ABOUT

The town of Telluride occupies the county seat and is the most populous town of San Miguel County. Formerly a frontier town, Telluride is situated in the stunning southwestern portion of the U.S. state of Colorado, a gold rush epicenter in the late 19th century. This former mining camp on the San Miguel River is witness to majestic western San Juan Mountains, that would bless the region as one of the world's premier skiing destinations.

Telluride sits in a box canyon, encircled by steep forested mountains and cliffs. Bridal Veil Falls is the state's tallest waterfall, situated at the canyon's head. A gondola ride connects the town with its companion, Mountain Village, at the base of the ski area.

The charms of Telluride and the surrounding area have earned it recognition in popular culture, and songs. The town is a symbol of Americana, Butch Cassidy, and the frontier spirit, just as much as it represents pristine wilderness and unnmatched ski slopes. An extensive cultural itinerary from music to film festivals dazzles during the summer.




TELLURIDE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

To get a good idea of Telluride's mining days, head to the Telluride Historical Museum. Get a glimpse into what life was like in the 1800s for miners and townsfolk. The museum houses a fantastic collection of photos and artifacts reconstructing the area's vibrant past. But it's not just all about mining. The museum also displays the region's history from its geological formation to prehistoric times (they even have dinosaur bones), on to its indigenous roots, housing an Anasazi blanket from between 800–900 years ago.






The iconic Sheridan Opera House was built in a style between Art Nouveau of the late 1880s and Craftsman of the 1920s. Construction was completed in March of 1913 and the venue has hosted famous entertainers such as Sarah Bernhardt. This heritage building has flourished amid the ebbs and flows of economic insecurity and continues on in all its late 19th century glory.





The Nugget Building, which houses the Nugget Theatre, was built in 1892 to house the First National Bank and the Telluride Power Company offices. Today, the theatre has weekly showings of current movies and hosts film-genre events throughout the festival season.



TONY NEWLIN GALLERY

Visitors who love nature and wildlife, should include a trip to the Tony Newlin Gallery. This photographer's collection includes images of Colorado, the western US, and Alaska. Each of Newlin's photos portrays an authentic wilderness scene. He strives to present nature as he experiences it – nothing more, nothing less. "I take pride in presenting authentic moments in nature and hope you appreciate and value the high standards of my work," he says. Beautiful prints are offered for sale at the gallery, including limited editions.





Since 1985, Telluride Gallery of Fine Arts has been dedicated to connecting contemporary art with art lovers. As the area's oldest established gallery, it exhibits the best in contemporary painting, photography, sculpture, and avant-garde jewelry. The gallery strives to remain at the forefront of emerging and contemporary art while being a resource for artists, art collectors, and the community.





Slate Gray Gallery is an art gallery, as well as a modern space showcasing items for home embellishment and personal adornment. The gallery presents a dazzling array of custom furniture, home decor, handmade leather goods and artisanal jewelry.






NIGHTLIFE






SKIING

Rated the #1 ski resort in North America by Conde Nast readers, Telluride Ski Resort is recognized internationally as a premier ski and snowboarding destination. Telluride's terrain is legendary and has always been revered as the best of Colorado. The region receives an average more than 300 inches of snow annually and offers more than 2,000 skiable acres for all ability levels. With 300 days of yearly sunshine and no lift lines, the skiing and snowboarding in Telluride is an epic experience.





Upon arriving at the camp, you're treated to a sumptuous Basque sheepherder meal, with dishes from Spain. At the end of the evening, you'll get aboard the sleigh and ride back to the waiting transport vehicle which will bring you back to Telluride.

Fly fishing in the winter in Telluride is truly a unique experience. Half-day trips are guided during the "heat" of the day. Start times and end times for each trip vary depending on weather conditions, location of fishing, and sunlight. Discover why fly fishing in the winter is more challenging than fly fishing at other times, but much more rewarding. Guides will provide a truly memorable experience in the breathtaking winter mountain scenery.



ICE CLIMBING

The alpine setting of the San Juan Mountains offers world–renowned ice climbing and provides a wide variety of winter climbing opportunities. To fully explore the winter climbing routes, we recommend the expertise of a local guide. Standing 365 feet tall, Bridal Veil Falls is Colorado's tallest free–falling waterfall, and one of the most classic and difficult ice climbs in the country. Having been closed to climbing for the better part of a few decades, with the exception of a few brief openings, the climb re–opened to the public in the winter of 2008/09.





Strap on a pair of snowshoes and explore Telluride's breathtaking backyard. Start on the Valley Floor to get the hang of this fun activity that is fun to learn and easy to master. For those who want more of a cardio challenge and adventure in the woods, head up the Bear Creek Trail.





Telluride and its surrounding areas are blessed with natural geothermal springs and mineral pools. Feel your muscles release decades-long tension amidst the majestic Colorado mountain scenery. Soak up every ounce of pleasure from the hot medicinal waters as snowflakes gently waft on a light breeze. A world of unforetold enjoyment awaits you in these natural hot springs – all within two hours of scenic mountain drives. Supplement your day at a hot spring with a body scrub, facial and massage. At the forefront of natural rejuvenation retreats, Telluride is a Mecca of wellness for your body, mind, and soul.

Orvis Hot Springs has long been a sacred place of healing for the Tabeguache band of the Utes, who lived in the Uncompanger River valley before Mexican and European settlement. Led by famed Ute Chief Ouray, the namesake of Ouray County, the Tabeguache soaked in the hot springs to receive its calming effects and curative powers. Today, these natural hot springs continue to offer therapeutic results to all who seek relaxation and rejuvenation.





Ouray Hot Springs' geothermally heated mineral pools range from 104 to 75 degrees Fahrenheit. Located in the heart of the San Juan Mountains – an area native to the Ute Indians – Ouray is rich in tradition and culture. The springs are a true gem of the Rocky Mountain region, referred to as the "Switzerland of America."






Wiesbaden is an intimate natural hot springs featuring a peaceful atmosphere and massage therapy. Here you will find a restful environment with a therapeutic hot springs vapor cave with soaking pool, outdoor hot springs, swimming pool, and Lorelei – a private hot springs soaking pool with a waterfall.






Just across the mountain from Telluride, Dunton Hot Springs is a romantic 1800s ghost town set in an extraordinary alpine valley. The resort offers a variety of day and overnight packages, and the entire town can be rented for corporate retreats, family reunions or weddings.





Ask any local on the gondola and they'll probably tell you, "they" came to Telluride for the skiing and stayed for the summers. There is no place quite like Telluride in the summer. You can find a lifetime's worth of outdoor activities to do. Telluride and the San Juan Mountains should be enough to quell anyone's appetite for natural beauty.





Telluride's most beloved method of transportation, the town's famed gondola in operation since 1996, connects the town to the Mountain Village. Soaring 10,540 feet above sea level, the ride provides stunning 360-degree views of the San Juan Mountains extending as far as Utah. A shining icon of the city and free for revelers, the gondola is adored by locals and tourists alike.



4X4 OFF ROADING

Travel to Telluride's high country to view beautiful mountain vistas, alpine lakes, waterfalls, wildflowers, ghost towns and mining ruins. From moderate overpasses to extreme roads, there is nothing like a 4x4 adventure ride on some of Colorado's most breathtaking mountain roads! Tour Imogene Pass, one of the most popular mountain passes, connecting Telluride to Ouray or explore one of the many other off-road routes such as Bridal Veil Falls, Last Dollar Road, Ophir Pass, Alta Lakes or Black Bear Pass.





A cherished Telluride destination, Bridal Veil Falls are the tallest free-falling falls in Colorado. Standing 365 feet in height, these falls are a regular pit stop for hikers, bikers, quad riders, ice climbers reveling in the majesty of nature. As locals can attest, the two-mile hike is well worth it!





Hiking is, by far, the most popular activity in the summer season. It's no surprise, as there is enough terrain in the greater Telluride region to explore a different trail every weekend. Surrounded by an abundance of scenic nature trails, expansive jeep roads, as well as plenty of less-traveled paths, you can choose a quick afternoon jaunt to summiting a 14,000-foot peak.





The San Juan Mountains provide a variety of terrain perfect for biking. From the town of Telluride, find challenging trails that explore old mining roads and basins high above the box canyon. For longer, moderate trails, mountain bikers can link several former railroad tracks throughout the valley and to the west. When the snow melts, the Telluride Ski Resort transforms into a biking playground with plenty of trails that meander through aspen groves and lush meadows.





From wild river rapids to a leisurely float, the Telluride area offers water sports second to none. The rafting season typically starts in late May and continues through October on the Colorado, Animas and Gunnison Rivers.






Located 40 minutes from Telluride, San Juan Balloon Adventures is available to fly on a daily basis (weather permitting) from May 1st through September 30th. 



MONTROSE REGIONAL AIRPORT


