

### **ABOUT**

Far on the tip of Costa Rica's Nicoya Peninsula, away from airports and city lights, is Santa Teresa. This charming little surf village is known for its incredible beauty with white sand coves, steep jungle-covered hills and forests teeming with monkeys and exotic birds. It has excellent surf year-round, many food options, and an unbeatable atmosphere. Beaches serve as the main gathering place, especially at sunset. Small and large groups gather on the sand, surfers catch their last waves of the day, and everyone trying to get that perfect sunset selfie. Although this jungle-backed beach town is remote, it's anything but dull. Hip restaurants, beach parties, consistent surf breaks, jaw-dropping sunsets, and a social vibe that lets visitors reimagine what life is all about, make Santa Teresa one of Costa Rica's hot spots.


When Costa Rica abolished the military in 1948, it was able to reforest the majority of trees lost to bad policies. The country is now recognized worldwide as being at the forefront of conservation. It is basically the creator of ecotourism. The Nicoya Peninsula's designation as one of the world's five Blue Zones makes Santa Teresa an off-the-beaten-path escape from the buzz of the modern world. Some even travel to the region specifically for a self-imposed digital detox. A phrase you'll often hear associated with Costa Rica is "Pura Vida" or "Pure Life," and for good reason. Once a sleepy fishing village, Santa Teresa is now an increasingly luxurious surfer's paradise filled with people who have made this particular fantasy their reality.

Santa Teresa, a string of beach-backed hamlets on the southern tip of Costa Rica's westernmost peninsula, has an edge-of-the-world vibe that still feels remote and inspires dreams of relocation. Santa Teresa is far from most other destinations in Costa Rica. And that's all part of the appeal. it's no wonder with all the international coverage from media giants and visits from celebrities. One main road runs from the fishing village of Mal Pais through Playa Carmen, Playa Santa Teresa, and finally Playa Hermosa to the north. There are four areas in Santa Teresa among the loveliest. Driving down that dusty dirt main road connecting the locale's four beach areas - Playa Carmen (notable mainly for having the only ATMs in this no-credit-card zone), Playa Hermosa, Santa Teresa proper and Mal Pais - you look at the tanned, yoga-toned people carrying their surfboards back from the beach and wonder what your life would be like in a town that experiences almost year-round sunshine interrupted by the occasional biblical rainstorm and consistent 80-degree temperatures.




Even though Manzanillo is only a 20-minute drive away from Santa Teresa, the tranquil beach village has so far escaped tourist development. There aren't any hotels in Manzanillo, only a small nature lodge hidden in the hills and some vacation rentals.






Located in Cobano, Hermosa Hills is in a rural area and on the beach. The natural beauty can be seen at Santa Teresa Beach and Hermosa Beach. Explore all the area has to offer with mountain biking, hiking/biking trails, and ecotours.






Santa Teresa Beach is on the northern, more exclusive part of Santa Teresa. In this area, surfers can find the most consistent waves in the country. There is also an impressive array of dining options, bars, art galleries, boutiques featuring local designers, nature and hiking trails, and more.






This area has one of the most popular beaches in Costa Rica. It's known for its amazing surfing and fun vibe. The street behind the beach is full of restaurants, bars, hotels, and houses. There are a few roads heading up into the hills, dotted with boutique hotels and villas from which visitors can walk or drive down to the beach.






Mal Pais, Costa Rica is the southern neighbor of the popular tourist town, Santa Teresa but many people lump Mal Pais, Santa Teresa and Playa Carmen in as one. While Santa Teresa and Playa Carmen has grown substantially to become one of the top tourist destinations in Costa Rica, Mal Pais has retained its rural and relaxed local vibe.





The highlight in Santa Teresa are the gorgeous beaches. Santa Teresa is well-known for surfing, but the rough waves and rip currents can make swimming more of a challenge. Besides surfing and sunbathing, the beaches serve as the main gathering place, especially at sunset.




The beach is shaded by stocky palm trees and old Almendros leaning far out over the sand. Bathing is possible at mid to high tide. At low tide, visitors can walk over the rocks to a shallow lagoon protected by a reef. It's a good place for snorkeling and has the best light in the morning hours.





Somewhere around Florblanca hotel, the rocks begin again, and you'll find a huge towering rock known as *El Peñon*, which is where the Playa Hermosa beach area begins. Playa Hermosa is the most beautiful beach in the southern Nicoya Peninsula, and despite all the tourists in the area, is still to this day nearly empty. It's a long, flat sandy beach, with a great surf break (right point break) at the northern end. There's no development on this beach, except for an occasional house tucked back in the trees.






Playa Santa Teresa is the name given to a whole set of beautiful sandy beach areas north of the beaches of Playa Carmen. There are many road accesses, although some are footpaths only. Once you get to the La Lora Amarilla access, the beach really turns into a postcard, with perfect white sand and the best surfable waves.




#### **CARMEN BEACH**

Carmen Beach or Playa Carmen, as it is know, is the most popular beach in the area. Located in the center of the Santa Teresa – Mal Pais area, Playa Carmen is the most crowded, and so are its waves. The street behind the beach is full of restaurants, bars, hotels, rental villas, and many houses. There are a few roads that head up into the hills, dotted with boutique hotels and rental villas from which you can walk or drive down to this beach.






To the left (south) of the beach is a huge rock which is one of the landmarks of Malpais. Mar Azul is the most popular surf spot in the Mal Pais area, but still, it's rather empty. Most people go to Santa Teresa and Playa Carmen, where the waves are more consistent with fewer rocks.




#### THE SECRET BEACH

A secret spot at the far end of the Malpais road, this special cove is just on the other side of a towering rocky knoll, known also as "Playa los Suecos," the "Swedish Beach." The last leg of the road to get there is sometimes tricky, but drivable with 4WD. Probably because it's next to Cabo Blanco's protected marine reserve, this spot is really great for seeing fish, eels, octopuses, stingrays, sea turtles, lobsters, etc. People come here for spearfishing to hunt the unfortunate snappers and groupers that stray from the protected waters next door. The other reason to come is because of the great snorkeling in the rugged topography of the rocks. The reef outside protects this beach from heavy surf, making the water more tranquil.






This is one of Costa Rica's most special places. At low tide, a path under the waves will appear and you can walk out to the island. On the island is a cemetery, with a large mysterious gate. When a local person dies, sometimes the funeral service will be held at night, and all the attendees will carry candles across this path. It is a spectacularly eerie site. On the north side of the island is one of the area's best snorkeling spots.




#### **MONTEZUMA BEACH**

Since the 1970s, Montezuma has been a world-famous travel destination for people who want to get away from it all. Along with the Malpais, Santa Teresa, Manzanillo and other places, this is one of the best surfing beaches in the Nicoya Peninsula. It features some of the most perfect surfing waves that are known to be big, strong and consistent. Panoramic vistas around the area also make it one of the most popular tourist hubs in the region. Zipline tours are also a much sought-after adventure activity in the region. You can go along the Montezuma River and halt by the waterfalls.






Tortuga Island or Isla Tortuga (Spanish for "Turtle Island"), as it's known by Costa Ricans, is an exotic, albeit peaceful and pristine island lying off the southern tip of the Nicoya Peninsula. Tortuga Island is a delightful, mystical and scenic paradise with crystalline turquoise waters, relaxing tropical beaches, incredible biodiversity, and swaying coconut palms lining the tranquil beach.





There aren't many places in Costa Rica where you will find such a wide range of food choices like in Santa Teresa. The culinary scene ranges from gourmet restaurants and beach lounges to funky street-side stalls At most places you will dine "al fresco," which is just what you want on a balmy, tropical night. No need to bring a change of clothes for going out ... in Santa Teresa and Mal Pais dress code is very casual. The yoga and health scene in Santa Teresa ensures many vegan and health-oriented eateries, while the multi-ethnic composition of the village adds flavors from all over the world. For a typical Costa Rican dish go to a Soda, a simple restaurant, serving typical local food.

### **NECTAR | COSTA RICAN/FUSION**

Nectar at Hotel Florblanca is laid back and elegant; an indoor/outdoor gathering place for guests and locals wanting to dine, celebrate, or enjoy a cocktail after a day at the beach. The kitchen serves fusion cuisine with Latin, Mediterranean, and Asian influences. The menu is built around seasonal ingredients with an emphasis on organic local produce, fresh seafood from the surrounding waters, and traditional favorites. From sushi to fish tacos, from salads to chocolate soufflé, the menu is varied and creative. The fish is so fresh, it's hook to fork!




#### **AL CHILE VIOLA | ITALIAN**

Of all places, guests will experience an Italian meal here as they've probably never experienced before. Chef Emiliano from Florence challenges guests' taste buds with imaginative dishes using authentic Italian ingredients. The exciting menu includes traditional homemade pasta: beef lasagne, eggplant parmigiana, osso buco à la Romana, and seafood such as sea bass rolled around grilled vegetables. For dessert, try a killer dark chocolate mousse sprinkled with sea salt crystals, or try the signature frozen coffee made with local Cafe Tica liqueur. During the high season, December to May, there's live music three times a week.




#### MANZU | CONTEMPORARY

Manzu is designed to remind guests of the palm-thatched huts where the ancient Chorotegans used to live. It offers a relaxed ambiance set by the warm, salty breeze from the sea and the modern twist of an open kitchen. Enjoy the international menu with traditional Tico recipes passed down from generation to generation, all made with fresh, local ingredients. Mixologists surprise guests with their signature cocktails. Some of what's on offer: Fresh Pacific tuna served with fennel risotto, vegetables, and a wine reduction; coffee beef tenderloin with coffee-infused sauce, sweet potatoes, and sautéed spinach. For dessert try the Chocolate volcano with vanilla ice cream.



### KATANA | ASIAN

Owners say the idea of Katana is simply to create the best experience by trying to touch the hearts and souls of its customers. They do this by creating dishes inspired by many Asian cultures, transforming Asian fare into their own vision. They have a number of delicious rolls on the menu such as the Katana roll fashioned from tuna, avocado, cucumber, yuzu miso, and white fish topping; volcano roll made with tempura futomaki, avocado, sweet potato, tuna tartare and aioli; dragon roll made with white fish tempura, chipotle, avocado, seared tuna and tempura flakes.






Koji's Japanese Restaurant is considered to be the home of the best sushi in Santa Teresa. They use only the freshest fish and shellfish from the area as well as locally sourced vegetables, fruits and meats, offering a wide selection of excellent Japanese-inspired food. Chef Koji Hyodo's grilled octopus is barely fried and sprinkled with sea salt, and there's a perfectly sweet crunch to the soft shell crab and lobster tempura.



### NAMI | JAPANESE

Nami offers a combination of simple and modern Japanese cuisine with high-quality ingredients including fresh, local fish. In addition to a plethora of sushi rolls, main courses include udon noodles with vegetables and meat, chicken or seafood; sesame tuna; Nami sashimi. Special dishes include shrimp tempura with tuna, avocado, covered with spicy white fish, scallion and onion served with ponzu sauce; shrimp tempura, spicy tuna, avocado, covered with crunchy spicy tuna and sesame sauce; and shrimp tempura, avocado, spicy tuna, covered with tuna tataki.





## **JUNGLE SNACK**

The trendiest of beach towns on the Nicoya Peninsula, Santa Teresa offers much more than just fantastic surf. The food scene here is probably the best in all of Costa Rica. It can be said it's like a combination between Bali Gili Trawangan and Tulum, Mexico, but a few years behind. You'll find chic, open-air restaurants like Tom Brady's favorite sushi spot, Aussie-style coffee shops/cafes, perfectly flakey French pastries, and abundant vegan options. Enjoy!




#### **VAN PARJIS GALLERY AND STUDIO**




#### **COSTA RICAN COFFEE PRODUCTS**





Kika is considered by many to be the best bar in Santa Teresa for live music. On Thursdays, it's the hottest venue in town featuring a live band, loads of people and a great vibe. It's also a top venue for food and delicious cocktails.





Tipsy is an elegant wine shop, wine importer and wholesale distributor based in Santa Teresa beach. Besides offering a wide range of specially selected wines and spirits, as well as craft beers and cheeses it is also a sophisticated wine bar that attracts the cultured set of Santa Teresa. It's most popular on Thursday night when they have live music.








This is the perfect place to have a cocktail or a craft beer and watch a glorious sunset. Mixologists are very happy to create special cocktails for guests. Banana Beach often hosts events, from bikini contests to surf competitions. There's live music nightly, beautiful people, toasty beach bonfires and a lively ambiance.





The Drift is a vegetarian restaurant and bar, specializing in creative cocktails. The Drift Bar has a casual, cosmopolitan flair and is located by a former warehouse which now houses an art gallery. Drinks are made with cold-pressed juices and are best consumed in the chic lounge or while browsing the art. Guests who want to get their Santa Teresa beach villa rentals, can always order a sealed cocktail in a glass bottle (along with a reusable bag of ice) to go.





A refined beach restaurant with French cuisine, the restaurant **Playa Carmen** throws thundering rave parties on weekends. International Djs spin electronic music and there is dancing under the palm trees until wee hours.





No matter when visitors descend upon Santa Teresa, there is always some event taking place. Each year, a handful of festivals are organized to promote art in all of its forms, from theater to literature and film, showcasing both national and international artists. Although a lot of these performances are in Spanish, plenty of it is enjoyable by speakers of any language. Two of the largest festivals are the Arts Festival and the Light Festival.





Celebrated as the day Costa Rica secured its autonomy from Spain in 1821, Independence Day is celebrated with marching band parades of children playing their instruments to the tune of the Costa Rican national anthem. Typical Costa Rican foods are normally sold by street vendors.





Carnaval Nacional, an annual street festival, is held every Dec. 27 in downtown San José. There is live music, clowns, food, fanfare and much more. Street dancers in colorful costumes, decorations and a parade are just a portion of this exciting event.





The Festival of Lights or Festival de la Luz is held the evening of the second Saturday in December marking the official start of the holiday season. The fiesta is underscored with lively, festive music. A beautiful procession of white floats with glistening lights parades through the streets of San Jose, including the Paseo Colon and Avenida Segunda. Don't miss the brilliant fireworks show following the festival!



#### FESTIVAL DE LAS ARTES—ARTS FESTIVAL


The main art event in Costa Rica is the FIA+FNA, which stands for the joint event of the International Arts Festival and the National Arts Festival, a two-week celebration, filled with art shows, dance & acting performances, and massive concerts. It's a great opportunity to see creations by people from all kinds of backgrounds, and since it alternates annually between the international and national editions, there's plenty to discover each year. The festival was hosted in San Jose since it was founded, but recently the Ministry of Culture decided it was time to take it to another level, so now they tour different locations around the country. This festival usually takes place at the end of the dry season, in late March or April.




What's more exotic than a waterfall in the middle of the jungle? Hike to Montezuma Falls to experience the wilderness and since it is (possibly) the most famous waterfall in Costa Rica. In Montezuma, you might find exotic animals you won't be able to see in other parts of the area, such as the Roseate spoonbills (a bird similar to the pink flamingo), river otters, blue crayfish and the Jesus Christ lizards, able to run on the water surface.


#### **CAVING AT BARRA HONDA**

Barra Honda Caves National Park is an extensive network of caves about 40 minutes from Samara Beach that hold a number of secrets off-limits to the public like indigenous artifacts and the remains of humans. The public has access to one cave, Terciopelo. Guided tours with equipment are available in the dry season from the end of November through April. The three-hour tour begins with a 62-foot descent into the interior of the cave. Brave adventurers at Barra Honda will discover the wonders of this limestone cavern, including stalactites, stalagmites, soda straws, cave grapes, and more.




#### A VISIT TO CURU WILDLIFE REFUGE

Curu Wildlife Refuge is another popular choice for nature lovers staying in the Santa Teresa area. Search for Capuchin and Howler monkeys as you make your way through the coastal forest trails of Curu, observing towering Guanacaste trees and a variety of interesting flora along the way. This privately owned protected area keeps a rich and diverse ecosystem. The refuge is part of a large farm, which combines sustainable agriculture and forest management with the protection of wildlife and nature. This protected area has an abundance of wildlife hard to find anywhere else in the Peninsula.





Cabo Blanco has its own special place in the history of Costa Rica, becoming the first National Park in Costa Rica in 1963. The Reserve encompasses 1,270 hectares of mixed forest and 1,788 hectares of ocean belong to the protected area as well. The forest provides refuge to a large variety of animals like white-tailed deer, armadillos, anteaters, howler and capuchin monkeys, coatis, wild cats like ocelots and margays, while around 240 species of birds have been recorded in Cabo Blanco.





For many people, just sitting on the beach under a palm tree and staring at the waves is enough. Others like to "fry" in the sun, and show off a tan later. Beach-combing is popular, looking for various treasures to take home. Although it's actually illegal to take anything off the beaches, many (or most) people do. You can find a variety of shells, sand dollars, sea urchins, lots of interesting nuts and sea beans, agates and other beautiful stones, etc. Action sports are popular here, such as:

#### **SCUBA DIVING**

Costa Rica is world renown for being one of the best destinations to scuba dive. If the thought of diving in warm, crystal clear water teeming with tropical fish appeals to you, then read on to discover the basics of Scuba diving in the tropics. There are a couple of dive outfits in the general area that will take you to some spectacular locations.

- Tortuga Island known for its beautiful beach and hordes of tourists, but the waters in the area are great for scuba diving. You can see whale sharks, dolphins, whales, octopuses, white tip reef sharks, and large schools of fish.
- Costa Rica shipwrecks the Gulf of Nicoya is the only place in all of Central America that has THREE shipwrecks. that are suitable for diving occur in very few places in the country, so if you're into wrecks, this is the best opportunity in the country to see them.
- Tambor and Montezuma in various rocky reefs and coves
- Cabo Blanco



#### **SNORKELING**

Snorkeling can be amazing here, especially in dry season, when the water is more clear. Any time of year, there's tons of sea life in there, but due to dust and dirt that runs from the rivers into the ocean during heavy rains, you can't see much during "green" season, which is May through November. The best places to snorkel are:

- Playa Tequila
- Mar Azul Tidepools
- Los Suecos The "Secret Beach" is the best place. Tons of fish and creatures like octopi, sea turtles, huge rays, etc. due to being next to Cabo Blanco marine reserve.
- Las Manchas
- Tortuga Island





It would be impossible to visit Santa Teresa and overlook the influence of the area's surf culture. Mal Pais is one of the most beloved **surfing** areas in Central America and Santa Teresa is where all the wave fiends tend to congregate. Walk along the beach and witness lifelong surfers – local and international – navigate the amazing breaks along the rugged coastline.





Paddleboarding is a skill which most athletic tourists can pick up within just an hour of practice, assuming nice calm water. Good beaches to paddleboard are out at Playa los Suecos, but Manzanillo would be great, or Cabuya on the other side of the peninsula.






Kayaking is one of the choice water activities that attract many tourists, especially since it makes for a great family affair on any given day. Before tackling this activity, it is important to understand sea kayaking basics, specifically the conditions of the waters in your chosen area as well as where to get the appropriate gear. And remember to chart the waves before you brave the open waters in Santa Teresa.





The deep blue Pacific waters are home to abundant marine life, and this is the reason why sportfishing in Santa Teresa is one of the most pleasurable pastimes that anglers indulge. Some of the varieties you can catch here include mackerel, yellow-fin tuna, mahi-mahi, and Jack. This is not all! In deeper waters "catch of the day" can be marlin, sailfish, and large wahoo. Local fishing boats conduct guided tours, making sure that the adventure is to their clients' satisfaction.




### **GETTING THERE**
