### **ABOUT**



#### **BAVARO**

If you want to leave the resort on your own to shop or just walk around without renting a car, it is best to stay in the Bavaro area, particularly the Los Corales or El Cortecito neighborhoods. With shopping malls, town plazas with various shops and bodegas, Playa Bavaro is the most popular, developed, and populated beach and resort area in Punta Cana, with tourists and locals indulging in the plethora of activities and amenities. While being one of the most sought-after beaches, Playa Bavaro remains pristine with its palm trees, powder-white sand and little nooks where you can carve out some privacy. Parts of the beach have been awarded Blue Flag status and the offshore reef provides protection. That reef is located just off the coast and is famous among divers and snorkelers. Los Corales is Bavaro's upscale neighborhood and a luxurious beach within the town. The architecture is mostly Mediterranean with outstanding sea views, abundant palm trees and white powdered crystal sand. This charming corner of the world offers fine dining, spas, beauty centers, excursions, and all kinds of activities.




#### **PUNTA CANA**

This Caribbean's premier golf and beach resort destination, located in the unspoiled habitat of Punta Cana, offers a top-notch vacation experience and accommodations. 
#### **CAP CANA**

Cap Cana is in the heart of the Caribbean, on the eastern shores of the Dominican Republic. This exclusive real estate and hotel tourist enclave is recognized as among the best in the Caribbean. The neighborhood is home to luxury properties, such as Eden Roc at Cap Cana, Sanctuary Cap Cana, and AlSol Tiara Cap Cana. The area, spanning more than 6,000 acres, also shelters the ritzy Punta Espada Golf Course, its marina, equestrian center and eco-park. However, the epicenter of Cap Cana is its state-of-the-art marina. A perfect place to begin your day of adventures - to go sailing on your yacht, tour the beautiful shores of the Dominican, fish and explore the treasures of the DR. The Cap Cana Marina has more than 150 slips, accommodating up to 150-foot yachts, with complete services for captains and crew. Its coastlines are considered by the Billfish Report to be the No. 1 spot in the world for fishing and deep-water diving. The marina has been the scene of world-famous fishing tournaments and has become a popular destination among those who enjoy record-breaking fishing.





### **PLAYA ESMERALDA**

Playa Esmeralda is a true hidden gem in the extended area of Punta Cana, in Miches. Until recently, it was one of the most remote beaches in the country, but it got better accessibility with Club Med luxury all-inclusive eco-resort, which opened in 2021. It is still a gorgeous stretch of beach, resembling what you would imagine is like being stranded on a deserted island. When you visit, you will most likely be on your own, so enjoy having this paradise all to yourself. On your way to Playa Esmeralda, you can make a stop at Montaña Redonda, a hill with spectacular photo opportunities, thanks to its giant swings right at the edge of the mountain.



#### **MACAO BEACH**

Easily one of the Dominican Republic's top-five most stunning beaches, the mega-wide, brilliant blonde, palm-tree studded Playa Macao is a surfer's favorite. The beach is on the northern end of the Punta Cana region and is known for its swells and trade winds. On-site surfing classes of all levels are available year-round, particularly on weekends. Macao Beach made it to the "Best Beaches in the Caribbean 2020" list by TripAdvisor's Travellers Choice Best of the Best. Sink your toes into the fine-grain sands, dip your feet into the clear, tepid water and if you work up an appetite in the waves, pick up a snack at one of the local food stalls; the freshly caught fish or lobster are prepared right in front of you while you wait. The main beach of the area, Playa Macao, gets praises for its natural beauty, remaining mostly wild and free of development. UNESCO declared it one of the top beaches in the Caribbean.






The most beautiful stretch of beach in the Punta Cana area is undoubtedly Bavaro Beach, just north of Punta Cana. The calm Caribbean waters are perfect for swimming or wading. The color of the water is typical Caribbean turquoise to an aquamarine hue that stretches out well beyond the roped-off swimming area to the protective reef in the distance. The beach stretches for miles, more than perfect for endless beach walks.



### PLAYA BLANCA ("WHITE BEACH")

Part of the Puntacana Resort & Club, Playa Blanca is a water sports hub with good food and beachside relaxation. The beach is available to anyone dining at the famous, on-site Playa Blanca Restaurant. Try your hand at kitesurfing, stand-up paddleboarding, or sign up for a diving and snorkeling excursion nearby. Every year, Playa Blanca hosts an annual Kite Fest, when the beach turns into one big celebration with visiting kite surfers from around the country performing impressive stunts.





Often ranked as one of the best beaches in the Dominican Republic, Playa Juanillo offers miles of pristine, powdery white sand beach flanked with gigantic palm trees and turquoise water. The contrast of Caribbean colors is so sharp that the entire scene looks like a billboard commercial. Beach activities such as volleyball, snorkeling, kayaking and kiteboarding are also popular here thanks to excellent wind conditions. Then again, doing nothing except floating on Juanillo's crystal clear water is also perfectly fine.






This fine dining establishment was named after the island of Montserrat in the west Caribbean. The island was the home of the music studio where Rock and Roll history was made in the 70s and 80s. This modern American steakhouse offers the highest prime meat brought in directly from Chicago, hand-selected and wet-aged for 21 days. Of course, the specialty is local fish caught daily and lobsters. You will be treated to a mouthwatering meal and fine beverages.



#### LA PALAPA BY EDEN ROC | MEDITERRANEAN

Breathtaking views of the Caribbean Sea; fresh, local ingredients; and globally inspired cuisine are La Palapa by Eden Roc's recipe for a truly memorable dining experience. At La Palapa, the freshest fish and seafood is expertly prepared and can be enjoyed as sushi, savored as ceviche or paired with sumptuous handmade gnocchi and homemade pasta. A sophisticated fusion approach blending Mediterranean favorites with traditional Caribbean cuisine rounds out the restaurant's refined offerings. Surroundings provide a chic ambiance, making the most of the beachside location, with seating available over the water and in an open-sided pavilion complete with a namesake palapa roof.





The Steakhouse at Sanctuary Cap Cana is designed as a traditional Argentinean Grill, complete with a cast iron and brick oven that uses wood and charcoal to achieve perfect flavor. Steaks are brought to the table sizzling on a slab of hot stone. The selection of cuts is wide and pleases even the most demanding palate.






### LA YOLA I MEDITERRANEAN

On the list of the best restaurants in Punta Cana is La Yola, yet another of Oscar de la Renta's interior design endeavors, a mix of teak and bamboo with a thatched roof. Set beside the marina, dining here makes you feel like you're on a fishing boat with views, smells and sounds of the sea. The restaurant serves Mediterranean and Caribbean cuisine. On the menu, and always dexterously prepared, are the grouper, salmon, octopus and lobster. The restaurant serves great ceviche and crème brûlée, too. If you follow a gluten-free diet, La Yola will accommodate your needs.






Besides the yearly Art Weekend in Macao Hostel and the Art Gallery in Puntacana Village, there are some quaint galleries, art shops and museums around Punta Cana for you to explore. If you want to go big on art, it's probably a good idea to make a day trip to Santo Domingo's Colonial City, the first urban settlement in the New World. Many excellent museums are located within the area, giving insight into the Spanish colonial day, from the Alcázar de Colón Palace to the Museo de las Casas Reales. La Romana's Altos de Chavón is home to the most comprehensive display on the Taino at the Regional Museum of Archeology.

Get valuable insight into the country's indigenous culture, history, and way of life in one place, while enjoying a day out in nature, the Yucayeke Museo Indígena is a first of its kind in the Dominican Republic. It is a center of ecotourism located on a farm in Macao, recreating life scenes in a replica of Taino village. Complete with "bohios" — traditional thatch huts — the replica village has items on display used in everyday life and traditional dance performances.




#### **BASILICA & MUSEUM DE LA ALTAGRACIA**

Located in nearby Higüey and inaugurated in 1971, this cathedral ranks among the most important religious sites in the Dominican Republic. Honoring the Virgin of La Altagracia, the patron saint of Dominicans, it stands out for its 69-meter or 225 feet high arch, with a bronze and gold entrance. La Altagracia Museum, located on the grounds of the basílica, features an impressive collection of paintings and gold jewelry dating back to the 17th century up to the 20th. It also showcases the religious history and culture of the Dominican Republic and the country's devotion to the Virgin of La Altagracia.



#### **CHOCOMUSEO**

Located inside the Mundo Auténtico shopping complex, Chocomuseo is a popular spot due to its many chocolate tasting opportunities. This one-stop-shop provides a quick museum-style display and guided tour on the history of Dominican cacao, one of the country's top-four exports, as well as the chocolate-making process from tree to bar. Sign up for a hands-on, half-day chocolate-making workshop if you have time.





Juan Ponce de León was a 16th century Spanish explorer. His residence stands in the southeastern town of San Rafael de Yuma, close to Higüey, where he lived before heading out into the seas to conquer neighboring Puerto Rico and later heading to Florida. The house has been turned into a museum where a few preserved household items and artifacts are displayed, including 16th century furniture.






### **SHOPPING**

There are a handful of Dominican and international boutiques in Punta Cana. Local arts and crafts are ubiquitous. The best places to go shopping include some of the region's modern malls, quaint boutiques, and family-friendly dining and retail complexes. Artisan markets and boutiques are the best places to buy jewelry made with Larimar – a precious stone found only in the Dominican Republic. Farther south, Cap Cana is the ultimate area for luxury shopping, boasting multiple high-end gift shops, art galleries, designer beachwear and clothing, including the late Dominican designer Jenny Polanco's store and interior design boutiques. Along the way, meander through colorful produce markets present in every town and brimming with abundant fruits and vegetables. Pick up amber or larimar jewelry, cigars, chocolate, coffee, or a flask of mamajuana (a spiced alcoholic beverage made by infusing a mixture of rum, red wine, and honey with tree bark and herbs) to take home as a vacation memento.

Uvero Alto, the most northern part of Punta Cana, is more remote and luxurious. It's here you can find the Taino Shop selling local art. They sell little gems, from stones to small statues, jewelry, wood carvings and paintings of the area. The women in the shop can tell you all you need to know about the artifacts and art pieces before you make your choice.



#### **VIVALDI CIGARS**

In 1992 a young Dutch entrepreneur came to the Dominican Republic, where he soon teamed up with a young promising Dominican master blender. Their combined effort and enthusiasm initiated the birth of Vivaldi Cigars. Riding along on the wave of the Dominican cigar boom in the 90s, Bert van Kol and Francisco Rivas soon became the go-to guys for the demanding cigar smoker. With their uncompromising blending and surprising quality of cigars, they earned their spot among the big boys in the industry. You can become part of the Vivaldi Brotherhood, get some of the best handmade long-fillers in the world, and share your experiences with a seasoned and passionate smoker.



### **CHEZ NICOLE BOUTIQUE**

Chez Nicole Boutique is a high-end store at the Residencial Palma Real Villas at The Golf Suites. Shoppers looking for high-quality souvenirs, organic wellness products and locally handmade jewelry could easily spend a couple of hours at this chic boutique. Besides shopping, you can discover some local culinary traditions. You can sample Dominican chocolate, learn how cacao is made, taste homemade mamajuana beverages, and watch a demonstration to see how local cigars are traditionally rolled.





When you visit the Dominican Republic, there are four things you should bring home: Cigars, rum, coffee and chocolate. Here is your chance to buy all of these items simultaneously. Mundo Autentico is the shop attached to the Don Lucas Cigar Factory. If you want to bring cigars home with you, Mundo Autentico is the best place to buy them. You can also purchase other authentic and genuine Dominican Republic products, including amber, larimar, paintings, rum, coffee, cacao and mamajuana. Mundo Autentico consists of Don Lucas Cigars, ChocoMuseo, Coffee Museum and Rum bar and lounge.





Shopping in Punta Cana is synonymous with the area's flair for the sophisticated seaside life. Blue Mall Puntacana, an upscale mall with high-end boutiques and surrounding cafés and restaurants, is the latest shopping hub to open. The upmarket shopping mall is located two kilometers from Punta Cana International Airport. It is a great place to spend a couple hours when you feel like escaping the tropical heat. The single-floor, air-conditioned mall consists of boutiques selling international brands and excellent cafés and restaurants.



#### **SHOPPING IN CAP CANA**

Cap Cana offers the ultimate luxury shopping experience in Punta Cana. Situated in the south, the real estate and hotel destination is famous for its high-end resorts and the ocean-facing Punta Espada Golf Club with views of the Caribbean Sea. Dotted around Cap Cana are excellent upscale stores selling art, books, music, designer beach gear, and locally made Dominican gifts such as cigars and rum. You can shop for larimar gemstones at the Cap Cana Marina, unique to the Dominican Republic.

Step into the store of breakthrough Dominican designer, the late Jenny Polanco. You'll be tempted to buy something from her Prêt-à-Porter and Couture collection of home décor, clothing, jewelry and accessories. The designer's creations fuse sophisticated lines, drapes, and exquisite cuts, with handcrafted details of the Dominican vernacular: buttons in amber, details in horn, larimar, nacre, coral, among other autochthonous elements.






Punta Cana buzzes by day on the beach, but the beat continues at night. Some of the most modern, uniquely designed nightclubs and live music venues are here. Dance inside a cave turned disco at Imagine, with multiple chambers echoing with tunes from house music to merengue. For more late nights, Oro Nightclub, inside the Hard Rock Punta Cana, is the dance spot for the young and restless. For Dominican and Latin sounds, head to Bachata Rosa – a restaurant and pop music bar venue inside Blue Mall Punta Cana, co-owned by multiple Grammy Award-winning Dominican singer Juan Luis Guerra. Near Juanillo beach, Sanctuary Town offers guests a night filled with options, boasting cafes and bars, including a traditional English pub. The cigar clubs and tapas lounges in this area rank among the most upscale in the DR, and you'll find additional over-the-water hotel bars with panoramic sea views.

After its launch in November 2011, ORO Nightclub Punta Cana became the gem of the Caribbean and in moments, ranked as the Best Nightclub in the Dominican Republic. Located inside the Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Punta Cana, ORO is modeled to rival Las Vegas and Miami's finest nightclubs. It was designed by Francois Frossard, who drew inspiration from the sensuality of the Dominican Republic. ORO Nightclub Punta Cana maximizes the nightclub experience and creates a state of euphoria. The nightclub has been the scene of great DJs such as Steve Angelo, Erick Morillo, Bob Sinclar, Dimitri Vegas & Like Mike and world-renowned artists such as Inna, Akon, Daddy Yankee, Snoop Dogg, aka Snoop Lion, among many others.





Most Punta Cana's resorts – from Bavaro to Punta Cana and Uvero Alto – offer modern, lively casino facilities that stay open all night long. The largest is the award-winning Hard Rock Casino, with 40 gaming tables and 400 slots. Inside the Bavaro Princess Hotel, the Princess Casino also attracts its fair share of custom with its Texas Hold 'em poker, roulette, blackjack, and live music. 

Visitors can uncover culture, excitement, and fun every year through the Dominican Republic's festivals and events. ### THE CARNIVAL

The Punta Cana Carnival is held on the main avenue of Punta Cana Village, in front of the international airport on the second Saturday in March. It is an exceptional occasion for visitors and locals in this area as the streets become a true party. The main attraction is the procession of floats showing off colorful costumes to the sounds of Caribbean music. Many will be in costumes with giant decorated heads simulating demons, known as telephones, typical of the Dominican Republic. In contrast, other outfits will consist of silk fabrics covered in shiny mirrors. Punta Cana Carnival is, without a doubt, a perfect event to discover the most positive side of the Dominican Republic.






The Festival Presidente, previously known as Festival Presidente de Música Latina, is one of the most important musical events in Latin America and is the largest in the Caribbean region. The festival is arranged by the Cervecería Nacional Dominicana (makers of Presidente beer) and is celebrated every two years for three days during October in the Estadio Olímpico Félix Sánchez of Santo Domingo.



### **DOMINICAN BASEBALL LEAGUE**

Baseball was first brought to the Dominican Republic by Cubans fleeing the Ten Years' War. The sport's growing popularity led to the formation of The Dominican Republic Professional Baseball League (Spanish: Liga de Béisbol Profesional de la República Dominicana) – a winter professional baseball league consisting of six teams from the Dominican Republic. It is the highest level of professional baseball in the country. Each team plays a 50-game round-robin schedule in mid-October and runs to December. The league's champion advances to the Caribbean Series to play against Mexico, Venezuela, Cuba, and Puerto Rico representatives.





#### **SCAPE PARK**

Located in Cap Cana, the sprawling Scape Park is a massive green space ideal for spending the day experiencing a myriad of outdoor adventures in a natural setting. Families find their bliss here – whether swimming in the Hoyo Azul turquoise cenote, hiking the botanical gardens on–site and learning about orchids, ziplining past a thick canopy, horseback riding or driving buggies through the wilderness. For more adrenaline, sign up for the Iguabonita Cave Expedition, which will take you hiking up the 100–meter high EI Farallón cliff extending 800 meters along the coast and descending into a vast underground network of caves and tunnels. The famous sinkhole Hoyo Azul or Blue Hole, a natural phenomenon filled with crystal–clear water, is at the base of the cliff. The natural theme park also embraces the cultural heritage and traditions of Latin America and the Caribbean with replica homes of the ancient Taino Indians who occupied the land before the Conquistadors arrived.





Punta Cana is much more than sun and white sand beaches, more than big hotels and countless tourists strolling through its beautiful beaches. There are so many hidden gems unbeknownst to most tourists. There are horseback riding tours like no other! Ride on an impressive virgin beach and places like Higuey, Seibo, Miches, Playa Arriba, and Macao Beach. Gallop through great sugarcane fields on your way to visit coffee and cocoa plantations.




### **BUGGY ADVENTURES**

#### **PUNTA ESPADA GOLF CLUB**





The whale watching season 2022 in the Dominican Republic is approaching. Every year, Humpback whales visit the warm waters in search of a comfortable and safe place to mate and give birth to their calves. They start arriving in Samana Bay and Banco de la Plata, in Puerto Plata, from **Jan. 15** and stay until the end of March. It is one of the not-to-miss highlights in the entire Dominican Republic. You can book a whale-watching experience as an air tour by plane. The excursion combines the best of both worlds: flying from Punta Cana to Samana in a small propeller airplane and watching gigantic Humpback whales as they mate or give birth. Furthermore, you can spot the whales with a success rate of nearly 100% – and usually, you see not only just one, you see pods.




# AIR TOUR TO SAMANA PENINSULA TRIP TO ISLAND CAYO LEVANTADO

Not only can you go on helicopter tours, but you can also explore some of the most notable highlights in the Dominican Republic on an airplane excursion from Punta Cana. Experience beautiful views from above over the east coast of the Dominican Republic and the Samana Bay. The air tour to Samana includes beautiful attractions the peninsula offers, like the lush countryside with the picturesque waterfall El Limón and the famous island Cayo Levantado, aka Bacardi Island. 
# AIR TOUR TO SAMANA PENINSULA HORSEBACK RIDE TO SALTO EL LIMON

Once you hit the ground on the Samaná Peninsula, a jungle trek on horseback to the Salto El Limon (Lemon Waterfall) is one of DR's to-do activities/adventures. The Salto El Limon is a 170-foot cascading waterfall ending in a swimming hole. A guide will lead your horses through a sleepy village, up the steep and rocky paths, through dense forest and across a river, and the reward is a refreshing dip in the cool water.





Located inside the exclusive Puntacana Resort & Club complex, this 1,500-acre nature reserve and ecological park is open to the public to enjoy its enchanting, shaded hiking trails that wind through a lush tropical forest leading towards a series of 12 freshwater lagoons. The most popular lagoon for swimming has a wooden deck and a diving platform for those who wish to leap into the turquoise and emerald fresh waters.



# LOS HAITISES NATIONAL PARK BIRDWATCHING AND WILDLIFE EXPLORATION

Los Haitises National Park offers a fabulous day out in nature, with sightings of endless mangroves, secluded islands, mystic cloud forests, spectacular views and lush bays. If you watch close enough, you might also spot fantastic wildlife such as frigate birds, manatees and pelicans. Los Haitises is home to two endemic species for passionate birdwatchers, the Ridgeway Hawk and the Ashy–Faced Owl. The national park can be explored as part of guided hiking or bird watching tours, by boat, by kayaking through the mangroves and even (partly) from the air, by ziplining. Certainly among the biggest attractions in Los Haitises are many historic caves where the old native inhabitants, the Taínos, lived and protected themselves many centuries ago.



#### PLANE EXCURSION TO SANTO DOMINGO

Santo Domingo, the capital of the Dominican Republic, is a bit more than two hours away from Punta Cana by car but a quick 35-minute flight. While the city itself is a chaotic, loud and gigantic Latin American metropolis, it features a particular district, the "Zona Colonial," awarded UNESCO world heritage site. The historic center of the city with its ancient cobblestone streets, centuries-old colorful buildings, the colonial charm of the architecture of historical importance and creative art scene is a place not to miss in Santo Domingo and one of the top highlights in the entire Dominican Republic. Considering this unique way of experiencing history it is worth the journey from Punta Cana.




#### **EXPLORE BOCA DE YUMA**

Less than an hour south of Punta Cana, Boca de Yuma offers a daytime escape to a scenic Dominican fishing village. It has often been compared to an Italian seaside town, where restaurants, bars, and shacks line up above the sea and offer panoramic cliff top views. 
#### **COTUBANAMA NATIONAL PARK**

Cotubanama National Park, also known as Parque Nacional del Este, is named in honor of a great Taino warrior-chief, Cotubanama, leader of the Cayocoa. It is one of the most cave-riddled and adventure-packed national parks in the DR. It is the natural habitat to more than 500 species of flora, 300 types of birds, and home to a rich marine life. You can hike the land portion, accessible from Bayahibe village, to explore a handful of the park's caves and fresh water springs along marked trails of varying difficulty or go birdwatching. Snorkeling and diving sites are numerous along colorful coral reefs and steep walls teeming with sea life.





Founded in 1992, Don Lucas Cigars remains one of the top quality cigar makers in the DR with its small-scale, hand-rolled cigars. It is located in downtown Punta Cana's Mundo Autentico shopping complex. Before tasting a puro of your choosing, you will witness the making of the finest hand-rolled cigars. Don Lucas's cigars have won multiple awards over the years and you can pick up a box at an on-site shop to take home.

In this unique experience, you can dive across the seabed at full speed. Made for the whole family, whether you are a teenager or an adult, you can enjoy the coral, fish, and marine life that populate this area of the Caribbean.



#### **SCUBA DIVING**

A well-tended coral garden, sunken shipwrecks and cave diving are the scuba diving highlights in Punta Cana.

- **Pewter Wreck**, a Spanish ship lost in the 1540s nearing the end of its outward voyage from Seville to the colonies in the New World Salvage crews, has recovered around 1,200 pieces of pewter tableware.
- El Astron, submerged at 12 meters (39 feet) off the coast of Bávaro, Astron continues to be a popular site for advanced divers. The sheer magnitude of the ship, including its giant propeller said to weigh more than 20,000 tons is worth a look.
- A short drive from the Bávaro resort area, Cueva Taina Macao's underwater cave is easily accessible. With a depth of no more than eight meters (26 feet) this cave is around 54 yards long, with an impressive variety of stalagmites and stalactites in crystal clear waters.
- Enriquillo RM-22 For advanced divers only, the Enriquillo RM-22 sits 18 meters (60 feet) below sea level, off the coast of Playa Blanca. It houses numerous species, including horse mackerel, sea breams, yellowtail snappers, and hawksbill sea turtles.
- Las Cuevitas (72 feet) and El Canal (52 feet), two ideal dive sites for beginners, lie off the coast of Bávaro. Both reveal beautiful rock formations at relatively shallow depths.



#### **SNORKELING**

Located between the waters of Playa Blanca and Playa Serena in Punta Cana, the Igneri Caribe Taino Underwater Museum makes for a unique snorkeling and cultural site, with depths ideal for beginners. Created by award-winning Dominican artist Thimo Pimentel, 22 sculptures depicting indigenous Taino figures lie underwater, submerged at three to seven meters (10–23 feet). Coral was planted around the sculptures to provide a habitat for fish. You can see them circling and swimming past these prominent Taino figures while you snorkel.





Stand-Up Paddle Boarding (SUP) lessons, guided coastal tours and rentals on the calm, clear waters of Bayahibe Bay are available to anyone who desires to participate in the eco-friendly way to get out on the water and have fun. It's easy to learn and anyone can do it.
