ABOUT

The spectacular coastal town of St. Tropez is in the very heart of the French Riviera. St Tropez abounds with old-world charm, embraced by sleepy hilltop hamlets and undulating hills blanketed by vineyards. Synonymous with luxury and elegance since the mid-century, the town's serpentine cobblestones and intoxicating landscapes continue to seduce the jet set. A glamorous mystique is wrapped up in the iconography of Brigitte Bardot and the seductive zeitgeist of the 60s. Known for incredible dining, and an implacable laid-back ambiance, this gem dazzles with New World charm. Here, celebrity sightings are commonplace.

Saint-Tropez (or Saint-Trop' for the locals) is indeed the symbol of the Mediterranean sun and *farniente*. However, winter definitely contrasts with the electric, lively and crowded animation of the village in summer. Saint-Trop' turns into a sleeping beauty, life is slower and more magical. If you wish to make the most of a peaceful time in Saint-Tropez, then discovering the region in low season is the right time. In winter, Saint-Tropez offers a magnificent landscape for those who love the outdoors, nature and sunshine. Restaurants and bars around the village are getting a makeover before summer. Then, if you want to discover the little pebble streets and the beauty of Saint-Tropez in a very calm setting and have the city just for you, visit St Tropez in winter.

La Ponche is helmed by Thomas Danigo, Here, he produces Mediterranean cuisine using regional vegetables and fish of the day. Dishes such as fresh pea gazpacho, grilled lobster, and bouillabaisse, are all no fuss, fresh, and brimming with flavor. The Bridget Bardot era of the 60s in St. Tropez is resurrected in the restaurant and bar's interior using mirrors, black and white checkered tiling, wrought iron coffee tables with glass tops and a come-hither fireplace.






AU CAPRICE DES DEUX | FRENCH


CUCINA BYBLOS | ITALIAN

Just a stone's throw from the Place des Lices, in the heart of the hotel Byblos, the mythical palace of Saint-Tropez is the restaurant La Cucina Byblos. It quickly became a culinary reference in Saint-Tropez rewarded with the Michelin Guide plate in 2021. Indeed, the Cucina Byblos has many assets. Master Chef Alain Ducasse at the helm for one and the location for another, set on the beach in the cove of Bonne Terrasse near Ramatuelle and Saint-Tropez. La Cucina is indeed a hymn to the Italian culinary tradition. Chef Rocco Seminara sublimates original tastes of Italian cuisine in his creations ensuring the quality expected in the Ducasse houses is up to par. You will discover a whole host of flavors and aromas combined to recreate the original and authentic taste of Italian cuisine. Savor a white ham with truffle or let yourself be seduced by the Kristal caviar parmesan cheese wheel.






One of the city's oldest dining establishments, Le Cafe's Provencal authenticity has remained intact over a centuries-long journey. 
RESTAURANT @ BASTIDE DE SAINT-TROPEZ | MEDITERRANEAN

The restaurant of the Bastide de Saint-Tropez hotel is run by Sardinian Chef, Alessandro Caria, and his team. Home to century-old olive trees, this delightful setting is host to generous Italian cuisine, where high-quality local produce (like cured meats) is served alongside home-made pasta and recipes: tagliatelle with clams and tuna roe, Sardinian-style seafood, escalope of veal à la Marsala, and many more classic Italian dishes, simply made better.





Auberge des Maures is St. Tropez' oldest restaurant and a beloved spot for consistently spectacular dishes. The menu is graced by earthy Provencal delicacies, from daube, tapenade-stuffed lamb shoulder, grilled onglet (hanger steak). A broad wine selection leaves endless pairing options that will have you falling in love repeatedly with Provencal cooking.




CHEZ CAMILLE | SEAFOOD

Chez Camille restaurant in Ramatuelle, perpetuates the tradition of the local culinary heritage day after day. Since 1913 Chez Camille has offered authentic *crafted* cuisine. Taste the famous bouillabaisse, recognized as the specialty of the house. It is not, however, only the bouillabaisse that attracts gourmets to the Chez Camille restaurant, try the Mediterranean lobsters grilled over a wood fire or fresh fish since this authentic cuisine has a very special flavor thanks to the setting in which it is enjoyed. Located in the Bonne Terrasse district, the restaurant faces Cap Camarat near the Pampelonne beach.





The ever-glamorous St. Tropez lauded for its style and elegance, is a behemoth of luxury retail options. Between big name brands such as Dior, Louis Vuitton, and Gucci gracing the plazas of Place de la Garonne and Place des Lices, independent designer boutiques abound. Cultivate your Tropezian style, and discover the St. Tropez spirit through its fashion. The dress code here is casual-chic with generous dollops of French bohemia. Many shops and restaurants are closed during winter and only reopen in spring. Checking their opening times prior to your visit is recommended.


THE LUXURY TRIANGLE

In St. Tropez proper, you can spend a glamorous afternoon shopping in luxury boutiques along flowery, cobbled back streets. Stroll the 'luxury triangle' between Place des Lices, Rue Gambetta, and Rue Général Allard, stopping along the way at flagship stores of some of the most fabulous brands on the planet, including Louis Vuitton, Hermes and Dior. In summer you might spot a few Hollywood stars in oversized sunglasses getting their shopping on. Stock up on local boutique offerings, including swim suits from Vilebrequin or Kiwi Saint-Tropez, a pair of sandals from Rondini, or unique, colorful statement jewelry from Gas Bijoux.





The Rondini family has been making the legendary leather sandals for 92 years. Rondini's craftsmen and women are experts in leather, and are always keen to adapt the shoes specifically to your feet – customized sandals! As the years passed, the small business grew, family members joined the team, and Rondini has been for many years a successful and flourishing business.





If you're looking for a more rustic shopping experience, the markets are the place to be. Every Tuesday and Saturday morning, The Place Des Lices market offers a vast range of foods including breads, pastries, cheeses, sausages, olives, spices, herbs, fruit and vegetables. Pick out a lovely bouquet of fresh flowers to take back to the villa. There are also stalls for hunters of local artisan pieces. Locals head out early to nab the freshest produce.






L'Atelier 55 is a vintage furniture shop. With shops in Paris, Megève and Saint-Tropez, this is not a unique shop. However, they do sell very cool vintage pieces from the 50s, 60s and 70s, and their catalogue is exceptional.

LADURÉE ST. TROPEZ

If you are not familiar with Ladurée, it is one of the most famous Parisian patisseries. Ladurée was founded in 1862 in Paris and is world famous for their specialty desserts and macarons. More than 15,000 of their macarons are sold each day. If you would like to taste a classically French dessert while in St. Tropez, Ladurée is one of the elite and premier locations to do so. Ladurée macarons are one of those luxury food items perfect for a gift. The St. Tropez patisserie has a lovely designer box exclusive to them so your giftee will know these are the real deal macarons.



LA TARTE TROPÉZIENNE

A visit to the La Tarte Tropézienne is a must when in Saint-Trop'. Right on the Place des Lices, this bakery which opened in 1955, created a cream-filled brioche that would become the superstar of Saint-Tropez. That same year, Brigitte Bardot, who was filming a movie here, loved it and suggested it should be named after its birthplace, thus "la tarte tropézienne" was born!





Le Comptoir des Marines is the traditional bakery in the gulf of Saint-Tropez in the heart of the marines de cogolin. It is also a café-restaurant which welcomes you every day from morning to evening on its terrace by the water to taste the house specialties of the chef, or quite simply to have a drink and a good time in the sun.





St. Tropez night spots are known to be extravagant. As a renowned playground of the world's jet set, everything from bars, nightclubs, and casinos are dialed up to an 11. The town's devil-may-care attitude is well preserved in its nightlife from the halcyon time of the 60s, only now it's delivered with more panache. An air of exclusivity is palpable from the moment the sun sets. The town promenade is the place to be seen, an unofficial catwalk that has seen the graceful meanderings of the world's top fashion models and designers. At night St. Tropez awakens from its seaside slumber when fashion, culture, art, and the art of living collide.

L'Opera provides an experience like no other. An all white decor mixes circular white club chairs with long banquettes trimmed in Italian leather. A large communal table doubles as a stage by night for cabaret shows, fire-eaters, electro-violinists and the occasional shirtless contortionist sits in the center of the space. A glass wall of interconnecting doors leads to an interior space that acts as an overflow to the main bar. If you get hungry, you'll find a mix of Italian and French specialties including an impressive foie gras, raw bar selections and grilled meats.





Gaio is a St. Tropez three-in-one jewel: restaurant, bar and nightclub. The very first restaurant – a harbinger of Gaio – was the legendary Papagayo which opened in 1962 and frequented by stars such as Brigitte Bardot. Today, Gaio offers exceptional Japanese and Peruvian cuisine before turning into a hot party spot for the night where you can rub shoulders with A-list celebrities and socialites.





As you can probably guess from the name, the VIP Room is a very exclusive bar, particularly favored by celebrities. The music is predominantly house and techno with international DJs like David Guetta and Calvin Harris occasionally spinning tunes. Experienced mixologists create delicious cocktails. If you love making an entrance in your chicest fashions and enjoy the flavor of exclusivity, this is the place for you.



NIGHTCLUBS




The most prestigious nightclub in France for the past 40 years has lost none of its panache. This star-studded bar at the famous Le Caves du Roy at Hotel Byblos remains the perennial champion of nightclubs in St. Tropez, if not the whole Riviera. Dress to impress to get in to mingle with starlets and race car drivers.





From modest beginnings as a quaint fishing village occupied by the ancient Greeks, followed by the Romans, the illustrious past of St. Tropez goes back millennia. 
VIEUX PORT

The atmospheric Vieux Port is in the heart of St. Tropez, where the old fishing village first came to life. You'll be charmed by the idyllic scenery of small fishing boats and fashionable yachts docked in the harbor lined by pastel-colored houses and lively cafés with outdoor terraces. On the wide sidewalk at the water's edge, artists sell colorful paintings depicting vibrant village scenes.






The Old Town of St. Tropez, "La Ponche," borders the Vieux Port harbor basin and is below the citadel. La Ponche is the historic center of the fishing village and the most picturesque area of St. Tropez. Part of it has been laid out as a pedestrian zone with narrow alleyways and quaint cobblestone lanes rife with small shops, upscale boutiques, cafés, and restaurants.







St. Tropez has a rich maritime heritage. The citadel was built in the 17th century after King Henry IV sent his engineer to oversee work to build a fortress that could fend off an attack. It was turned into a naval museum in the 1950s and now celebrates the lives of locals who worked and fought on the seas. The museum is housed in the dungeons, which have been protected since 1921, but the entire site received protected status in 1995.



PLACE DES LICES - AN OPEN-AIR MARKET

Every Tuesday and Saturday morning, Saint-Tropez hosts its open air market on the famous Place des Lices. This fantastic market sells a huge range of foods including bread, pastries, cheese, sausages, flowers, olives, spices, herbs, fruit and vegetables. Locals head to the market early to secure the freshest produce. There are also stalls for souvenir hunters. These are good quality home accessories, antiques, mirrors, vintage posters, paintings and arts and crafts.





An aromatic countryside like no other accompanies Provence's rich recreation options. This stunning terrain is ripe for discovery, unrivaled beauty found behind every hill. Discover the region's vineyards, lavender fields, and Cyprus tree-speckled countryside. Our short list of land activities provides the ultimate immersion into this famously beautiful region. 


Explore the vineyards of the Gulf of St. Tropez on horseback! Before being so famous, this area was home to farmers, wine makers and fishermen. By joining this type of tour you will not only enjoy being outdoors, but you will also experience a part of the gulf that has not changed much.






From dusty trails, rocky paths, the red cliff of the Esterel, and the pine forests that line the coast you will have plenty of terrain and scenery to enjoy. You will find that in the Alpes-Maritimes there are several world-class bike parks where the trails are designed and maintained for you to enjoy, some with lift access. And along the coast, you can share the walking trails with hikers or head to the FFC (French Cycling Federation) waymarked and graded bike-specific trails that adorn the coastal green spaces.





Fields of lavender are veritable feasts for the senses. Learn about the botanical discovery, production, harvesting, distillation, history and culture of lavender. Get schooled on how to best use this aromatic flower to get the best of its benefits. The two-hour drive from St. Tropez to see and smell these stunning fields is well worth your time.





The area has produced wine for millennia (experts say for 2,300 years), thanks to the arrival of the Phoenicians and their vines. The appellation covers the region from the west of Marseilles to St Raphael in the east, through the area known as the Var. Whilst Cotes de Provence wines are mostly famous for their rose wines, rich, full-bodied reds are also produced, along with light and fresh white wines. Most vineyards are open for sales. Book in advance for tours and tastings.






Château des Marres is exceptionally beautiful and promises a perfect day to relax and sip on some fine wine. Located on the Route des Plages de Pampelonne, between St. Tropez and Ramatuelle, the estate is spread over more than 74 acres. A family-run operation for five generations, the Benet-Gartich family knows how to make fine wine.



VISIT TO DOMAINE DE LA CROIX VINEYARD

The vineyard at Domaine de La Croix is the largest of the Cotes de Provence Cru Classes, spread across 108 hectares of land bearing the Cotes de Provence appellation and divided into three very distinct terroirs that make up the wealth of the estate: Tabarin, Saunier and an exceptional site named Bastide Blanche. Its unique location on the Saint-Tropez Peninsula has given Domaine de La Croix one of its key assets: its microclimate. The grapes receive just the right amount of sunlight and sea air to thrive, producing exceptional wines. With bold architecture and state-of-the-art technology designed by Saint-Tropez-based architect Francois Vieillecroze, the cellar at Domaine de La Croix is astonishingly big -3,500 m2 - and yet, invisible! Buried eight meters below ground to comply with the standards required due to its location on a listed site, it integrates perfectly with its setting of vines and pine forests. Within this monumental structure, the facilities are resolutely modern and await your arrival.






At the midpoint of the French Riviera, St. Tropez makes the ideal jumping-off area to discover the wonders of Provence. Immaculate Renaissance-era villas are peppered across undulating hillsides. 
THE PORQUEROLLES ISLAND

Porquerolles greets you with its storybook magic. Sweeping white beaches and limestone cliffs frame a sanctuary of oak and pine trees teeming with chirping cicadas, wild herbs, sprawling eucalyptus, and the occasional fig tree. As the largest of the three lles d'Hyeres islands in the Parc National de Port-Cros, Porquerolles beckons visitors with a pristine Provencal landscape becoming increasingly elusive on the mainland. The Michelin-starred L'Olivier restaurant undeniably elevates an old-world ambiance with Provencal classics. Pause to to dine here to experience the full breadth of the island's flavors thanks to Chef Julien Le Goff.



THE VILLA & FONDATION CARMIGNAC ON PORQUEROLLES ISLAND

The Villa and Foundation Carmignac set the bar high for contemporary art. The collection of more than 300 works is a refuge in the heart of a remarkable archipelago. In this authentic provencal farmhouse, financier and art collector Edouard Carmignac wanted to share his love for contemporary artwork. In June 2018 the Villa Carmignac, on the island of Porquerolles, opened its doors to the public. To the sound of cicadas, walk barefoot through the extraordinary garden where works of Tom Sachs, Jean Denant or Alexandre Farto AKA Vhils are revealed. Make sure you put this initiatory voyage to the island on your itinerary.





In the heart of the Gulf of St. Tropez, the seaside town of Port Grimaud is an architectural exploit of visionary architect François Spoerry. Conceived in 1966, Port Grimaud is both a port and a true Provencal village. You get around solely by boat or on foot. Every house was designed in an authentic Provencal style. Never ceasing to grow, Port Grimaud now has 1,000 colorful houses with red roof tiles.






If you're craving an escape, or want to experience the authenticity of a quaint village, this is the one. Perched high on a hill, this labyrinth-like walled village with a tree-studded central square, got its name from "rahmatu'llah," meaning "divine gift" – a legacy of 10th century Saracen rule. Jazz and theater fill the tourist-packed streets during August's Festival de Ramatuelle – the highly-awaited jazz fest.




BORMES-LES-MIMOSAS

The beautiful medieval village of Bormes-les-Mimosas is a lovely town where colorful explosions of flowers, especially mimosas for which thee town got its name, clamber all over ancient stone and charming restaurant terraces offer breathtaking views across the Mediterranean coast. Explore the galleries and boutiques in the narrow cobbled laneways. For those wishing to stretch their legs further, Bormes-les-Mimosas is in great hiking and biking country with the forested Maures hills offering lots of outdoor activities.





Just over an hour's drive from Saint-Tropez into Provence backcountry, you'll find the large medieval village of Cotignac. Built in the shadow of towering cliffs riddled with caves and holes, houses were built into the cliffs and a few of the lower ones are still in use today. Cotignac is a lovely and vibrant town, with plenty of cafes, markets, and a wonderful outdoor theatre at the base of the cliffs. There are two stone towers called 'sentinelles' standing guard on top of the cliffs. To reach them, there's a trail that leaves town and circles around so you can stand on top of the cliffs looking down on the village.



BARGEME

Bargeme is listed as one of the most beautiful villages in all France, and is definitely worth the 85-kilometer drive into the hills to get there. The highest village in Provence, Bargeme is set on a ridge above a lonely valley with spectacular views of the craggy cliffs, rolling fields, and forests stretching all around. The town is immaculately kept and has an active village life for the residents and farmers of the area. Bargeme is definitely one for the medieval enthusiasts. Take your camera because, while the village is small, there are some blindingly good views and many an archway to capture the perfect shot of the ruined castle or the giant cliffs towering up behind the village.






During the Christmas holiday, the French Riviera becomes a magical place everyone will love. With the traditional market chalets, parades, lights, and many local delicacies, the French Riviera celebrates Christmas to its fullest. There are places to party with champagne and DJs, places to go if you want a ski chalet vibe, and places where you can get a homey nostalgic feeling. The highlight of the celebratory season in the French Riviera is the Christmas markets and villages, where the traditional log chalets are icons of the season.




SAINT-TROPEZ

Saint-Tropez puts together a program of events for the Christmas season with activities for the whole family. Most festivities take place down by the port, where there is usually an open-air ice rink open. The traditional 'Crèche Provençale', a giant nativity scene, opens at the Chapelle de la Miséricorde (rue Gambetta). There will certainly be a Christmas village at the Place des Lices with stalls selling 'santons' (small hand-painted terracotta nativity scene figurines famously produced in the Provence region of southeastern France) and local delicacies such as crepes, waffles, chocolate and 'vin chaud' i.e. mulled wine. On Christmas Eve, in keeping with tradition, Santa Claus arrives in the town by boat to distribute gifts and sweets to the waiting children. Another thing to possibly look forward is traditional Provencal 'creches' or nativity scenes on display, a tourist train, a climbing wall for kids, horse-drawn carriage rides, live music, theatre, art and much more.






Frejus celebrates the holidays with two ice-skating rinks and two holiday markets: a gourmet market in the historic heart and a Christmas Village selling gifts on the seafront of Frejus and a funfair for kids, a Disney parade and lots more.



CANNES

During Christmas, Cannes lights up with parades, live music and decorations. It's one of the best places to visit and has kids' activities and parades. The Christmas market has 50 chalets (including Santa's chalet) featuring local specialties, handicrafts, and the largest animated artificial Christmas tree on the entire French Riviera. The Christmas parade procession with acrobats, Christmas characters, and illuminated performers enchanted the visitors. The youngest can have fun, watch a skating rink performance, and enjoy numerous games, rides, workshops, and entertainment.



ANTIBES AND JUAN-LES-PINS

Antibes and Juan-les-Pins turns into a exciting winter-land for kids' every Christmas holiday season. Their events truly highlight the tradition and culture of Christmas in Cote d'Azur. There are Christmas villages in various locations housing chalets with specially made gourmet treats and handcrafted gifts, Ferris wheel, carousel, and other rides for kids; Ice skating rink; animal farm, a dancing fountain with lights, and a "Creche road."



CAGNES-SUR-MER

The charming coastal town of Cagnes-sur-Mer has a lot going on every December. It has more holiday events than any other small town on the French Riviera! There are workshops and parades for kids with Disney characters cheering everyone on the streets. Traditional Christmas masses will be held at several churches. There are theater shows, Santa's forest, pony rides, and horse-drawn carriage rides to entertain visitors and locals during the festive season.




Seventy-one percent of the earth is water, yet most of this magical world remains a mystery. Embark on a journey traversing the planet's most exquisite waters from the crystalline aqua hues of the Caribbean to the deep indigo blues of the North Atlantic. There are such meditative and tranquil effects of being next to a body of water. 
TORTOISE RESERVE AT PLAINE DES MAURES NATURAL PARK


GRIMAUD KARTING LOISIR


PORT GRIMAUD

Hop over to Port Grimaud, only 20 minutes from Saint Tropez. This seaside town, known as the *Venice of Provence*, is the passion project of architect François Spoerry dating back to the 1960s. He modified the marshes of the river Giscle on the bay of Saint-Tropez. Built with channels in a Venetian manner but with French "fisherman"-style houses resembling those in Saint-Tropez, Spoerry called his style "L'architecture douce." You can sail along the canals in a small boat and boat around the multi-colored fishermen's houses. A stop at the Glacier de la Plage (for an artisanal ice cream or a homemade waffle) is a must before heading to the long beach just next to the port. The kids can learn to navigate the boat equipped with a map of the labyrinth-like canals in Port Grimaud. This is a beautiful way to spend a family day out.





This iconic building was once the city's gendarmerie, or police station, for over 125 years. It was made famous by Louis de Funès in films about the French police. You can learn about the history of both the building and the movie industry. Exhibits here range from a vintage police office to a replica retro movie theater.
