






There are several distinct areas in Orange County. The Costa Mesa freeway is a popular dividing line between the northern and the southern regions. The North OC was the first part of the county to be developed and is culturally closer to the neighboring Los Angeles County. The most prominent cities in North OC are Anaheim, Fullerton and Santa Ana. South Orange County on the other hand is more residential, elite, and more recently developed. Irvine, the largest city in the region, is an exception to some of these trends. South Orange County almost always includes Irvine, Newport Beach and Costa Mesa. There is also another (sub)region of Orange County, the Orange Coast with a string of cities and neighborhoods fronting the Pacific Coast. Cities associated with beach town flair and surf culture are Seal Beach, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Laguna Beach, Dana Point and San Clemente.




ANAHEIM

Anaheim is the heart of Orange County. With its laid-back atmosphere and unbeatable attractions, this vibrant city on the northwest side of the county has become a popular destination for visitors. Known for A-list, family-friendly attractions like *Disneyland* Park, *Disney California Adventure* Park, and Knott's Berry Farm, Anaheim offers more, from delicious cuisine at the Anaheim Packing House to an ice-cold beer at the Packard Building. Thanks to the revamping, the central shopping and dining area makes Anaheim an outstanding destination for everyone, from families to gourmands. In recent years, walkable, livable, sociable areas have sprouted around town, making the city a worthy magnet for locals and visitors alike.



SANTA ANA

The city of Santa Ana is the second–most populous city in Orange County and the county seat. There is a lot to offer here, from the historic downtown area to the many cultural sites and numerous green spaces. The original courthouse, The Old Orange County Courthouse, still stands. This historic landmark serves as a museum. Downtown Santa Ana hosts many community events including the farmers market, the Artwalk, and music nights. Also located in downtown Santa Ana is the Artist's Village – a flourishing art community with galleries, studios, creative small businesses, dining, and residential space.



COSTA MESA

Costa Mesa, named *The City of Arts*, is one of the poshest areas in California's sun-drenched Orange County. "Costa Mesa" means "coastal tableland" as a reference to the city's geography as being on a plateau by the coast. With its southernmost border only one mile from the Pacific Ocean, Costa Mesa has evolved from a town with agricultural roots to becoming a world-class center for fashion with a venue like South Coast Plaza, a mecca for arts and theater with Segerstrom Center for the Arts, and a renowned dining destination. Costa Mesa is also home to the OC Fair & Event Center, which hosts the annual Orange County Fair, one of the largest in the country.



HUNTINGTON BEACH

Local waves make Huntington Beach a hub of surf activity. The city's moniker, Surf City USA, says it all. From surf wear shops and local wave-rider hangouts to suntanned surfers in search of that perfect wave, you can't help but dive into this beach town's infectious surf culture. Beachfront lounges, lively breweries, distilleries, and having cocktails on the sand make Huntington stand out as one of the best party spots in Orange County. While its bars are legendary, there is much more to do here than bar-hop.




NEWPORT BEACH

Newport Beach is guirky and nuanced and much more than radiant sun, sand and surf. Newport Beach epitomizes the casual yet sophisticated lifestyle of Southern California. This idyllic destination is widely celebrated for its natural beauty which sets the scene for a vibrant yachting community alongside upscale accommodations, eclectic coastal cuisine and world-class shopping. This stretch of southern California has been home to artists, surfers, and the stars of Hollywood's Golden Age. Like any glamorous icon of a certain age, this coastal town has changed its identity a few times over the years. Notwithstanding, the city's heart and soul still revolve around the harbor, which comprises two bodies of water. There's Upper Newport Bay, an ecological reserve ringed by a 10-mile loop trail that attracts birders, joggers, equestrians, and cyclists. The four-mile-long Lower Newport Bay, meanwhile, features lovely shops and restaurants especially in Cannery Village, Balboa Peninsula, and Balboa Island. The town also has a thriving surf scene, thanks to more than 8 miles of beaches and the bodysurfers' bucket-list spot known as the Wedge, with raucous waves that can easily reach 20 feet in height.



LAGUNA BEACH

In more than 10 years, Laguna Beach has become a household name, thanks largely to its presence on television. But for those who know it well, it's a quirky beach town marked by palm-tree studded streets, a string of art galleries, and big and small hotels sitting right on the bluffs. This seaside community was discovered by a group of landscape painters in the 1920s and quickly became a destination of choice for the artistically inclined. With posh hillside mansions, trendy shopping areas, and a rugged coastline of cliffs leading to secluded sandy beaches, it's a great place to discover hidden gems and relax in a low-key setting.



DANA POINT

Dana Point remains an overlooked treasure in Southern California. It is Southern California's original surf town, bringing together the best of luxury amenities and laid-back surf culture to create one idyllic destination. It's a place with sophistication and taste, and yet it's casual. Set between San Diego and Los Angeles, Dana Point offers everything from sunset wine cruises and luxury spas to surfing and ocean view golfing. Stand-up paddleboarding (SUP) and kayaking rentals, as well as "pirate ship" adventures, beach and aerial yoga classes, and deep sea fishing offer endless options for making memories.





With its charming ambiance and Spanish-style architecture, picture-perfect San Clemente evokes images of the Mediterranean. Enjoy the leisurely pace, pristine beaches, friendly sidewalk cafés, and family activities. You can shop for antiques, custom jewelry, designer perfumes, and unique gifts along the quaint streets in this "Spanish Village by the Sea."





Orange County has often been seen in the media as something of an afterthought, being overshadowed by the much larger and more densely populated Los Angeles County next door. But the truth is that there's a vibrant and diverse culinary community in this oceanside setting of more than 3 million people. Inland spots reflect the flavors important to those who live there (in areas like Westminster, where Vietnamese food dominates), while the county's coastal locations often have upscale dining done with modern California touches. From historic seaside stands serving some of the OC's most notorious desserts, to fine dining strongholds backed by big names, to small mom-and-pop shops that have spent decades perfecting a singular passion, there's something for everyone to enjoy in Orange County.or those who are in search of a fine dining experience that blends laid-back luxury and casual sophistication, look no further than the following top Orange County restaurants.

KHAN SAAB DESI CRAFT KITCHEN | PAKISTANI REGIONAL CUISINE

This Michelin-anointed halal restaurant combines the flavors of India, Afghanistan, and Pakistan with a modern Californian twist. Originally from Pakistan, Chef Imran Ali Mookhi displays a certain deftness with spices, flavors, and the handling of red meat. The tender boneless chicken karahi is served with tomatoes and shishito peppers, and the butter chicken with dried fenugreek is one of the restaurant's more popular dishes. Chicken and vegetarian items are on offer, but there's no denying that beef is king on this menu. The decor is bright, neat, and hip. A bar in the back pours craft mocktails that pair swimmingly with such memorable items as beef (sirloin) kebabs with mustard oil, yogurt, and garlic. Sides of gunpowder mashed potatoes, garlic chutney, or dal Bukhara score high on flavor and texture. Australian Wagyu and Tomahawk steak will thrill carnivores; while seasonal vegetables have locavores returning for more.



THE RANCH RESTAURANT | AMERICAN

This Anaheim restaurant features true American regional cuisine made from scratch with the finest ingredients, fresh organically grown fruits and vegetables from local farms and from the restaurant's own ranch in the Santa Ana Mountains. Known best for the selection of steaks (including a 58-ounce cowboy ribeye, 40-ounce delmonico, and 50-ounce porterhouse), the restaurant prides itself on partnering with farmers, ranchers, fishermen, bakers and artisan cheesemakers honoring the season's best in local and regional ingredients, In the kitchen, the culinary team creates menus crisscrossing between classic dishes and elevated interpretations of global fare.





The Hobbit is an absolute escape from the busy streets of Ocean City. It's a place to indulge in inventive American cuisine and mouth-watering seafood while overlooking one of the most picturesque views on the coast. Stop by The Hobbit and step into a classy, sleek, and comfortable world of dining excellence.




VACA | SPANISH

Vaca is nestled between the world-famous Segerstrom Center for the Arts and the premier shopping destination, South Coast Plaza on Town Center Drive in Costa Mesa, California. The space evokes the energy and ambiance of Spain with the comfort of California. The restaurant brings Barcelona, Madrid, Andalucia, Sevilla, and the Basque to the heart of Orange County. The paella and aged steaks are the big-ticket items at Top Chef alum Amar Santana's Spanish-inspired eatery. But, here the tapas and small plates shine. The Beverage program emphasizes traditional Spanish cocktails, wine and beer, as well as innovative craft cocktails. Start with the pan con tomate, charred Spanish octopus, and potato croquettes.



TACO MARIA * MICHELIN | MEXICAN

Nestled within the upscale OC Mix galleria, this simply-appointed but highly desirable gem boasts one of the country's most refined expressions of Mexican cuisine. Brought to you by the intensely creative Chef Carlos Salgado, lunch here focuses on elevated tacos. But in truth, this kitchen shines brightest at dinner, with a prix-fixe menu inspired by Salgado's heritage and bolstered by top-notch produce and techniques honed during his fine-dining days. Following suit, the attentive and knowledgeable staff excels in every way.



ANQI BISTRO | VIETNAMESE/ SEAFOOD

AnQi Gourmet Bistro & Noodle Bar serves a unique twist on California Vietnamese Cuisine, with favorites like filet mignon potstickers and miso black cod, as well as items from their award-winning molecular menu. AnQi's most intimate dining experience, The Chef's Table, offers guests the unique opportunity for a glimpse into the AN's legendary Secret Kitchen. The completely concealed "kitchen within a kitchen," is open only to members of the An Family and those who have been employed by Master Chef Helene An for more than 10 years.





Like so many sushi counters, this one, too, feels like a neighborhood secret, hidden in the back of a shopping mall with no large flashing sign to mark its entrance and overshadowed by far busier neighbors. And yet, this intimate gem is indeed worth seeking out, as the 10-seat counter offers the chance to enjoy a leisurely omakase under the impeccable guidance of Chef Atsushi Yokoyama. Moments of quiet are filled by watching this one-person show lend artistry to the meal.



NOBU NEWPORT I JAPANESE

The world's most recognized Japanese restaurant, known for its innovative cuisine and celebrity following, has opened its first Orange County location at Lido Marina Village in the spring of 2017. There are now 32 outposts of Nobu – and they draw an enthusiastic crowd – but the Newport Beach location is worth braving the crowds. Nobu's arrival has been perhaps the most eagerly anticipated and talked about restaurant opening the OC has seen in years! The two-story waterfront design is stunning and to cap off the incredible service Nobu is known for, there's a boat valet, making the experience even more indulgent.



BASILIC | SWISS-FRENCH

Basilic Restaurant serves superb Swiss-French cuisine in an old-world charm ambiance. Owner and Chef Bernard Althaus brings lifelong cooking experience and a family tradition from his native Switzerland to the dishes he creates daily from scratch. The menu changes regularly and specials are featured according to season and what's available at the local farmer's market. Typical menu items may include appetizers like viande sechee "bundnerfleish," or Swiss-style air-dried beef; entrees like coq au vin, steak au poivre and seafood risotto; and desserts such as caramelized pecan walnut chocolate tart. The carefully chosen wine list features a wonderful selection of French, Swiss and domestic wines. Basilic Restaurant offers an intimate, romantic atmosphere with a formal table setting.



MASTRO'S OCEAN CLUB I



TANNER'S TREEHOUSE | ROOFTOP BAR


MESA | LOUNGE


A'MAREE'S

A'marees originally opened in the 1970s in a modest retail space and has since moved to a stunning waterfront location, complete with floor-to-ceiling windows and a private dock. The family behind the boutique cultivates relationships with their designers—including Peter Cohen, Denis Colomb, Daniela Gregis, The Row, and Sofie D'Hoore—and hosts special meet-the-designer events for customers. The boutique stocks some impressive pieces by Alaïa and Céline, plus jewelry by Marc Alary. There's a homey familiarity every time a patron steps into the spacious shop, with high arching windows revealing yachts outside and glass portholes looking down to the Pacific. Book a private appointment with the sisters on a Sunday for a one-on-one styling session.






This unique shop on Pacific Coast Highway is a nod to Laguna's rich surf history offering a trusted mix of clothing and gear (most of which is from independent brands) existing solely for the sport. The team is knowledgeable and friendly, so if you're in the market for a board, or simply want to learn more about surfing, this is a good resource. It's also an unexpected goldmine for retro surfer tees, vinyl records, and art books.





Every city and region in Orange County has its artistic personality and cultural identity, from colorful street murals, like ones by famed muralist Shepard Fairey, to sleek gallery spaces, monthly art walks to world-class exhibition halls. Orange County boasts its world-renowned art scene, underscored by Segerstrom Center for the Arts, featuring top-national touring Broadway productions and concerts by legendary musical artists.




YOST THEATER


ORANGE COUNTY CENTER FOR CONTEMPORARY ART – OCCCA

Founded in 1980, Orange County Center for Contemporary Art, in the historic downtown Santa Ana Artist Village, is an uncensored gallery encouraging an innovative and progressive approach to art. Since its inception, it has provided emerging and established member and guest artists a forum to explore and develop ideas in contemporary art in an atmosphere promoting experimentation and risk-taking but without the specter of censorship. The center hosts film screenings, conferences, artist receptions, and revolving exhibitions designed to foster engagement and conversation.



THE SEGERSTROM CENTER FOR THE ARTS

Since its opening, Segerstrom Center for the Arts has been arguably one of California's best-performing arts centers. The center is well known for both its award-winning architecture and facilities and the exceptional quality of performances. It is the artistic venue for three resident Orange County musical companies: Pacific Symphony, the Philharmonic Society of Orange County and Pacific Chorale. The Segerstrom Center includes Segerstrom Hall, the Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall, Samueli Theater, the Judy Morr Theater and the 56,100-square-foot Julianne and George Argyros Arts Plaza. Jazz, pop, opera and classical music are featured in concert series events. The center also presents an annual Broadway Series.



THE ORANGE COUNTY MUSEUM OF ART (OCMA)

This bastion of art and culture for Orange County was founded in 1962 by 13 women. Having changed names several times over the years, it settled on the Orange County Museum of Art (OCMA) in 1997. The OCMA broke ground on its permanent home at Segerstrom Center for the Arts in September 2019 and its opening to the public is expected on October 8, 2022. Designed by Pritzker Prize-winning architect Thom Mayne of Morphosis Studio, the state-of-the-art 53,000-square-foot building is double the size of the museum's former location in Newport Beach. Moving to the region's premier cultural campus in Costa Mesa will provide OCMA with a central location, expanded gallery space, and inviting public areas. Additionally, a sculptural wing hovering over the lobby atrium is in the works as well.



ART WALK IN COSTA MESA

You can find 20 or so great pieces of free public art to view in various areas around Costa Mesa. *The Ram* by Charles O. Perry is an excellent starting point from which to begin Costa Mesa's *Art Walk*. This bright yellow painted steel sculpture was the second installed in Town Center Park and remains a colorful focal point there. Thanks to Henry Segerstrom, world-renowned international artists like Isamu Noguchi and Joan Miró have one-of-a-kind art pieces found only in Costa Mesa. There is an audio tour you can listen to on your phone.





Modjeska House, also known as Arden, was designed by Stanford White in Modjeska Canyon, California. It is the only surviving home of Helena Modjeska, a Shakespearean actress and Polish patriot. The house is tucked away amid a live oak grove on the banks of Santiago Creek. The century-old abode is named for the grounds' resemblance to the Forest of Arden in the Shakespearean play, "As You Like It." Arden is designated a National Historic Landmark.






Also referred to as the museum of California art, Laguna Art Museum exhibits works created exclusively by California artists or those who represent the life and history of the Golden State. Founded in 1918, the museum's collection spans periods and styles, from the 19th century till today.


THE RICHARD NIXON PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY AND MUSEUM

Just 15 minutes from the Anaheim Convention Center in Yorba Linda – the hometown of the only California-born President – Richard Nixon, The Richard Nixon Presidential Library & Museum preserves and displays an extensive collection of documents, audiovisual material, and memorabilia from Richard Nixon's life and presidency. Visitors can view 22 unique spaces in the museum that inform and educate about the life and times of Richard Nixon before, during, and after his presidency, including a replica of Nixon's Oval Office, an exhibit about the Vietnam War, a dedicated space about First Lady Pat Nixon and the house where President Nixon was born.




MUZEO MUSEUM AND CULTURAL CENTER

Muzeo Museum is the center of the Anaheim art world. Housed in the only remaining Carnegie Library building in Anaheim, this museum deals both with the rich cultural history of Anaheim and the world. The volunteers who work there value educating the younger generation about their fine city founded in the mid-1850s by German winemakers who wanted to sell their product to citizens of Los Angeles. Muzeo displays an ever-changing rotation of exhibits showcasing various artists, media, and subjects, making it a truly fascinating museum. Displays here are among the most innovative and thought-provoking works of art across genres.




BOWERS MUSEUM

Home to a range of cultural exhibits as well as beautiful gardens and tranquil fountains, the Bowers Museum is the ideal stop for those wanting to learn more about Native American art, Chinese history, or even fossils from Ancient America. In addition to its impressive permanent collection of some 2,000 19th and 20th–century paintings and 12,000 historic decorative art objects (such as dolls, furniture, and homewares), the museum also welcomes traveling exhibits in various subjects. Since kids love museums too, Bowers offers Kidseum, with an emphasis on world cultures, art, and archaeology. Interactive exhibits allow children to touch and explore as they learn about the world both near and far.




LYON AIR MUSEUM

Lyon Air Museum is a small museum founded by General William Lyon containing a nice collection of military vehicles and airplanes. Tucked away in the city of Santa Ana in the backlot of John Wayne Airport, this unique aviation museum is one of the unmissable attractions. The museum's collection features dozens of planes and helicopters spread out across many hangars – from WWII–era bombers to rare Vietnam–era fighter jets (and non–flying military vehicles and motorcycles). Some of the most interesting exhibits are the iconic Divco Helms Bakery trucks; a 1943 Japanese Rikuo Sidecar Motorcycle, one of the first motorcycles manufactured in Japan and WWII Ford military Jeeps.





This automotive museum in Tustin offers an impressive roster of classic and iconic, one-of-a-kind automobiles (including some from film and TV history like the Batmobile and Knightrider), and rare cars. The Marconi Automotive Museum houses a collection of vehicles worth \$30 million dollars. One of the Marconi Museum's primary goals is to support the Marconi Foundation for Kids, an advocacy group helping at-risk youth through a variety of programs and financial support.



HUNTINGTON BEACH INTERNATIONAL SURFING MUSEUM

The museum's goal is to preserve the history of the surfing culture throughout the globe. It is dedicated to Duke Kahanamoku, considered to be the father of modern surfing. The International Surfing Museum, although small, displays historic surfboards, such as those owned by Duke Kahanamoku, provides information about legendary surfers, and shows classic surf films. Visitors can examine artistic surfing sculptures and hear surf music. Even those who don't surf will find the museum entertaining.





When you're exploring an urban destination, the city's parks may not be the first places you think of. Big or small, lush or bare, these are the ultimate sites for people to escape the urban hustle and bustle. Yet, these green spaces in the heart of cosmopolitan chaos leave revealing clues about the city's distinct character. Parks are integral parts of cities, places where the spontaneity of civil life unfurls. Visitors may genuinely breathe in the rhythm and spirit of a destination, starting from its parks.


FULLERTON ARBORETUM

The Fullerton Arboretum is the most extensive botanical garden in Orange County. Established in 1979, the Arboretum has served as a prime resource for ecological, horticultural and historical education. Encompassing 26 lush acres, the Fullerton Arboretum has assembled a permanent collection of more than 4,000 unique and unusual plant species from around the world. The Fullerton Arboretum offers a tranquil retreat from a fast–paced urban life with its ponds, streams, and wildlife.





Commissioned by Henry Segerstrom in 1979 and completed in 1982, Isamu Noguchi's *California Scenario* (also known in the Costa Mesa community as Noguchi Garden) is recognized as one of the country's preeminent sculpture gardens. It is a vital publicly accessible outdoor sculpture oasis in Southern California. The garden, situated on 1.6 acres, in its design symbolizes various geographical characteristics in California, incorporating indigenous plants and materials.


While exploring this tranquil haven in Corona del Mar, it's hard to remember you're just steps away from the bustling Coast Highway. This is one of the more manicured gardens in the county, with brick pathways, tile fountains, and a display of succulents artfully arranged in a mosaic with colored glass. The lily pond near the Coast Highway entrance is flanked by statues, including a river otter nicknamed Shermie. At golden hour, this area is reminiscent of Monet's *Giverny*.



HORTENSE MILLER GARDEN

Nature meets architecture in this once-private Laguna Beach garden and mid-century modern home of artist, environmentalist, and feminist Hortense Miller. The Boat Canyon home, designed by Newport Beach architect Knowlton Fernald, with free-flowing artwork, furniture, and Miller's personal items, boasts ocean and canyon vistas Floor-to-ceiling windows throughout create seamless harmony with the encircling garden. Once there, take notice of the fences made of bamboo, steps made of tree-trunk rounds, and lively hand-painted murals.






With ideal Southern California weather and some of the country's most celebrated courses, Orange County justly earns the nickname "California Golf Coast." Considering Tiger Woods grew up playing on local public courses, including Anaheim's Dad Miller Golf Courses, the county certainly boasts an impressive pedigree. Many of the best courses are open to the public, including the Tom Fazio-designed Pelican Hill Golf Course just south of Newport Beach, offering ocean views from its 36 championship holes. Pelican Hill's South Course is famous for the back-to-back par 3s on the cliffs just above the Pacific. There are great inland courses, too, such as the Ted Robinson-designed Tustin Ranch Golf Club, with handsome foothill and mountain views.




TUSTIN RANCH GOLF CLUB

The 18-hole public golf course at the Tustin Ranch Golf Club features 6,736 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72 and a course rating of 73.5. Designed by Ted Robinson, member of the ASGCA (The American Society of Golf Course Architects), the Tustin Ranch golf course was opened in 1989. The course contains breathtaking Southern California scenery, sparkling lakes and cascading waterfalls. This championship course offers private caddy service, a unique and popular amenity.






The quiet, scenic Costa Mesa Country Club features a golf course with a driving range, a private teaching area, a sand bunker, and chipping and pitching greens. It contains two municipal golf courses and a clubhouse that can be rented for weddings and special events.



STRAWBERRY FARMS GOLF CLUB

Strawberry Farms Golf Club is situated about seven miles from the center of Costa Mesa in the canyons of Irvine and its wetlands. The course offers picturesque vistas across a 35-acre reservoir to large rolling greens surrounded by wildlife, natural vegetation and scenic hills studded with granite boulders and natural waterfalls. Designed by James W. Lipe, Jr., member of ASGCA (The American Society of Golf Course Architects), the Strawberry Farms Golf Course opened in 1997.






At Pelican Hill,world-class golf weaves its way through breathtaking views facing the ocean. Every shot and hole is designed to complement the natural landscape at sea level. Both North and South Courses are designed by Tom Fazio, who has more courses on Golf Digest's list of "America's 100 Greatest Golf Courses" than any other living designer. Pelican Hill features two of his best.



MONARCH BEACH GOLF LINKS

The public 18-hole regulation length golf course at the Monarch Beach Golf Links facility features 6,344 yards of golf from the longest tees for a pair of 70 and a course rating of 69.2. Designed by master architect Robert Trent Jones, Jr., ASGCA (The American Society of Golf Course Architects), the Monarch Beach golf course opened in 1983. Situated along the dramatic oceanfront bluffs of Southern California, Monarch Beach Golf Links is one of the select few golf courses in California that offers sweeping panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean.




ALISO AND WOOD CANYONS HIKE AND MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDE


DISNEYLAND RESORT | THEME PARK


HONDA CENTER | SPORTS

Angel Stadium of Anaheim is the home of the Los Angeles Angels, the major league baseball team formerly known by several different names including the California Angels. The stadium hosts all Anaheim Angels MLB home games and seats 45,050. Angel Stadium is off the 57 freeway, just 13 miles from Costa Mesa.





The Balboa Fun Zone, on the Balboa Peninsula of Newport Beach, is one of Southern California's oldest and last great coastal amusement areas. The Fun Zone continues to compete with Orange County entertainment giants such as Disneyland and Knott's Berry Farm, as the fun place to go. Since 1936, the Fun Zone's Ferris Wheel has been a day and night landmark on the Newport Harbor scene, beckoning all to join in the entertainment.








LAGUNA BEACH FESTIVAL OF ARTS




The Pacific Air Show comes to Orange County every year – where airborne performers skim the shore, soaring over the Huntington Beach Pier. Thousands of spectators pack the sand and streets during the exciting three-day airshow. DANA POINT FESTIVAL OF WHALES

The Annual Dana Point Festival of Whales celebrates the migration of the California Gray Whale over the two weekends in March. There's so much more to see during this annual celebration, including dolphins, starfish and other aquatic locals. The Dana Point Festival of Whales offers a rare opportunity to see some of nature's most elusive creatures in their own habitats. From smaller Minke whales to mid-sized Humpbacks and gigantic (but gentle) Gray whales. VANS US OPEN OF SURFING

It's a mega-beach party in every direction, with skateboarding and BMX events, bands, film premières, car shows and product demos. The Vans US Open of Surfing is one of the most significant annual events in Orange County, drawing about half a million viewers every year. Downtown Huntington Beach has hosted the event since 1959. The surfing competition has transformed into one of the biggest extreme sports festivals in the nation, featuring world-class surfing, skateboarding, and BMX competitions.










Orange County hits the sandy shores of the Pacific Coast. There are favorite beaches for surfing, walking on the pier, places to see the sunset, but mostly, it's 42 miles of continuous coastline beginning as far north as Seal Beach, through "Surf City USA" in Huntington Beach, to the southernmost part of the county, San Clemente. Orange County has both large sandy and small cove beaches. They have piers, rock arches, and tide pools galore, tucked-away spots to seek out sea glass and serene spaces to bask in the bursts of sunshine. Some well-known surf breaks are in OC too. 




West Jetty View Park is at the end of Balboa Peninsula in Newport Beach. The park is small, but the beach here is large. Waves at this location are large as well, especially when conditions are right. Local expert surfers hang out here and ride the barrel wave called "The Wedge." There is a long jetty at the entrance to Newport Bay jutting out from the beach and the reflected wave energy creates a huge swell – sometimes up to 30 feet high!



LITTLE CORONA DEL MAR

Little Corona in Newport Beach is a hidden gem great for families. This small beach is at the end of Buck Gully ravine in the Newport Beach neighborhood of Corona Del Mar. It is a rocky cove beckoning snorkelers, scuba divers and tide pool aficionados. The jetty near this shore helps keep waves at bay, making it an ideal place for smaller children to frolic and for exploring tide pools and sea life. Sturdy shoes to explore the rocks and tide pools south of the sandy beach are needed.






Treasure Cove Beach is a true gem. Popular with surfers and scuba divers, the scenic paths bordering the beach are perfect for enjoying the beauty and for sometimes spotting gray whales during their migration season from December and April. The park entrance is across from Newport Coast Drive on Pacific Coast Highway.



VICTORIA BEACH

Victoria Beach sits south of Main Beach and is known for its white sands, beautiful blue-green waters, and unique older and newer residences. The prominent landmark is the Pirate Tower at the north end of the beach which looks like a Victorian turret or lighthouse. It is one of Laguna's most secluded public beaches mainly because it is not easy to find and there is little parking. Many residents are not familiar with it or have never been to Victoria Beach. Volleyball courts grace its north and south ends. Other popular activities are skimboarding at the south end, body surfing, diving, and fishing.







Treasure Island Beach is near the Montage Resort in South Laguna. In fact, it is co-managed by the city and the resort. This beach is known for its interesting rock formations, pristine sand, and easy access. Some popular activities here include snorkeling, swimming, and inspecting the tide pools for little ocean creatures.



THOUSAND STEPS BEACH

There is a sign and about 230 steep steps leading to the beach. It is a trek going down and coming back up, yet it is worth the haul to get to one of the premier beaches in town. This beach is one of Laguna's classic shorebreak spots, where the summer waves smash right on the sand. This makes it beloved by body surfers and skimboarders alike. If you head south along the shoreline, you'll come to Laguna's most famous sea cave. It actually has a full walkthrough you can enter when the tide is out and the entrance is exposed. It is sure to make even the most serious adults feel like pirates searching for treasure.




STAND UP PADDLE BOARDING (SUP) IN DANA POINT
