

Situated a few steps from the waves, you may be lucky to spot whales if you're visiting from December to May. The Sunset offers a setting and cuisine as good as it gets in Southern California.






Gravina is a family-owned and managed Italian eatery serving authentic multi-regional Italian cuisine in a cozy home-like atmosphere. The restaurant offers delicious meals, like spaghetti ai frutti di mare (shellfish and seafood in a spicy tomato sauce) and beautifully prepared, delicious drinks.





Perched on a romantic Malibu hillside, Geoffrey's offers a spectacular view of the curving Southern California coastline, and its flower-filled patio is a fine spot for a candlelight dinner or Sunday brunch. Panoramic views of the ocean grace every table in the house, canceling the boundaries between the restaurant and the splendor surrounding it. Escape the stresses of life and unwind at Geoffrey's Malibu for an unforgettable oceanside dining experience.





The eatery is a historic Malibu Canyon hunting lodge turned restaurant. It is perched up on the Saddle Peak (the drive up is quite pretty at sunset) and it serves the big-game meat-centric menu. Despite the scattered mounted deer busts and similar hunting regalia, dining at this institution is a deeply LA experience and not nearly as kitschy as it may sound. Dining alfresco is particularly ideal for romantic evenings. The place is not just for the carnivores. Fish options, salads, and veggie sides are on the menu too.



MALIBU FARM | NEW AMERICAN

A white-washed dining room and oceanside patio bar are home to Malibu Farm Restaurant & Bar. Go for brunch at this organic, kosher, and farm-fresh eatery on the Malibu Pier, where everything is healthy and delectable. Featuring fresh juice cocktails and the fresh, organic, and local cuisine of Helene Henderson, try a watermelon mimosa with your vegetable paella and spaghetti squash lasagna. At the same time, soak up the sounds and smells of the ocean. Both, the outdoor patio and elegant dining room offer beautiful views of the pier and ocean.





This intimate space has knowledgeable bartenders who can recreate classic drinks on the spot or introduce you to a new favorite. There are no pre-mixes here, everything is made before your eyes, completely from scratch. The upscale decor and casual atmosphere creates a comforting space that's refined, yet friendly and solo travelers will find it surprisingly easy to strike up a conversation with laid-back locals.



LITTLE BEACH HOUSE | SEAFOOD

On the exclusive mile-long stretch of sand known as Carbon Beach or *Billionaire's Beach*, adjacent to Nobu Malibu, sits the latest outpost of the Soho House. This unbelievably trendy global members-only club is so exclusive not even already-established members are guaranteed entry — they must be approved by a local board first. Nevertheless, should you gain access to the privileged club with a beachy vibe and contemporary art flair, ocean views, and a seafood-charged menu, you will be living an endless summer.





Nobu is probably the most famous restaurant in Malibu. It has locations all over the globe. It's an extremely trendy place to dine, and the Asian-inspired cuisine is top notch. Chef Matsuhisa's sushi is among the best in the area. Try the lobster tempura truffle amazu or the roasted king crab with uni or shiso serrano. Nobu is a favorite among celebrities.





Surfing legend Duke Kahanamoku taught surfing in Malibu and spent time in the area as a lifeguard. He competed in water sports and appeared in more than 28 Hollywood movies. Duke's Malibu features good food, an amazing atmosphere, a beautiful vista and, of course, delicious food and luscious cocktails.



MOONSHADOWS | CALIFORNIAN

Dining at Moonshadows feels like you're dining on a luxury yacht surrounded by massive windows for an exemplary panoramic ocean view. The mouthwatering dishes have Asian fusion, Italian and American influences. Appetizers include choices such as duck and shiitake mushroom spring rolls, and octopus carpaccio while main courses feature dishes like miso glazed black cod and almond-crusted albacore tuna steak.







THE MALIBU COLONY CO.






THE ARTS

Malibu is home to an array of exquisite galleries and museums featuring artifacts and art pieces from antiquity to the present day. Many of these cherished institutions started as patronage projects of wealthy art collectors and philanthropists. More than just local haunts, Malibu's museums are mentioned in Los Angeles itineraries. One look at the splendor of the Getty Villa and it's clear why!

THE ARTS



The Frederick R. Weisman Museum of Art at Pepperdine University was founded in 1992 with a \$1.5 million gift from Frederick R. Weisman, a noted art collector and philanthropist. The museum showcases historical and contemporary art by nationally recognized artists, with a focus on the art of California. Past exhibitions have included Andy Warhol: Life and Legends; Rodin: Muses, Sirens, Lovers and Wayne Thiebaud: Works on Paper.





Malibu Contemporary Art Gallery features works exclusively by 14 established Southern California-based artists. These creatives exhibit internationally and are in museum collections. The gallery gives a percentage of its art sales to a local non-profits serving Malibu as a city and a community. Art lovers who are primed to purchase a piece by a California artist should definitely check out this gallery.






This immaculately preserved 1930's Moorish-Spanish-style villa serves an important purpose in the community: to educate visitors about the history of Malibu, going all the way back to the 18th century when the land was home to the Chumash Indians. You can see the entire house, with its elaborate tile work and stunning views of the Pacific Ocean. On site is the Malibu Lagoon Museum, offering an even deeper dive into Malibu's past.



GETTY VILLA

Billionaire, oilman and art patron J. Paul Getty opened the Getty Villa in 1974 and made his vast collection of Classical and Renaissance-era artworks available for public viewing. Getty felt art in his collection deserved to be displayed in a building evoking Classical traditions and not in a neutral or Modern-style museum setting. So, he commissioned a group of architects who created a re-imagining of Herculaneum's Villa of the Papyri, a Roman villa buried in the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in AD 79. The museum now houses only Greek, Roman, and Etruscan art, with the rest of Getty's collection now housed at the massive Getty Center in Brentwood.




THE GETTY CENTER

The Getty Center sits on a hilltop in the Santa Monica Mountains in Brentwood. From there, you can take in the unprecedented views and distinctive features of Los Angeles's landscape—the Pacific Ocean, the San Gabriel Mountains, and the vast street-grid of the city. Inspired by the relationship between these elements, architect Richard Meier designed the complex to highlight both nature and culture. Natural light is one of the Getty Center's most important architectural elements. Art from the Middle Ages to present day are set amid modern architecture and gardens.






Malibu's coastlines embrace majestic canyons, lush waterfalls, and sprawling ranches. Between 21 miles of shoreline, Malibu flaunts no less than 29 beaches of various sizes. Found where land, water, and mountains meet, Malibu is at the foot of the majestic Santa Monica Mountain range. High above are gorgeous vineyards and secluded compounds. From on high, you'll have stellar views of the mighty Pacific.








4X4 VINEYARD TOUR

The 4x4 Vineyard Tour is a guided adventure around Saddlerock Ranch Vineyards. In addition to exploring the vineyards, you'll get the opportunity to probe other natural areas of the property. You'll also visit the Chumash Native American archaeological site, organic vegetable garden, mountain top overlooks and more!





The workshop will teach you the fundamentals of night photography and give on location experience (study the landscape and plan compositions) and training to create stunning images on your own. It includes a masterclass in editing to bring the images to life. One thing to note, you should bring your own equipment.


SCUBA DIVING




Get hands-on instruction from a local surfer and lifelong Malibu resident. Learn the ins and outs of surfing, including paddling and standing, with the goal of riding waves.
