are many mountains to choose from and hundreds of ski lifts to get you to the peaks. Whether you choose North Lake Tahoe ski resorts or South Lake Tahoe ski resorts, you are sure to have the time of your life, skiing through an old–growth forest and experiencing hair–raising cornices and cliffs.





Lake Tahoe is home to the highest concentration of ski resorts in the country within a 100-mile radius. Tahoe South receives nearly 300 bluebird days a year. And when it comes to snow, storms don't deposit a few measly inches. They bring in feet of snow, dropping more than 500 inches annually on Lake Tahoe's peaks. If you love snow, the sun, and a vast assortment of slopes to pick from, you'll enjoy snowboarding in Lake Tahoe.





Homewood Snowcat Adventures accesses more than 750 acres of backcountry terrain on the flanks of Ellis Peak, above the resort's traditional ski area boundary. Once transported to the peak, groups of up to 10 skiers and riders will enjoy guided access to a wide variety of terrain options – from perfectly–spaced tree runs to steeps, powder bowls and intermediate–level glades – all leading guests back to the in–bounds terrain at the resort.



#### **TERRAIN PARKS**

The feeling of the brisk wind on your face, the rush of snow beneath your skis, the feeling of freedom as you slide off your favorite jib: only a few activities can match the thrill and excitement of skiing or snowboarding in a terrain park. Northstar at Tahoe (with 9 terrain parks, including Riglet for kiddos 6 yrs and younger, Moonshine, Pinball, Pipeline, to name a few) and Sierra at Tahoe Ski Resort (with 8 in total, including Halfpipe – the only halfpipe in South Lake Tahoe – the training grounds for Olympians and World Champs) are renowned for their incredible, award–winning terrain parks. Heavenly is also worth a mention with four terrains. Groove Park is the resort's the smallest, yet the most popular, while Re–Mix is a newly opened park featuring freestyle terrain.





If you're looking for a new kind of adventure, give cross-country skiing a try. It's a different pace on cross-country skis. One that lets you get up close and personal with Lake Tahoe's forested trails, untrammeled meadows, and snowy shores.



#### **SNOWSHOEING**


Snowshoeing gets your heart pumping while you take in the majestic views, making it one of the most popular activities in Lake Tahoe. Journey through snow-covered forests as you travel into Tahoe's pristine wilderness traversing over fresh snow. Breathe crisp winter air and enjoy the solitude. Emerge from the forest and adjust your eyes to the azure waters of Lake Tahoe. The snowshoeing adventure above the shorelines might be an opportunity to observe Tahoe's wildlife, such as osprey, winter partridge, squirrels, the elusive bald eagle, and perhaps a rare glimpse of a California black bear. Here are some of the best and the most scenic snowshoeing trails to explore:

- Carson Pass






Lake Tahoe has little to no light pollution, making for some of the most vibrant night skies you'll ever encounter. Journey into the night as you travel through snow-covered forests. Enjoy the stars as they pierce through winter canopies. Traverse valleys, pass open meadows and trek along high alpine lake shorelines.





This fast-paced activity is perfect for adventuring through the backcountry of Lake Tahoe. There are plenty of snowmobiling opportunities in Lake Tahoe's North and South, so you can satisfy your need for speed anywhere around the lake!





When the snow becomes a playground, few activities sound more fun than sliding downhill on a rubber tube. Tubing is a perfect way to satisfy your inner child while playing in the snow. Squaw Valley and Heavenly Lake Tahoe are some great tubing locations.





Most people think of winter as a barren time of year, but if you have patience and a penchant for winter meditation, you can catch glimpses of some birds that come here for the season to rest, like the bald eagle and golden eagle.



#### **ICE SKATING**


Though Lake Tahoe itself doesn't freeze, there are several places in the area that give you the chance to take a break from the slopes:

- **Squaw Valley:** Besides skiing, this is one of the most popular areas for ice skating, with views of Sierra Nevada and the nearby Lake Tahoe. Here you can ice skate in places like the Olympic Ice Pavilion or the resort at Squaw Creek.
- Heavenly Village Ice Skating is an open-air skating rink in South Lake Tahoe, complete with winter decorations to make the experience that much livelier.





You don't have to ski down Lake Tahoe's mountains to enjoy the ride up. Gondola rides are a great way to experience the panoramic views of Lake Tahoe and the surrounding Sierra Nevada mountains. The Heavenly Gondola is one of the area's most picturesque, with a 2.4-mile-long ride that stops at an observation deck.





Explore Lake Tahoe's wilderness on two wheels by going down some imposing trails with a stunning backdrop. Ride through snow-covered forests, open meadows and lake shorelines as you kick it up a gear and discover all that fat bikes have to offer. Enjoy meandering trails at your own pace and get a taste of Lake Tahoe's expansive frontiers.





#### **CURLING**

The Olympic sport of curling has gained popularity over the past few years. On Sunday evenings at the Lake Tahoe Ice Arena, you can try it yourself as part of "Learn to Curl" classes.



If you want to experience Lake Tahoe's winter landscape with some furry friends, dog sledding is a perfect choice. A couple of companies offer tours of the area under the experience of a well-seasoned musher.





Lake Tahoe is home to a variety of snowpack. As a result, avalanche terrain is commonplace throughout its surrounding wilderness. With so many winter activities throughout Lake Tahoe and the surrounding regions, stories of force majeure avalanches are of no surprise. Lake Tahoe offers a rare opportunity to book an avalanche course geared toward identifying avalanche areas, stability assessment, route-finding, metamorphism and layering, as well as rescue techniques deployed in the event of an avalanche.

### **OVERNIGHT WINTER BACKPACKING**



### **HELICOPTER RIDES**


