
#### **ABOUT**




#### THE PENINSULA

The peninsula boasts many places of interest, the *Punta del Este Port*, which has become a popular nightlife spot, with many different restaurants serving mainly seafood. The port is also an essential visit if you want to see sea lions, and **the Playa de Los Ingleses**, which is Punta del Este's most southern beach joining the river with the ocean. Explore different galleries and craft markets, enjoy classic cafés, pizzerias, and pubs or watch the sun go down from the pier bandstand. Its streets, unlike the rest of the resort, are numbered from one to 31, even though each street also has a name relating to sailing or to the marine world.



#### **EL CHORRO**

El Chorro is a resort area in southeastern Uruguay right on the shores of the Atlantic Ocean. Beautiful beaches and exquisite sunsets beckon travelers from far and wide. Bikini Beach is a popular area for watersports and relaxing in the sun. For a small area, visitors will find lots to do and sights to see, like the 19<sup>th</sup> century Punta del Este lighthouse with its sweeping views and incredible maritime history. This tranquil area is the ideal respite for luxury vacationers looking to reconnect with nature, unwind and breathe for a while.






#### LA SUSANA


#### **PARADOR LA HUELLA**




#### **CUATRO MARES | INTERNATIONAL**

Chef Gastón Yelicich cooked in Europe and the US before returning to his native Uruguay. After time working at restaurants in José Ignacio, he opened Cuatro Mares on the Punta Peninsula. Seeking out the best produce to create simple yet flavourful dishes, his menu changes daily according to availability; take a seat at the kitchen bar for a close-up of the culinary action. Start with pork shoulder and bechamel croquettes before sharing Provence-style clams, octopus with olive mayo, brótola, a local and popular hake, or rib-eye from the parrilla. Weekend lunches are all about the abundant buffet. Gastón also serves feijoada, a weekend tradition for Brazilian diners.



#### **LO DE TERE I LATIN**

Focused on Uruguayan products and producers, Lo de Tere serves the best seafood from the Atlantic and local lagoons alongside the finest countryside ingredients. In a tasting menu of five, six or seven courses, the restaurant serves dishes such as mussels with herbs and garlic, octopus carpaccio, red crab salad and wild langoustine bonbon with wild mushroom consommé. The cozy dining room with exposed brickwork looks out onto lush greenery and a grand view of the harbor, Gorriti Island and Mansa Beach Bay. Ask for the dulce de leche shot for dessert.



# LA BOURGOGNE RELAIS & CHÂTEAUX \*MICHELIN | FRENCH

This gourmet restaurant sits right on the seafront in one of Uruguay's most exclusive seaside resorts. Authentic French cuisine is created by Executive Chef Jean-Paul Bondoux, using products from his own farm, like zucchini flowers stuffed with chicken or roast rack of lamb in garden herbs. The chef says he likes to use ingredients close to the land. Luxury travelers looking for something a little different to do might want to consider taking cooking classes with the chef. On the menu, you can find such offerings as house-smoked salmon, suckling piglet, and of course, filet mignon. La Bourgogne is the ideal place for a romantic and sophisticated dinner.



# L'INCANTO RESTAURANTE | INTERNATIONAL, NEAPOLITAN

Set in the heart of Boulevard Gourmet, L'Incanto is the true benchmark for Italian gastronomy in the city. The chef creates high-quality dishes, made with ingredients imported from Italy. L'Incanto is a really charming and traditional place, dedicated to Italian and Mediterranean cuisine in Punta del Este. The atmosphere is full of charm, the service is very friendly and the food is delicious.




#### FLOREAL RESTAURANTE | FRENCH

Maintaining the style of its origin, Floreal has an international signature cuisine based on quality products and techniques. Floreal offers an international signature cuisine based on quality products and techniques. Year after year, it seeks a balance between maintaining the characteristic dishes of Uruguayan cuisine and innovating in terms of techniques and products. It is nestled in a 60s building echoing a formal atmosphere surrounded by a natural garden in the middle of the San Rafael forest. It has two rooms, a VIP room, a cellar, and a garden.



#### **FASANO PUNTA DEL ESTE | ITALIAN**

Fasano Punta del Este offers fine dining enthusiasts more than 100 years of tradition and excellence in the best haute cuisine in a relaxed, informal environment. The Fasano family has been one of the most respected names in South American hospitality for more than a century and this hill-top spot boasts all the glitz, glamor and glorious Italian cooking you'd expect from the Brazilian dynasty. Unapologetically nostalgic menus (including homemade pasta) are consistently excellent, but the real draw is the setting. This beautifully designed rocky cabin by Isay Weinfeld perches like an eagle's nest atop one of Uruguay's highest peaks and offers stunning views of the virgin countryside and Maldonado river. Interiors nod to the breezy Brazilian design of the 1950s, but the best seat in the house is on the rattan-clad balcony; if sitting here, bring a jacket as evenings are generally cool.



#### MARISMO, JOSÉ IGNACIO | INTERNATIONAL

With the sky as your ceiling and sand dunes for a carpet, dine under a starry canopy at Marismo while candles – and the gratitude of your dining companion – light up your dishes. One of the most captivating experiences in Uruguay if not South America, Chef Federico Desseno plays with fire, using a clay oven to knock up succulent empanadas teamed with spicy llajua tomato dip, or the parrilla to grill a whole catch of the day such as *lenguado* (sole). One unmissable dish is the provoleta, a gooey yet curiously light and chewy variation of the classic grilled provolone cheese. At weekends, catch the outdoor culinary show when Federico cooks under the stars.



#### **BODEGA GARZON | URUGUAYAN**

Simple, delicious food is often the hardest to execute, and Chef Francis Mallmann at Bodega Garzon has this down pat. Mallmann owns restaurants all over the world and is well-versed in the Uruguayan and Argentinian styles of cooking. Diners will enjoy the warm, welcoming ambiance and those who are familiar with fine dining know that a restaurant is a place for excellent food and an unforgettable experience, and that is what they will get here. Food and libations are not fancy, yet somehow stay in the memory: a perfectly seared steak drizzled with herbed olive oil; the freshest local fish baked in a salt crust; or a simple, smoky Negroni. Mallmann's cuisine rivals those of the restaurants in the best luxury hotels in Punta del Este.





Punta del Este stands out for its landscapes, its beauty, and its coastlines and nature, but anyone visiting this city will notice art galleries are everywhere, giving inspiration to those who see and appreciate their beauty. Punta del Este is a great art center, with world-known museums, art galleries, and temporary displays on the streets. Punta del Este has some stellar galleries and museums exhibiting works by contemporary Uruguayan and foreign artists with innovative techniques in textured oil paintings, acrylic applications, photographs, carved sculptures, and recycled materials, among others. 




Make sure to wear shades when approaching Casapueblo. Its stark white exterior next to a brilliant blue sky may be too bright for the eyes to handle. Uruguayan artist Carlos Paez Vilaro's whimsical villa and art gallery sits atop Punta Ballena, a jutting headland west of Punta del Este. Visitors can tour five rooms, view a film on the artist's life and travels, and revel in spectacular sunset views in the upstairs cafeteria bar.





The Ralli Museum in Punta del Este is the first of five Ralli museums in the world. Especially designed and planned to house a museum, it is home to one of the most important collections in the Latin American art world, as well as works by renowned European artists. Art lovers who appreciate the work of Fernando Botero must visit this museum. It also has a healthy selection of sculptures from Salvador Dali. Pencil in at least a few hours to see all the wonders this museum has to offer.

Paseo Gallery in Manantiales was founded in 1998, and since then, it has developed a program of activities aimed at promoting Latin American artists in the line of contemporary creation. Initially installed in the historic district of Montevideo, in 2004, it moved to Punta del Este, where it holds exhibitions throughout the year. It offers an incredible display of Latin American Contemporary Art. Thirty artists with different techniques interconnect in an impeccably balanced style.




### **FUNDACIÓN PABLO ATCHUGARRY**

The Pablo Atchugarry Foundation is an enormous estate with several indoor facilities holding temporary exhibitions and sculptures by artist, Pablo Atchugarry. Its most prominent feature is the astonishing 62 acres sculpture park, designed in dialogue with the landscape, offering the viewer a natural setting in which to appreciate the monumentality of the works of national and international artists, where special attention has been paid to diversity. of expressive languages. Diversity that becomes a value to discover our own identity. The artist's collection that brings together works of 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century sculptors from all over the world. Walking around the park, with its forests and lake, will entice everyone for the unique connection between art and nature.







#### **OCEAN CLUB | NIGHTCLUB**

Ocean Club is one of Punta del Este's best and most reliable beach clubs in the dunes between Punta and La Barra. Things really get hopping after midnight. Food and drinks are superb and the staff, welcoming and accommodating. The club is set in the middle of a concrete parking lot with a tunnel-like entrance made of translucent glass. A beam ceiling with strewn canvas connects large rooms with teak wood floors and a long central bar of tufted suede. Large circular chandeliers catch the occasional laser ray and fog storm from the club's visual display. The patio area and adjacent beach frontage attract international DJs for theme parties in the spring and summer. The crowd here is progressively upscale.




### LA CASITA RESTO BAR | BAR



Caro Criado is a Uruguayan designer that has several fashion boutiques around the country. She became famous for designing incredible dresses which are coveted for events like weddings and prom parties. Nowadays, her style has developed into more intricate and original designs, with more international influences. Her focus is still partywear, but you can find elegant pieces for every occasion.





Magma is a renowned store in Uruguay that sells various high-end designer brands. Every store has a different set up and collection, tastefully curated by a team of stylists who combine local favorites with luxury brands from all over the world. The trendy store in Jose Ignacio is naturally more focused on the summer season, featuring a lot of brands from LA, as well as store favorites like Missoni, Maison Margiela, and Uruguayan it-designers Margo Baridón and Nina Hauzer.



#### **EL REMANSO**

The majority of shops run along Avenida Gorlero and Calle 20, also known as El Remanso, or the Little Paris. This area is known as "Little Paris" because of the architectural style of the houses and shops, which

highly look like the French capital city. Besides having many restaurants and cafes, you can also visit the stores that are located along these two famous streets.





A lifestyle boutique on the outskirts of town *Santas Negras* is housewares and fashion shop that sells an eclectic variety of clothing, restored (and sometimes reimagined) mid-century furniture, and stylish curiosities. It is on two levels, with a light-filled top floor. More than 75% of Santas Negras' offerings are of Uruguayan origin.





This is a small independent fashion boutique that curates products from different brands. El Canuto is focused on Uruguayan labels of clothes and accessories, like Telma and Laurel. You can also find some trendy home décor to take home, which you are sure to love judging by the beautiful interior design of the store.






### **NIGHT OF NOSTALGIA**

#### PUNTA DEL ESTE INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL





#### **CATEDRAL DE SAN FERNANDO**


This beautiful neoclassical cathedral gives a touch of beauty and charm to the historic center of the city of Maldonado. Construction began in 1801 and was suspended by the English invasions of 1806, which led to the completion of the work taking almost a century. The cathedral consists of a main nave with two bell towers and a central dome. On the sides and at the back of the nave there are two small buildings that complete the set in the shape of a cross. The magnificent main altar is the work of Antonio Veiga, who won two prizes at the continental exhibition held in Buenos Aires in 1882. This stunning piece of local history is worth a visit.




#### BRAVA BEACH HAND SCULPTURE "LA MANO"

The Fingers of Punta del Este, created by artist Mario Irarrazabal, is a tourist stop. In a rather eerie way, these huge fingers can be seen emerging from the sand, The sculpture has become a symbol for Punta del Este since its completion in February 1982 and has become one of Uruguay's most recognizable landmarks. The artist was inspired to make a sculpture of a hand "drowning" as a warning to swimmers, as the water at La Barra up the beach has rougher waves which are better for surfing only, while the other way, the water at Solanas is much more suited for swimming and windsurfing.

#### **BIKING IN THE VINEYARDS**

An old grocery store in the middle of a peaceful countryside, the ideal starting point for your bike ride. The "Cordano" winery, better known as "Almacen la capilla" (The chapel grocery store), is in the Carmelo region, in Colonia Estrella. It was founded by Antonio Cordano in 1855 with the intention of providing supplies to the neighborhood while creating a friendly meeting place. This old barn, surrounded by peace and nature, is the ideal departure point for this amazing bike ride! You will go through fields and vines and will discover the charm of the little village and its old chapel; The Saint Roque Chapel is one of the oldest in the country and still hosts many weddings.



#### **TOUR TAMBO EL SOSIEGO**

Tambo el Sosiego, maker of famous Lapataia-brand dulce de leche, gives free tours that walk you through the process of making the region's favorite dessert. The dairy farm and plant are 12 miles from central Punta del Este, easily accessible by car and open seven days a week. This is an ideal excursion for those vacationing with children. Kids can milk cows, feed baby goats and calves, ride on ponies and enjoy amazing dulce de leche pancakes.




### **GORRITI ISLAND**

Feel the invigorating saline breeze and set sail to Gorriti Island. This pedestrian-only national heritage site, a 15-minute journey from Punta del Este, is an exceptional destination for recreation or reconnection with the elements. 





Kayaking on the Maldonado Stream is a unique experience. The tour starts at La Barra, close to the famous waving bridge. Paddling upstream


On the "Arroyo Maldonado" you will able to see a wide variety of birds. Reaching the river club, you will enjoy a delicious picnic.
