
INDIE BEACH








Not only is Plage des Salins, or Des Salins beach less crowded than Pampelonne, it also has a spectacular landscape. This 2,000-foot stretch of beach intersects with a creek that flows inland toward a marsh. Lush pines and grassy dunes embrace white sands.


NANO TRATTORIA | ITALIAN/MEDITERRANEAN


SICILIA RESTAURANT | ITALIAN/SICILIAN

NOTO IN SAINT-TROPEZ | ITALIAN

Noto in Saint-Tropez is a joyous celebration of Southern Italian cuisine, an ode to its sun-filled generosity that brings together the delightful creations of Chef Emilio Giagnoni, formerly of the Four Seasons. From Puglia's Burrata to Vitello Tonnato and raw fish, you can savor the generous pasta for lunch and dinner in a chic waterfront setting. Noto has been proudly recognized for three seasons as one of the most popular places to party on the Côte d'Azur with its Italian-style festivities – from aperitifs with a "Spritz di Sole" cocktail to live music and singing, followed by a DJ until 3 a.m. – a homage to the Mediterranean dolce-vita, the air of freedom and authenticity, with the mistral blowing instead of the scirocco.





Le Caprice Des Deux it opened its doors in 1994, and since then it has received many awards. Founder Stephane Avelin (along with his sister, Sonia) was first elected Hope of Gastronomy in 1995. In 2014, the state awarded him the prestigious title of Master Restaurateur for the quality of cuisine, and commitment to use only fresh and unprocessed products.





This quaint restaurant's chef and staff expend so much skill and enthusiasm to ensure your time at Le G'Envie is happy. The wonderful fare from the modest open-plan kitchen makes a meal here highly memorable – so much so, that it's a favorite with the locals. Fresh market ingredients drive the menu, which changes regularly.



DIOR DES LICES | FRENCH

The epitome of summer chic can be found in the Saint-Tropez village at the seasonal eatery located within Christian Dior's resort flagship. Set on the grounds of the House of Dior's grand château, this idyllic outdoor restaurant provides the perfect setting for alfresco dining with magnificent views of the coveted yachts in the harbor. This three-story compound along the Place des Lices, designed by renowned Peter Marino, has original terracotta floors, marble hearths and oversize picture windows facing the garden dining space, created by Peter Wirtz, where 3-star Michelin chef Yannick Alléno offers up a delectable menu of calissons in a variety of foie gras, melon gelée, tomato-citrus and basil, summer vegetables and zucchini with almond mousse variations. Served on impeccable Dior bone china, guests can also savour his classic tomato salads, pressed sandwiches and grilled entrees.




CIPRIANI I ITALIAN


ARCADIA | MEDITERRANEAN


CUCINA BYBLOS | ITALIAN






THE LUXURY TRIANGLE





LADURÉE ST. TROPEZ

LA TARTE TROPÉZIENNE

A visit to the La Tarte Tropézienne is a must when in Saint-Trop'. Right on the Place des Lices, this bakery which opened in 1955, created a cream-filled brioche that would become the superstar of Saint-Tropez. That same year, Brigitte Bardot, who was filming a movie here, loved it and suggested it should be named after its birthplace, thus "la tarte tropézienne" was born!





Le Comptoir des Marines is the traditional bakery in the gulf of Saint-Tropez in the heart of the marines de cogolin. It is also a café-restaurant which welcomes you every day from morning to evening on its terrace by the water to taste the house specialties of the chef, or quite simply to have a drink and a good time in the sun.





St. Tropez night spots are known to be extravagant. As a renowned playground of the world's jet set, everything from bars, nightclubs, and casinos is dialed up to an 11. Today, Gaio offers exceptional Japanese and Peruvian cuisine before turning into a hot party spot for the night where you can rub shoulders with A-list celebrities and socialites.



L'OPERA

L'Opera provides an experience like no other. An all white decor mixes circular white club chairs with long banquettes trimmed in Italian leather. A large communal table that doubles as a stage by night for cabaret shows, fire-eaters, electro-violinists and the occasional shirtless contortionist sits in the center of the space. A glass wall of interconnecting doors leads to an interior space that acts as an overflow to the main bar. Revelers flock to this festive establishment for the magical shows, delicious cuisine and chic ambiance. To experience all that the Opera has to offer, you can dine or dance in the dining room or take in the festivities on the terrace, where shows come alive as the DJ kicks off their set. For an unforgettable evening in Saint-Tropez, one must not miss the Opera.






The most prestigious nightclub in France for the past 40 years has lost none of its panache. This star-studded bar at the famous Le Caves du Roy at Hotel Byblos remains the perennial champion of nightclubs in St. Tropez, if not the whole Riviera. 


This museum has many surprises, each one as fun as the last! You can see a replica of a 1960s-era police office, and enter a retro cinema entirely dedicated to the history of the Gendarmes, go along the Nationale 7 (the famous holiday route) riding shotgun in a 2 CV and Simca Aronde, party in St. Tropez, get acquainted with Romy Schneider and Brigitte Bardot in their digs during filming of And God Created Woman (1956) and The Swimming Pool (1968).



VIEUX PORT

The atmospheric Vieux Port is in the heart of St. Tropez, where the old fishing village first came to life. You'll be charmed by the idyllic scenery of small fishing boats and fashionable yachts docked in the harbor lined by pastel-colored houses and lively cafés with outdoor terraces. On the wide sidewalk at the water's edge, artists sell colorful paintings depicting vibrant village scenes.






The Old Town of St. Tropez, "La Ponche," borders the Vieux Port harbor basin and is below the citadel. La Ponche is the historic center of the fishing village and the most picturesque area of St. Tropez. Part of it has been laid out as a pedestrian zone with narrow alleyways and quaint cobblestone lanes rife with small shops, upscale boutiques, cafés, and restaurants.




CITADEL & MUSEUM OF MARITIME HISTORY

St. Tropez has a rich maritime heritage. The citadel was built in the 17th century after King Henry IV sent his engineer to oversee work to build a fortress that could fend off an attack. It was turned into a naval museum in the 1950s and now celebrates the lives of locals who worked and fought on the seas. The museum is housed in the dungeons, which have been protected since 1921, but the entire site received protected status in 1995.





An aromatic countryside like no other accompanies Provence's rich recreation options. This stunning terrain is ripe for discovery, unrivaled beauty found behind every hill. Discover the region's vineyards, lavender fields, and Cyprus tree-speckled countryside. Our short list of land activities provides the ultimate immersion into this famously beautiful region. Explore the vineyards of the Gulf of St. Tropez on horseback! Before being so famous, this area was home to farmers, wine makers and fishermen. By joining this type of tour you will not only enjoy being outdoors, but you will also experience a part of the gulf that has not changed much.





Fields of lavender are veritable feasts for the senses. Learn about the botanical discovery, production, harvesting, distillation, history and culture of lavender. Get schooled on how to best use this aromatic flower to get the best of its benefits. The two-hour drive from St. Tropez to see and smell these stunning fields is well worth your time.



VINEYARDS IN SAINT-TROPEZ

The area has produced wine for millennia (experts say for 2,300 years), thanks to the arrival of the Phoenicians and their vines. The appellation covers the region from the west of Marseilles to St Raphael in the east, through the area known as the Var. Whilst Cotes de Provence wines are mostly famous for their rose wines, rich, full-bodied reds are also produced, along with light and fresh white wines. Most vineyards are open for sales. Book in advance for tours and tastings.






Château des Marres is exceptionally beautiful and promises a perfect day to relax and sip on some fine wine. Located on the Route des Plages de Pampelonne, between St. Tropez and Ramatuelle, the estate is spread over more than 74 acres. A family-run operation for five generations, the Benet-Gartich family knows how to make fine wine.




VISIT TO DOMAINE DE LA CROIX VINEYARD

The vineyard at Domaine de La Croix is the largest of the Cotes de Provence Cru Classes, spread across 108 hectares of land bearing the Cotes de Provence appellation and divided into three very distinct terroirs that make up the wealth of the estate: Tabarin, Saunier and an exceptional site named Bastide Blanche. Its unique location on the Saint-Tropez Peninsula has given Domaine de La Croix one of its key assets: its microclimate. The grapes receive just the right amount of sunlight and sea air to thrive, producing exceptional wines. With bold architecture and state-of-the-art technology designed by Saint-Tropez-based architect Francois Vieillecroze, the cellar at Domaine de La Croix is astonishingly big -3,500 m2 - and yet, invisible! Buried eight meters below ground to comply with the standards required due to its location on a listed site, it integrates perfectly with its setting of vines and pine forests. Within this monumental structure, the facilities are resolutely modern and await your arrival.






At the midpoint of the French Riviera, St. Tropez makes the ideal jumping-off area to discover the wonders of Provence. Immaculate Renaissance-era villas are peppered across undulating hillsides. Discover charming hamlets unravaged by time and untouched nature rarely seen in continental Europe all within an afternoon's voyage of your villa.



Porquerolles greets you with its storybook magic. Sweeping white beaches and limestone cliffs frame a sanctuary of oak and pine trees teeming with chirping cicadas, wild herbs, sprawling eucalyptus, and the occasional fig tree. As the largest of the three lles d'Hyeres islands in the Parc National de Port-Cros, Porquerolles beckons visitors with a pristine Provencal landscape becoming increasingly elusive on the mainland. The Michelin-starred L'Olivier restaurant undeniably elevates an old-world ambiance with Provencal classics. Pause to to dine here to experience the full breadth of the island's flavors thanks to Chef Julien Le Goff.



The Villa and Foundation Carmignac set the bar high for contemporary art. The collection of more than 300 works is a refuge in the heart of a remarkable archipelago. In this authentic provencal farmhouse, financier and art collector Edouard Carmignac wanted to share his love for contemporary artwork. In June 2018 the Villa Carmignac, on the island of Porquerolles, opened its doors to the public. Works of art here rub shoulders with and marry the nature of the Port–Cros National Park. To the sound of cicadas, walk barefoot through the extraordinary garden where works of Tom Sachs, Jean Denant or Alexandre Farto AKA Vhils are revealed. Make sure you put this initiatory voyage to the island on your itinerary.






In the heart of the Gulf of St. Tropez, the seaside town of Port Grimaud is an architectural exploit of visionary architect François Spoerry. Conceived in 1966, Port Grimaud is both a port and a true Provencal village. You get around solely by boat or on foot. Every house was designed in an authentic Provencal style. Never ceasing to grow, Port Grimaud now has 1,000 colorful houses with red roof tiles.





If you're craving an escape, or want to experience the authenticity of a quaint village, this is the one. Perched high on a hill, this labyrinth-like walled village with a tree-studded central square, got its name from "rahmatu'llah," meaning "divine gift" – a legacy of 10th century Saracen rule. Jazz and theater fill the tourist-packed streets during August's Festival de Ramatuelle – the highly-awaited jazz fest.










Pampelonne beach has plenty of motorized watersport rentals like adrenaline-pumping jet skis and wakeboards. You can enjoy these high octane activities amid spectacular French Riviera backdrops, usually calm waters, and fresh sea breezes.





Prevalent south-westerly winds make kitesurfing and windsurfing a dream at Pampelonne beach if you're visiting off season. During the summer, the activity is relocated to nearby St. Aygulf beach, 15 miles from St. Tropez. Feel the fresh sea spray generated by these water activities which provide the ultimate feeling of abandon like no others.





PARASAILING

Imagine flying like a bird taking in the breathtaking views of the Cote D'Azure. Parasailing, offered up and down the coast close to St. Tropez, is the zenith of exhilaration. 
GRIMAUD KARTING LOISIR

A stop at the Glacier de la Plage (for an artisanal ice cream or a homemade waffle) is a must before heading to the long beach just next to the port. The kids can learn to navigate the boat equipped with a map of the labyrinth-like canals in Port Grimaud. This is a beautiful way to spend a family day out.
