THE SUMMER OLYMPICS | 2024




Breaking away from the traditional confines of a stadium, the opening ceremony will take place on the Seine River. This daring choice aligns perfectly with Paris 2024's vision of innovation and accessibility. The picturesque banks of the Seine will transform into a grand stage, with a procession running for 3.7 miles between **Pont d'Austerlitz and Pont d'Iéna**. The finale promises to be a visual feast, culminating in front of the iconic Trocadéro.

This unique setting will not only provide an impressive backdrop but also allow for an extraordinary number of spectators. An estimated 600,000 people are expected to witness the celebrations along the route, a figure that dwarfs the capacity of any Olympic stadium.

The two closing ceremonies at the **Stade de France** will mark the end of this historic event in France, promising to be just as breathtaking and memorable as the opening.

THE ARTISTRY BEHIND THE EVENT

The Paris Summer Olympics 2024 is shaping up to be more than just a sporting event; it's an ambitious artistic endeavor that aims to redefine the way we experience the Olympics. Under the guidance of Thomas Jolly, known for the exceptional, norm-defying shows with elevated performances and the vision of Tony Estanguet, President of Paris 2024, the world can expect a celebration that honors tradition while boldly forging a new path forward. Jolly's background in theatre and opera will undoubtedly influence the ceremonies' design, making them deeply engaging and emotionally resonant.





THE SUMMER OLYMPICS | A HISTORY OF THE OLYMPIC GAMES



The Olympic Games are a grand display of sportsmanship and unity, with a storied past stretching back three millennia. It all began in **776 BC** in Olympia, Greece, with a religious festival dedicated to Zeus, the king of the gods. The event, known as an "Olympiad," was held every four years and included a single event – the stade, a **192-meter race**. As time went on, more events were added, and the duration was extended to 17 days. Unlike modern Olympics, the ancient Games were highly religious, featured fewer events, and only free men who spoke Greek were allowed to compete. Unfortunately, they faded into obscurity in 393 AD, until Baron Pierre de Coubertin proposed the revival of the Olympics in 1894.

FAST FORWARD TO THE MODERN GAMES

Born again in **1894** after the Baron had championed their revival, the Games welcomed 280 athletes from 12 nations to **Athens** for the first modern-day Olympics. Since then, the Olympic Games have evolved into a stunning showcase of sportsmanship and unity, where people of all nationalities come together to compete in close to 70 sports. The **International Olympic Committee** (IOC) works tirelessly to ensure sustainability, efficiency, and equality, while maintaining the Olympic spirit of peace, understanding, and fairness.

PARIS AND FRANCE AS HOSTS

Paris will achieve a remarkable distinction by hosting the Summer Olympics for the third time, a feat matched only by London. The city previously held the games in 1900 and 1924, and this achievement gains even more significance as it marks France's sixth time as a host nation for the Olympics.

The Olympics continues to be a symbol of global solidarity and good-natured competition, preserving its ancient roots whilst striving for a better future.

THE SUMMER OLYMPICS | THE OLYMPIC TORCH

The Torch is a symbol of the Games that illuminates its spirit throughout the host city and beyond. As each edition of the Games progresses, it becomes evident that sports is a wonderful way to **bring people together in spite of competition**. The Torch and its **Flame** impart a message of **peace and solidarity**, connecting us all.

Manufactured by ArcelorMittal, the world's leading steel company and an Official Partner of Paris 2024, these Torches unite and inspire, radiating the spirit of the Games throughout France. With **2,000 Torches** produced, five times fewer than previous editions of the Games, ArcelorMittal is creating a more sustainable future.

In ancient tradition, the **Olympic Flame** would be ignited by the **sun's rays in Olympia**, Greece and then journey across the Mediterranean Sea to France. On 8 May 2024 in Marseille, the Flame of the 2024 Paris Olympics will kick off **a four-month-long festivity**, ending at the Opening Ceremony of the Olympic Games in Paris on July 26, 2024.

After two weeks of triumphs and festivities, the Olympic Flame will be extinguished, yet the Torch and what is symbolizes will remain and be carried on through the **Olympiad**.







THE OLYMPIC VENUES



ICONIC AND HISTORICAL VENUES

Featuring a total of **32 sports** and **329 events** in **35 different locations** or settings, the Games will see a variety of open-air arenas, iconic stadiums like **Roland Garros** and **Stade de France**, as well as newly-built facilities such as the **Centre Aquatique Olympique** – a modern swimming pool connected to the Stade de France by a passenger bridge!

Innovative and creative, Paris 2024 is also taking the sports out of the stadiums and into the heart of the city. While the existing sports venues will be revitalized with the influence of the Games, the iconic landmarks will be transformed into thrilling sporting arenas. From the newly-renovated **Grand Palais for fencing**, **Les Invalides for archery and para-archery** to **volleyball** at **Champ de Mars at the Eiffel Tower.** The 35 venues that will be featured throughout the Paris Games are united by a single concept – to use the power of sport to create a lasting legacy and bring us together.

PUSHING THE BOUNDARIES


The Paris Olympics will encompass a wide array of events beyond the boundaries of the City of Light. Sailboats will race across the waters of Marseille, while the waves of Tahiti in Polynesia (15,700 km from Paris) will serve as a thrilling venue for the surfing competitions.

Handball will take place in Lille, equestrian events in the Chateau de Versailles and six cities around the country will each host a soccer game - Marseille, Nice, Lyon, Saint-Etienne, Bordeaux and Nantes. Truly, these Olympic Games will be a world-spanning spectacle!



MAP | THE OLYMPICS VENUES & LVH HOMES



THE OLYMPIC VENUES | TOP VENUES



EIFFEL TOWER STADIUM | BEACH VOLLEYBALL

At the magnificent Eiffel Tower, a temporary open-air stadium with 12,860 seats is erected. Nestled in the picturesque Champs de Mars, Parisians would come together to enjoy Bastille Day fireworks and witness World Cup soccer matches displayed on huge screens. This time, however, it's beach volleyball that takes the center stage, creating memories that will last a lifetime.



CHÂTEAU DE VERSAILLES | EQUESTRIAN

The prestigious Château de Versailles creates a majestic atmosphere for the games, with dressage and showjumping performed on an arena constructed among the picturesque geometric lawns. Cross-country riding and the modern pentathlon will also be held amidst the grandeur of the Versailles grounds.



GRAND PALAIS | FENCING
AND TAEKWONDO

Situated in the heart of Paris, the Grand Palais is an architectural masterpiece with an impressive heritage. Constructed for the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900, its masterful nave and grand glass roof were made with the most innovative building techniques of the era. Now, after a thorough restoration, the Grand Palais is set to reopen in 2024 to host the Olympic and Paralympic Games in its breathtaking Nave.



STADE DE FRANCE | RUGBY & ATHLETICS

The Stade de France, built in 1998 for the FIFA World Cup where France emerged victorious, is the country's largest stadium and will be the site of the concluding match of the 2023 Rugby World Cup. Additionally, the Olympics will kick off here, with the men's and women's Rugby Sevens tournaments. Numerous other notable sporting events have been hosted at the Stade de France since its construction.

THE OLYMPIC VENUES | TOP VENUES



BERCY ARENA | BASKETBALL AND GYMNASTICS

The iconic 12th Arrondissement's grassy pyramid, otherwise known as the Accor Arena, is a grand multi-sports venue – hosting basketball, judo, concerts, and more. Bercy stands tall as one of the city's most vibrant entertainment centers – now ready to dazzle spectators with basketball, gymnastics, and wheelchair basketball during the upcoming Olympic and Paralympic Games.



ROLAND GARROS STADIUM | TENNIS AND BOXING

In the leafy Bois de Boulogne, on the western outskirts of Paris, lies the famous Roland Garros Stadium, host of the French Open since 1925. Greats such as Rafael Nadal and Venus Williams have graced these red clay courts, and the Olympic Tennis and Wheelchair Tennis competitions, as well as the Boxing Finals, will also be held here.



LA DÉFENSE ARENA | SWIMMING AND WATER POLO

As it gears up for the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games, the Arena is set to bring unparalleled excitement to the city of Nanterre. Designed by the architect, Christian de Portzamparc, its iconic exterior is composed of 600 dynamic giant aluminium and glass scales. Its crowning glory is the world's largest interactive giant screen: a 1,400-square-meter display made of seven tennis courts.



PARC DES PRINCES | SOCCER

Parc des Princes, the historic home of Paris Saint-Germain - one of Europe's premier soccer teams - stands proud as one of France's largest stadiums. In 2024, the legendary arena will welcome the world's top men's and women's soccer teams to compete in the finals of the much-anticipated tournament.

CHAMP DE MARS ARENA | WRESTLING & JUDO

At the 2024 Paris Games, the iconic Champ de Mars Arena will be more than just an 'overlay' of the Grand Palais. In 2024, the Arena will remain in place for a few extra months, serving as a venue for the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Designed by architect Jean-Michel Wilmotte, the Arena stands gracefully in the Champ de Mars with its timber structure, weaving harmonious curves that mirror the grandeur of the Grand Palais



PONT ALEXANDRE III | CYCLING, TRIATHLON

Connecting the Grand Palais and Invalides, Pont Alexandre III is the epitome of the Paris 2024 mission to bring the Games to life in the centre of the world's most enchanting city, surrounded by its iconic landmarks – like Concorde, Arena Champ-de-Mars, Pont d'léna and the Eiffel Tower stadium. It is here, beneath the bridge's stunning facade, that the finish line will be marked for the individual cycling time trials, swimming marathon, triathlon and para triathlon.



INVALIDES | ARCHERY

The beautiful Esplanade des Invalides in Paris' 7th arrondissement is a vast green space, sitting opposite the impressive Hôtel des Invalides. Constructed by Louis XIV in 1687 to serve as a military hospital and retirement home, the Hôtel is now home to museums, monuments and the tomb of Napoleon Bonaparte. In 2024, this will be the perfect stage for the archery and para archery events during the Olympic Games.




OLYMPIC AQUATIC CENTER | DIVING

The Olympic Aquatic Center, a marvel of modern architectural design and engineering, serves as the distinguished venue for aquatic sports during the prestigious Olympic Games. This grand facility hosts a myriad of water-based competitions, providing an arena for athletes from around the globe to showcase their extraordinary skills and compete for the coveted Olympic medals.





FRENCH TEATIME AU RITZ PARIS | TEA ROOM

There are two kinds of afternoon teas at the Ritz: with or without champagne. There's the English-style served with finger sandwiches and cakes in the Bar Vendome and the French teatime (goûter à la française) that takes place in the Salon Proust. It is an evocative, wood-lined world unto itself. Cocoon yourself in the intimate, serene atmosphere of this observatory on the rich mix of life that pulses throughout the Ritz Paris. Enjoy the magic and skillfulness of pastry chef François Perret under the watchful eye of Marcel Proust. French biscuits like Madeleines and cakes from Proust's era are given center stage here.

LES DEUX MAGOTS | CAFÉ

Like its neighbor and rival, Café de Flore, this legendary spot represents the height of Parisian café culture. Its large corner terrace is perfect for people-watching, giving you a view of both the bustling Boulevard Saint Germain and the Église Saint-Germain-des-Prés, one of the oldest churches in Paris. With its iconic green and white awning, Les Deux Magots is renowned for being the café where great literary minds like Jean-Paul Sartre, Simone de Beauvoir, and Albert Camus once gathered. It was also a favorite among American expatriates like Julia Child and James Baldwin. The restaurant maintains its literary legacy with the Deux Magots literary prize awarded to a new French work annually since 1933.





LADURÉE | TEA ROOM

Ladurée, a world-renowned French luxury patisserie, was founded in 1862. Ladurée offers an exquisite and original experience with its iconic macarons. The specialty store is an institution; it is for gourmands, whether you're craving a Religieuse, a La Fleur D'Oranger, or a St. Honoré Framboise. It's worth a visit for the presentation, taste, and atmosphere.

BERTHILLON | ICE CREAM SHOP

Berthillon ice cream on the Île Saint-Louis has become an essential summer tradition in Paris for almost 70 years. This picturesque wooden interior shop offers irresistible sorbets, ice creams, and pastries. And many times, the ice cream has been ranked as the best in Paris. Whatever your choice, you will not be disappointed. If you're having trouble deciding, go for the wild strawberry sorbet, which was the ingredient that made Berthillon famous.



CAFÉ DE FLORE | CAFÉ

Café de Flore is one of the two legendary cafes in Saint-Germain in Paris. As one of the oldest cafes in Paris, it was the preferred refuge for writers, philosophers, and artists such as Georges Bataille and Pablo Picasso. The interior of this eternally elegant cafe has not changed much since World War II, and sitting down to have a bite can feel like a journey back in time.










THE LOUVRE MUSEUM




MOULIN ROUGE




