

### **ABOUT**

Once known for its mining industry, Park City, UT is nestled in crevices of the Wasatch Mountain Range with miles of snowy terrain surrounding the town. Park City is a prime destination for anyone looking for a winter wonderland. Known for the ultimate winter trifecta: snowboarding, skiing and the Sundance Film Festival, Park City can provide an epic adventure. The city has two major ski resorts: Deer Valley Resort and Park City Mountain Resort. Back in 2015, thanks to an alliance with mountain behemoth Vail Resorts, Park City Ski Resort and Canyons Resorts merged into Park City Mountain Resort. The result is a 7,300–acre mountain retreat complete with a high–speed gondola, Quicksilver, as well as a handful of new on–mountain upgrades.

In addition to being the home to the United States Ski Team and training center for members of the Australian Freestyle Ski Team, Park City houses the 2002 Olympic bobsled/skeleton/luge track at the Utah Olympic Park along with several outstanding golf courses. The city is the main location of the United States' largest independent film festival, the Sundance Film Festival, making it a hip place to be at the end of January. That being said, winter vacation in Utah certainly has its draws – wide-open terrain, more bluebird days than you can count, and some seriously good, consistent snow. Another draw is the proximity to the airport. This laid-back, former mining town is rightfully getting the attention it deserves.




Park City neighborhoods are varied and each one has unique characteristics. From the historic charm of Old Town, the opulence of Deer Valley Resort with its many ski-in/ski-out properties, the country club golf resorts of Glenwild and Promontory, to the more remote areas nestled high in the trees, Park City boast distinctive neighborhoods catering to every lifestyle. 


#### **DEER VALLEY**

Tucked in the Wasatch Mountain range, Deer Valley Resort consistently tops lists for its customer service. Featuring upscale and luxurious facilities, you can enjoy a plethora of amenities that can't be found anywhere else. Deer Valley competes by catering to a more upscale audience than its neighbors. Eleven Deer Valley ski runs lie within its community boundaries and include Deer Valley's mile-long, high-speed detachable gondola. 
#### **UPPER DEER VALLEY**



Open Thursday to Saturday for lunch and Sunday for brunch. Advanced reservations are highly recommended as space fills up quickly.





Enjoy elevated comfort food inspired by mountain regions from around the world. Treat yourself to a mouthwatering seasonal menu inspired by the finest local ingredients. Powder's rotating menu and serene mountain setting make it truly one of the best restaurants with a view. Expect a romantic dusting of white powder around the property in the winter and warm up by ordering the wild and exotic mushroom cappuccino "soup," finished with a dollop of rich crème. No matter what's on the menu, you're bound to enjoy the views on and off your plate.



#### **RUTH'S CHRIS STEAK HOUSE | AMERICAN**

Located in the elegant Hotel Park City with amazing views of the Wasatch Mountains, Ruth's Chris will dazzle mogul skiers, local carnivores and distinguished hotel guests alike with its stellar cuisine and impeccable service. Whether you are on a romantic dinner date, a business meeting, a private party or just a drink at the bar, this steakhouse will deliver superior service and an unforgettable dining experience. The steakhouse features US prime steaks, broiled to perfection, expertly executed seafood, New Orleans-inspired appetizers, unforgettable desserts and an award-winning wine list.





Step into the Handle dining room to find natural wood, an open kitchen, and a new American menu heavy on the shared plates. While modern comfort food is ubiquitous across the city, Handle shines with a strong cocktail program and items like cauliflower glazed in sweet chile and orange sauce, beetroot carpaccio with Greek yogurt, apricot agridulce and watercress.



#### **BANGKOK THAI ON THE MAIN I THAI**

As the first Thai restaurant to land in Park City, Bangkok Thai has been a Main Street staple since 1994. Now under new ownership, chef Wichayanee ("Yanee") Chayangkura is doling out fresh bowls of Thai food while honoring the beloved restaurant's history. Start with classic appetizers like coconut sesame shrimp, roasted duck with steamed buns, and chicken satay, then move on to inventive signature dishes like three-flavor sea bass, pineapple fried rice and an extensive curry and noodle menu to round out your feast.




#### YUKI YAAMA SUSHI | JAPANESE

Yuki Yama, which translates to "snow mountain," is rife with traditional Japanese hospitality – complete with the most covetable table in a private tatami room for up to nine guests. Start with Executive Chef Kirk Terashima's tuna tartare and yama–mame, boiled soybean pods sauteed in sesame oil, garlic, togarashi, and cherry preserves. Then dive into everything from savory pork ramen to well–composed sushi rolls, paired with Japanese whisky and sake from the restaurant's extensive and limited–availability spirits list.



### **RIVERHORSE ON MAIN | AMERICAN**

Riverhouse, the sophisticated sanctuary on Main Street, possesses a big-city style and a welcoming ski-town attitude. It's one of the oldest and most distinguished restaurants in town. Highly regarded by both critics and the dining public, Riverhorse touts an impressive list of accolades and was the first restaurant in Utah to receive the prestigious DiRoNA Award. The menu offers a rotating cast of locally sourced dishes like Morgan Valley lamb lollipops, a trio of wild game, and rainbow trout.





If you have a craving for wood-fired meats and delicious cocktails, head to Chef John Murcko's Main Street restaurant, Firewood. This eatery is about the senses. About taste. About the warmth of a meal well made. It's about experiencing locally sourced seasonal food cooked by wood fire, enhancing its flavor and keeping the connection between food and terrain. The restaurant's glowing ambiance with a giant wood-fire grill set behind antique windows allows you a sneak peek at all of the action in the kitchen. The turn-of-the-century industrial décor goes hand in hand with the restaurant's cuisine.



#### **RIME | AMERICAN**

As the elegant signature restaurant of the five-star St. Regis Deer Valley, Rime presents a seasonal menu built on sustainably caught seafood and locally sourced meat that arrive fresh each morning. Long-time St. Regis Deer Valley Chef Matthew Harris is dedicated to tried-and-true dishes like diver scallops, grilled whole bass, and classic cuts of beef from Snake River Farms and Niman Ranch – all of which pair perfectly with any selection from the restaurant's award-winning wine cellar, holding more than 10,000 bottles.



#### **GLITRETIND RESTAURANT | AMERICAN**

The amalgam of alpine elegance, an innovative menu and an award-winning wine list make the Glitretind at Stein Eriksen Lodge the most breathtaking dining experience. Nestled among picturesque aspens at Deer Valley Resort, the Glitretind offers regional American cuisine in a warm and elegant setting. Executive Chef Zane Holmquist focuses on seasonal menus and fresh, local and sustainable ingredients for his award-winning dishes. The knowledgeable sommelier is charged with selecting, purchasing, and pairing wine with the seasonal menus.




#### THE VIKING YURT | SCANDINAVIAN

Dinner at The Viking Yurt (winter only) is a dining experience that truly sets Park City apart from other ski destinations. A snowcat-pulled sleigh draws guests up a ski run through aspen and conifer groves with incredible views of the night sky, Park City and surrounding mountains sets of your magical Nordic-themed culinary adventure at the Viking Yurt. Being the only ones on the top of the mountain at night in the deep pine forest is thrilling. Upon entering the toasty warm yurt (located at 8,700 feet), you'll be greeted by the sounds of piano and the sweet fragrance of holiday spice. Capped at 40-people with communal dining arrangements, the intimate six-course dinner features a stellar lobster and salmon bisque, cheese course, braised rib, and more. For a fun photo op, try on the Viking helmets and sip Gløgg from large goblets.



#### **APEX AT MONTAGE | CONTINENTAL**

Apex, Montage Deer Valley's signature restaurant, is a celebration of classic continental cuisine in an unforgettable mountain setting, offering guests a relaxed yet refined dining experience. With floor-to-ceiling windows, you can dine while enjoying the restaurant's sophisticated ambiance, continental cuisine, and supreme landscapes. An array of seasonal breakfast, lunch and dinner options make Apex an ideal setting for a mid-day break from the slopes or a refined evening gathering. Delight your taste buds with the decadent coriander-crusted Utah pork belly accompanied by banana vindaloo, oven-dried grapes, and verjus or an Apex Steak which pays homage to Montage Deer Valley's unique location high in the mountains of Empire Pass.










### THE ARTS

#### **SUNDANCE INSTITUTE**

Sundance Institute, a nonprofit organization, was founded by Robert Redford in 1981 with the mission of fostering new voices in American storytelling. The institute is a champion and curator of stories for the stage and screen. Each year in late January, the institute hosts the annual Sundance Film Festival, considered to be one of three top film festivals in the world bringing artists and audiences together for premieres of groundbreaking work.



Park City Film is a single-screen, non-profit art house cinema presenting a curated selection of independent, foreign and documentary films, as well as film-related events. The vision is to use film as a medium to entertain, inspire and educate patrons, helping Park City to remain a well-informed and engaged mountain community.






Since its establishment in 2008, Gallery MAR has been a place where brilliant artistic visions meet the everyday lives of collectors around the globe. With a fresh and lively atmosphere, Gallery MAR seeks to educate and inspire collectors while supporting and encouraging nationally-touted artists.



#### **FATALI GALLERY**

Fatali Gallery represents the work of Michael Fatali, aka Light Hunter, the name given to him with honor by the Navajos. His images span a 40-year event of hunting for light through the desert southwest. His intimate relationship with the canyons, Navajo people and the light began when he first explored and helped discover slot canyons bordering Northern Arizona–Southern Utah. Fatali is celebrated as the world's top landscape photographer.





McMillen Fine Art Photography offers spectacular landscape photography. It will simply transport the viewer to a moment in time that may have otherwise gone unnoticed. If you're looking for a wonderful photography experience, make sure this gallery is on your itinerary.



#### **EGYPTIAN THEATRE**


This Egyptian–Revival Theater is both a cultural treasure and the beating heart of the annual Sundance Film Festival. The theatre is Park City's hub for art, culture, and entertainment – all from a perch atop Main Street. The historic stage is home to classical and contemporary theatrical and musical performances and stand-up shows.





Museums are by definition places where questions about past events are answered and history of a place and its heritage are preserved and protected. With interactive exhibitions and plethora of memorabilia of forgone days, Park City's museums offers its visitors an insight into its colorful mining and ski history.





#### **ALF ENGEN SKI MUSEUM**

Within the Alf Engen Ski Museum at the Utah Olympic Park is the George Eccles Salt Lake 2002 Olympic Winter Games Museum. It offers visitors the opportunity to experience winter sports using state-of-the-art interactive and virtual exhibits. Athletes, volunteers and sports that were represented at the games are honored in dedicated displays. One of the USA's most extensive collections of ski and Olympic Winter Games memorabilia is on show. The museum opened in 2005 and is funded by generous benefactors.





The Park City Museum was a part of a renovation and expansion project of three historic buildings – Old City Hall, the Fire Whistle Tower, and the Old Library – to create a state-of-the-art museum in the heart of Park City's historic Main Street district. This museum, with its permanent exhibitions like an original stagecoach or the historical Silver King Mine, and Territorial Jail in the basement of the Old City Hall make great places to become familiar with the town's racy past and its rise to international resort status up to and after the 2002 Winter Olympics.





### **APRÈS LOUNGE - VEUVE CLICQUOT YURT**



The dishes are a testament to mariners who set off in the cold of winter to capture the sea's salty harvest. Respecting the fruits of their labor, dishes that satisfy are prepared with simplicity. Proven, sumptuous classics transport you to the coastlines with each bite all the while you're feasting your eyes on the blankets of snow.






While Utah's liquor laws are stringent, Park City's nightlife scene is anything but buttoned up. #### **HIGH WEST SALOON**

Try one of the killer cocktails like the Marooned Miner – a mix of rye whiskey, rum, creme de cacao, and blueberry cardamom bitters or opt for a flight of four whiskey tastings. Then tuck into comfort food like elk chili, bison short ribs, and chicken schnitzel. High West's chefs fuse classic techniques, regional and seasonal flavors, as well as High West Distillery spirits to create innovative nouveau western fare.





Downstairs is the spot if you're looking to mingle. Danny Masterson, who played witty and sarcastic Hyde on "That 70's Show," owns Downstairs and has turned the place into the type of club he and his buddies would want to let loose in. The dance floor at Downstairs gets packed, the cocktail waitresses aren't afraid to dance on the tables and the rotating cast of DJs spin EDM tracks well into the night.





Fletcher's will tickle your tastebuds with contemporary American dishes, The Library Lounge is an excellent place for a late-night bottle of wine with friends after a full day on the pistes. The interior design of the locale is a mixture of reclaimed wood, brick and raw materials fused with vintage and modern elements to create an eclectic and hip vibe. It definitely deserves visiting.







# **NIGHTLIFE**







During the festival, daily filmmaker conversations, panel discussions and live music events are part of the accompanying program. Since 1985, hundreds of films launched at the festival have gained critical recognition and acclaim, reaching new audiences worldwide. Screenings and events are held at Park City, Salt Lake City and Sundance Resort.





Considered one of the premier art festivals in the nation, this three-day festival hosts more than 200 of the best fine artists from across the country who sell their works on Main Street. #### **DEER VALLEY MUSIC FESTIVAL**

The Deer Valley Music Festival is the summer home of the Utah Symphony. The eight-week series in July and early August takes place in spectacular Park City venues surrounded by the Wasatch Mountains. The vision of the festival is to be renowned for consistently delivering a high-quality and musically diverse experience ranging from chamber music, classical, and pop, in casual settings of unparalleled natural beauty. The festival is held in several venues: the Deer Valley Snow Park Outdoor Amphitheater, St. Mary's Church and salon events in private homes in the Park City area. Past artists featured at the festival in performance with the Utah Symphony include The Beach Boys, Ben Folds, The B-52s, Earth Wind and Fire, Kristin Chenoweth, Tony Bennett, Idina Menzel, Diana Krall, Elvis Costello, Gladys Knight, Matthew Morrison, Smokey Robinson, Kenny Rogers, and many more.



#### **BEETHOVEN FESTIVAL PARK CITY**

The Beethoven Festival Park City, originally founded as the Deer Valley Chamber Music Festival in 1984, is the flagship project of The Park City Chamber Music Society, one of the oldest arts non-profit organizations in Summit County. This festival presents 35–40 performances throughout the year in the form of the Summer Festival, the Autumn Classics Music Festival, the Spring Chamber Music Festival as well as individual concerts and outreach performances.

#### **SKIING**






#### **HELI-SKIING & SNOWBOARDING**

#### **FAT TIRE BIKING**




#### **ICE SKATING**


#### **EXPLORE ICE CASTLES**

#### **HIKING**



# ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE (ATV) TOUR IN UINTA MOUNTAINS

• Russ McDonald Field (KHCR / HCR)

• Salt Lake City International (KSLC / SLC)

The most commonly selected private jets by category in the area around Park City include light jets (Citation V and Learjet 35A), midsize jets (Learjet 60, Hawker 800, and Gulfstream G150), and large jets (Gulfstream III and Falcon 2000).
