


Palm Desert is in the heart of Great Palm Springs and has turned into a shopping, dining, entertainment, and recreation mecca. The El Paseo Shopping District is a tree-lined boulevard in Palm Desert boasting upscale stores, boutiques, and many fine dining establishments.





A luxurious lifestyle meets a lovely landscape in Rancho Mirage. It's a playful area with a host of things for children and adults to see and do such as the Children's Museum of the Desert and Palm Springs' only waterfront shopping and entertainment center, The River.





Palm Canyon is one of the greatest areas of natural beauty in Western North America. Majestic palm trees are mesmerizing contrasts to the area's stark rocky gorges and desert lands. Palm Canyon is ideal for a picnic near a stream, meditation, exploring, hiking and horseback riding.





Indian Canyons was built in the 1960s with mid-century-modern homes designed by notable architects such as Dan Palmer, William Krisel, and Stan Sackley. Including the architecture, the neighborhood is best known for its close proximity to the mountains, Indian Canyon Park, many golf courses, and the largest grove of wild palm trees in the world.






This beautiful area was developed in the 1920s by the same man who built the famous El Mirador Hotel, P.T. Stevens. There once was a resort called the Desert Inn here which was a popular cavorting area of the Hollywood elite. You can still see the resort's tower. El Mirador is an eclectic and interesting neighborhood worth seeing.





This neighborhood is named after the many movie stars who owned homes in the area between the 1930s and 1960s. The Movie Colony (TMC) is within walking distance to the downtown area and many fine restaurants, boutiques and live entertainment. It is only three miles from Palm Springs International Airport.






#### WALLY'S DESERT TURTLE | CONTEMPORARY

In spite of or perhaps due to it's unusual name, Wally's Desert Turtle is one of the most awarded restaurants in the desert. A classically French menu presents some unforgettable takes on roasted pheasant breast, seared venison strip loin, escargot, and lobster ravioli. Prepare for an impeccable dining ambiance among murals, a mirrored ceiling, and ancient Peruvian artifacts.



#### MISTER PARKER'S | FRENCH

Housed within the famed Parker Hotel in South Palm Canyon, Mister Parker's stands as one of the most impressively decorated eateries. Dinners here are always impressive. You can expect upscale bistro dishes with a stylish twist. Look out for the Osso Bucco with saffron risotto, pistachio-crusted rack of lamb, and duck confit with truffled potatoes.





American cuisine infused with the tastes of the tropics and Europe is served at the award-winning Copley's On Palm Canyon. Dine on the patio surrounded by stunning mountain vistas or in the inviting indoors. Chef Andrew Copley is known for innovative dishes like miso-glazed Scottish salmon or saffron-scented seafood spaghetti. After dinner, try the black ice martini made with dark rum, Irish cream, Frangelico, and a shot of espresso.





Locals, tourists, and celebrities are dazzled by Spencer's. An award-winning meal of particular repute is the pan-fried Dover sole, served with asparagus, lemon caper brown butter, bearnaise sauce, and gratin potatoes. Dine alfresco with a breathtaking setting against Mount San Jacinto in a restaurant that hits all the right notes.







The casual, two-mile hike amid Palm Springs' historic Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians tribal grounds counts among the most unique in the region. Part of the Indian Canyons' 60 miles of hiking trails, Andreas Canyon's adjoining stream gives rise to bountiful vegetation which starkly contrasts the texture of the canyon's rocky routing.






Located off Highway 62 in Morongo Valley, these 31,000 preserved acres present a host of incredible hiking opportunities ranging from three-tenths of a mile to an 11-mile round-tripper through Big Morongo Canyon. Diverse plant life is abundant, as are more than 240 species of birds.





A sweeping array of nature and fitness treks greets guests across the 1,250-square-mile breadth of space, which makes Joshua Tree among the most popular hiking, camping and rock climbing attractions both nationally and internationally. For leisurely hikes, check out the three-mile 49 Palms Oasis hike or the four-mile Lost Horse Mine & Mountain hike.






Tahquitz Peak is a granite, 8,846-foot-tall rock formation on the high western slope of the San Jacinto Mountain range in Riverside County above the mountain town of Idyllwild. Tahquitz is a steep approach hike, leading to about a 1,000-foot face.




