The Grove at the LA Farmers Market is a crossover between mid-range and high-end shopping with plenty of opportunities to meet those in film and television.






The Arts District is one of the hottest neighborhoods in Downtown LA; the area resembles an open art gallery filled with murals and graffiti, each channeling a different facet of the LA way of living, the reflections of the local artists, political matters, and street art. You will experience art at every corner of this neighborhood and get to know some picturesque places.





Hollywood history permeates the exquisitely decorated Grauman's Chinese Theatre on the Walk of Fame. Designed to resemble a Chinese pagoda and guarded by a pair of Ming Dynasty lions, it has hosted more than its fair share of premieres since it opened for Cecil B. Now known as the TCL Chinese Theatre, it seats 932 and in 2013 was fitted with a custom IMAX screen – one of the largest in North America.





The Broad is a contemporary art museum built by philanthropists Eli and Edythe Broad on Grand Avenue in downtown Los Angeles. The museum is home to 2,000 works of art in The Broad Art Foundation and the Broads' collections, an exhibition that features a selection of more than 250 paintings, sculptures and photographs.





With such comfortable weather, and outdoor recreation available, it may be hard to ask for someone to swap the beach day for a museum day. Yet Los Angeles boasts access to some incredible permanent collections spanning from prehistory to the modern day. A permanent pit-stop for the world's premier traveling exhibitions, places like the Getty and Natural History Museum harbor great international acclaim. If you are looking for a cultural experience, a trip to Los Angeles is incomplete without visiting its beloved cultural institutions.

The Los Angeles County Museum of Art lays claim to being the largest art museum in the western United States, with almost 130,000 pieces spanning from antiquity through to modern times. Of particular note are the outstanding collections of Asian, Latin American, and Islamic Art.





The Petersen Automotive Museum's eye-catching new shell, designed by New York's Kohn Pedersen Fox Associates, attracts cheers and jeers. It will take about three hours to explore the museum's three floors and gawk at the 50 or so cars on regular display. Admission to all of these permanent exhibits are included with a general admission ticket: Cars of Film and TV, Cars Mechanical Institute, Alternative Power and Forza Motorsports Racing.

THE GETTY

The Getty Center in Los Angeles is a campus of the Getty Museum and other programs of the Getty Trust. It consists of a permanent collection, which includes pre–20th century European paintings, drawings, manuscripts, sculptures, and decorative arts. Besides the above–mentioned art collection, you will fall in love with the Central Garden, the Cactus Garden, the outdoor sculpture, and the knockout views.



MUSEUMS



Museum of Natural History is the largest history museum in the Western United States. The collection consists of more than 35 million specimens and artifacts. The display of extraordinary specimens is in exhibitions such as Age of Mammals, the Dinosaur Hall, the Gem, and the Mineral Hall.





Between such enviable weather and a very outdoorsy and active culture, it is no wonder that LA is home to some of the most enduring sports franchises. No force in the world seems to rally Angelinos so fervently than the Los Angeles Lakers. A potent symbol of hometown pride, there is no overstating the reach and importance of sports to the LA lifestyle. Do as the locals do and catch yourself a game at the Staples Center or Dodger's stadium!

One of the busiest sports arenas in Los Angeles is home to the LA Lakers and LA Clippers NBA Basketball teams, the LA Sparks pro women's basketball team and the LA Kings hockey team.





The 125 acre StubHub Center Complex includes a 27,000-seat soccer stadium, an 8,000-seat tennis stadium, a track and field facility and the Velodrome, a 250-meter indoor wood bicycle racing track – the largest in the US. These facilities are used for a variety of national and international competitions each year.





Dodger Stadium at Chavez Ravine in Elysian Park is home to the National League's Los Angeles Dodgers' baseball team. The stadium was built in 1962 and has undergone many upgrades and environmental improvement measures. Dodger Stadium holds 56,000 spectators, with seats enjoying a commanding view of the downtown Los Angeles skyline.





The Irwindale Speedway is a twin-paved oval motorsports track, about 25 minutes east of downtown Los Angeles. The 6,000-seat Speedway hosts Stock Cars, Sprint Cars, Midgets, Supermodifieds, Legends, Trucks, and more around its double ovals, banked at 1/2 and 1/3 mile, respectively. The venue also hosts concerts and other events.

Los Angeles isn't the world's unofficial cultural capital for only appealing to adults; the city hosts some of the world's most exciting children's theme parks. If there's anything Tinseltown excels at, it's entertainment. Between Disneyland and Universal Studios, the kids are spoiled for fun and games. SANTA MONICA PIER


