


Kahanamoku beach is a curved section of shoreline at the western end of Waikiki. The sand is golden and the water, crystal clear. It's protected by the breakwater and pier, and if you're in the mood to snorkel there's a stunning section of coral running between them.





One of the most famous beaches in the world, Waikiki beach is nestled on Oahu's south shore. It has more than four million visitors each year and offers amazing views of Diamond Head. Waikiki beach is great for snorkeling, swimming, riding the waves, and enjoying soaking up the rays. It's also home to some fine restaurants for an apres beach dinner or cocktails.






Kahala Beach is a well-hidden alcove where you can relax among tranquil, sandy shores without having to share the space with crowds. In fact, it's possible you won't find anyone else at all on this beach since it's mostly used by area residents. You might want to dive here since you're likely to spot quite a number of fascinating aquatic specimens that aren't often interrupted by a lot of human traffic. Note: Don't jump in directly from the seawall, since it isn't deep enough to do so safely.






Among the most popular things to do in Oahu is visiting Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve. It's one of the best areas to experience top-notch snorkeling. Located 30 minutes east of Waikiki, this stunning cove was once a volcanic crater but is now home to clear blue waters and lively reefs teeming with vibrant sea creatures.






Consistently rated the best beach in Oahu, this strip of shoreline is just gorgeous and a perfect place to stop and have a swim, especially if your children are along. It is much quieter than Waikiki or Hanauma Bay and is a great spot for kayaking or stand up paddle boarding. There is an offshore reef that keeps the water calm making it ideal for safe swimming.





Situated on the historic north shore Sunset beach is a beautifully long expanse that has enamored both locals and tourists for decades. During the summer, the blindingly blue ocean waters are calm and crystal-clear, making it a terrific destination for swimmers, snorkelers and families.





The undisputed culinary epicenter of the Hawaiian islands, Oahu's vibrant dining scene is very well regarded. A lightning rod for gastronomic ingenuity, some of the world's most celebrated chefs have flocked to the island to set up their fine dining outposts. The island's culinary reinvention can be traced back 25 years as ground zero for the sweeping Hawaiian regional cuisine movement. 
#### **BAR LEATHER APRON | COCKTAIL BAR**

The bar at this intimate cocktail spot on the mezzanine of a downtown Honolulu office building seats only six, so making reservations is recommended. It's worth it to enjoy bespoke cocktails utilizing only the finest liquors and ingredients. Owners Tom Park and Justin Park have cultivated a reputation for their signature cocktails including the E Ho'o Pau Mai Tai made with raisin-infused five-year-old El Dorado rum; 12-year-old El Dorado rum; coconut water syrup; spiced orgeat; vanilla; ohia blossom honey; lime; absinthe; and Kiawe wood smoke.







When the sun sets and the nightlife begins, head to Rum Fire. Centered in the middle of Waikiki in the Sheraton Hotel, Rumfire is one of the more modern tiki bars, with vibrant red colors, flame-featured lighting, and tropical rattan furniture. Hugely popular thanks to great music and incredible views of Waikiki beach, this hotel nightclub is a sure bet any night of the year.





Sky Waikiki sits 19 stories above the city, just below Top of Waikiki, the strip's iconic revolving restaurant. 




The Bernice Pauahi Bishop Museum, designated the Hawaii State Museum of Natural and Cultural History in the historic Kalihi district of Honolulu, devotes itself to history and science. Founded in 1889, it is the largest museum in Hawaii and has the world's largest collection of Polynesian cultural artifacts and natural history specimens.




#### HAWAII STATE ART MUSEUM

The No. 1 Capitol District Building, on the site of the former Armed Services YMCA Building, now houses the Hawaii State Art Museum (HiSAM) and the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts (SFCA). View some of the best contemporary art from across the state in HiSAM's exhibits. This is the venue for the Art in Public Places Program of the SFCA. Most of the collection is on display in public buildings, including libraries, schools, and state offices. Art in the collection are primarily contemporary works by artists with a connection to Hawaii.





Iolani Palace was the royal residence of the rulers of the Kingdom of Hawaii beginning with Kamehameha III under the Kamehameha Dynasty and ending with Queen Lili'uokalani under the Kalākaua Dynasty, founded by her brother, King David Kalākaua. It's a magical venue all lovers of architecture and culture will appreciate.






#### **NALU KINETIC SPA**





The Honolulu Zoo is the only zoo in the United States to be established by grants made by a sovereign monarch and is built on 42 of the 300-acre royal Queen Kapi'olani Park. There are more than 1,200 animals in specially-designed habitats living at the zoo.

#### **HONOLULU WATERSHED RESERVE**

Honolulu Watershed Forest Reserve is one of the most well-known national parks. It is part of 600 square miles of highlands covered with unique natural forest. The park is a must see place for everyone, but especially for those who enjoy various outdoor adventures.




Kaiwa Ridge (Lanikai Pillbox) Trail is nearly two miles of heavily trafficked path near Kailua with a moderate difficulty rating. Trek through fields of beautiful wild flowers and stop to chat with other hikers and runners along the way. Dogs are allowed, but must be kept on leashes.






Jump in a multi-passenger off-road ATV that accommodates up to five passengers, venture across the iconic Jurassic Valley and visit the movie's famous film locations. ATV-ing across this rugged terrain is one of the more adventurous things to do in Oahu.






In 1958, Koko Crater was earmarked for development into a botanical garden. Plant collections now occupy 60 acres of the inner slopes and basin of this 200-acre crater. The garden focuses on the cultivation of rare and endangered dryland plants.






Portions of this garden park were once the property and favorite picnic grounds of Queen Lili'uoakalani, the last reigning Hawaiian monarch. She later donated the land to the city and county of Honolulu to be used for the public's enjoyment. This constantly developing garden is devoted to native Hawaiian flora and fauna.






The trail begins at the end of Moanalua Valley at Moanalua Valley Park. It starts as a road barred by a green gate which eventually turns into an unimproved route and later to a narrow trail. The trail to the top of the Haiku Stairs (Stairway to Heaven) is about two miles past the trailhead.





Makapu'u Point Lighthouse Trail is nearly three miles long and features a wide selection of beautiful and unique plants. This year-round trail can accommodate all skill levels and is primarily used for hiking.





Guided Segway tours lets you experience natural Hawaiian beauty, history, and culture in quiet and with zero emissions. The segway ride in Kailua provides pure exhilaration and miles of smiles. Saves you tiring your legs with all that walking.





Up, up and away is often the best way of seeing the beauty of a vacation destination. Whether you're in a helicopter, private plane, paragliding, parachuting or in a hot air balloon, getting a bird's eye view will take your perceptions of an area to new heights! So don't stay grounded, take flight for a thrilling adventure!





A helicopter tour over is likely to be among your most cherished memories of this island paradise. Soar over majestic waterfalls, volcanic craters, Waikiki and some of the world's best beaches. Take it all in and snap some magazine-worthy photos. For a boost of adrenaline choose the "doors-off" airborne experience.



### **SKYDIVING**

Brave souls and adrenaline junkies can experience skydiving on the North Shore of Oahu. Doing the "freefall" over Oahu, and taking it all in, the landscape and color, induces your endorphins and makes it worthwhile.



#### **PARAGLIDING**

Paragliding is a skydiving alternative that's more mellow (no free fall) but still offers a rush of adrenaline. You and an instructor will "fly" off the side of a mountain and float to the ground using a parachute (controlled by your instructor). Jumping off the side of the mountain – can be scary, however the overall experience is very gentle and peaceful as you glide through the air.





Glider Tours are a must on Oahu. These aircraft are without an engine. They are pulled up into the air by another aircraft and released, at about 3,000 feet, so that they could "glide" through the air for a peaceful, scenic flight and descent.







Seventy-one percent of the earth is water, yet most of this magical world remains a mystery. No experience is necessary, and you'll enjoy views of Koko Crater, Koko Head, and the Ko'olau mountain range.






### **PARASAILING**

Take the thrill ride of your life on this Oahu parasailing experience! Soar through the air on lines up to 1,000 ft. and enjoy views of Diamond Head, Waikiki Beach and the Ko'olau Mountains.



Surfing is just a way of life on Oahu. With more than 100 named surf spots surrounding the island, there's lots to explore! Oahu waters offers something for all levels – from surfing Waikiki beach to surfing pipeline – yes, the world-famous Banzai Pipeline!





If you enjoy paddleboarding and yoga, you can combine the two on your Honolulu trip with a paddleboard yoga class. One awesome yoga session on the ocean while watching a sunset come down one side of Ala Moana, while palm trees line the other side of the bay, is the ideal centering experience. For a real challenge, try SUP yoga at night with the help of led lights.






Explore the underwater world of Oahu's sea life, swimming past vibrant coral reefs and playful schools of fish. Experienced divers can explore the depths of reefs and sunken ships. Introductory scuba dives are also available, complete with lessons for first-timers.





Travel offshore three to four miles to a cage moored in beautiful cobalt blue water. The visibility is so good (often 150 feet or more) that you can actually see the sharks coming up from the deep. Tours can accommodate up to 14 people who get 20 minutes in the cage which can hold up to eight people comfortably allowing small families to experience a shark dive together.




