

ABOUT

Verbier lies in the heart of the Bagnes Valley in the southern Swiss Alps, close to the borders of France and Italy. It is one of the most gloriously situated ski resorts in the Alps, with superb skiing and charming chalets. The ski resort is very entertaining, very stunning, and large skiing area. Snuggled among the majestic Swiss Alps, it forms the western sector of the massive 4 Vallees (the largest ski area entirely in Switzerland) and has almost limitless premier on and off-piste opportunities, rightly ranking it among Europe's best and most famous ski resorts. With more than 250 miles of ski runs, luxury chalets, Michelin-starred eateries, and ultra-high-end fashion outlets attracting premier clientele, Verbier is on everyone's luxury travel list. Its blazing white powder and decadent apres-ski experiences are unrivaled. Being just over an hour and a half's drive from Geneva, Verbier is a much-favored ski weekend destination. Situated in the center of the 4 Valleys, which gives way to a vast ski area with exciting terrain to thrill skiers and boarders of all abilities.

Verbier isn't only for its snow. When the valleys have thawed in summer, Valais vineyards come to life, awaiting the harvest for vintners to create the nectar of the gods. Visitors will enjoy visiting local wineries to indulge in vintage tastings. Spring and summer in the Swiss Alps are magical because underneath all that winter powder lies hundreds of miles of trails and footpaths for biking and hiking. Lush pastures are grazed by cows and the whole region turns into a playground with infinite potential. Alpine wildflowers turn landscapes into kaleidoscopes of color. Travelers who visit Verbier in the spring and summer will wonder why they waited so long.






Verbier ski resort comprises hundreds of small wooden chalets and much larger, but still chalet–shaped, apartment blocks and hotels clad in wood. An enchanting village ambiance is speckled with lovely low–rise chalets loyal to local architectural tradition and folkloric flourishes. Fusing state–of–the–art mega–sized resort infrastructure with the pinnacle of cosmopolitan thrill and fine living options, Verbier's draw is second to none. Abuzz with verve and vitality, this elite holiday destination offers the ultimate choose–your–own–adventure getaway. The chalet–style villages provide some of the most stunning vistas in the country, including that of Mont Blanc, the Alps' highest mountain, and the Matterhorn from the summit of Mont Fort. With an impressive assortment of vacation home hot spots, from the lively town of Verbier to the quiet village of La Tzoumaz, the 4 Vallées are full of surprises.

LA TZOUMAZ

The north side of Verbier is reserved for the hamlet of La Tzoumaz. The small town of La Tzoumaz, in the opposite direction from Verbier than Bruson, comes to life in both winter and summer. It is linked to Verbier and the rest of the 4 Valleys ski area by the Savolyeres ski lift and has a much quieter après ski scene than the central part of Verbier. Vacationers can choose to relax or take advantage of the perfect snow conditions, sunshine galore, and glorious views. Chalets here are just a stone's throw away from the lifts. There are a handful of bars and restaurants in La Tzoumaz, offering mostly Savoyard-style food or pizza.




LES CREUX & SAVOLEYRES

This is a quiet, convenient spot on the north side of Verbier. Up the hillside from the center of Verbier are the quieter areas of Les Creux and Savoleyres. These two hamlets are very close to the pistes and near amenities of the Verbier center, reachable by bus. Les Creux and Savoleyres are good options for those looking for ski-to-the-door accommodations, who are not too worried about making the most of the town's nightlife. Staying here means you are closer to some of the quieter lifts and slopes in the valley, making it a great location for families. Even though this area is slightly out of town, the main lifts, bars, and restaurants are still easily reachable.



VERBIER VILLAGE | PLACE CENTRALE & MEDRAN LIFT

The lively town has an exciting buzz and is brimming with keen skiers and après lovers. Being just over an hour and a half's drive from Geneva, Verbier is a much-favored ski weekend destination and you will soon feel at home in the laid-back atmosphere of the town. Verbier town is perched upon a sun-drenched plateau in the center of the 4 Valleys. Right at the heart of Verbier sits the aptly named Place Centrale, from where the Medran lift departs accessing the main ski area. This is the place to be if you are looking for central accommodation right at the heart of the action and want easy access to ski schools, shopping and, of course, the town's legendary bars, nightclubs, and restaurants.




LE CHABLE

At the bottom of the valley, Le Chable is a quiet village on the east side of Verbier, very well connected with the center of the town, thanks to a gondola providing direct access to the Medran ski lift. Ski slopes and nightlife of Verbier are still within easy reach. Whenever you fancy Verbier's legendary après ski scene, remember the last lift down the valley leaves at 6:30 p.m. The ski area is easily accessible by cable cars connecting Verbier and Bruson. Le Chable also has a tourist office and a railway station, so it is the ideal point of departure for many excursions and hikes. For those who want the magic of racing down untouched snow, heli-skiing is readily available with copters taking off from Le Chable to set skiers down on the summit of Petit Combin, the Rosablanche, or the Trient for the descent of a lifetime.



BRUSON

Set on the south side of Verbier the village is ideal for families and accomplished skiers. The village has an unspoiled and peaceful feel making it ideal for those who are looking for a more authentic Alpine ski holiday. Based on the other side of the valley from Verbier, Bruson is considered by locals as a bit of a hidden gem in the 4 Valleys ski area. Little wooden chalets, roofs covered with thick snow. That's the background - a typical mountain village, quietly authentic. Yet this fairytale image is far from being all that Bruson has to offer. With 26 kilometers of ski runs, forests of well-spaced trees ideal for freeriding and ski touring, this resort enchants every lover of snow sports. Skiing here on a powder day is great when the rest of Verbier may already be tracked out. Every year, it hosts a qualifier for the Freeride World Tour as well as the No Limits Bruson Freeride Tour (FWT Junior), attracting more than 250 skiers and snowboarders intent on taking to the vertiginous slopes of Pointe de Sésal or Six-Blanc. Moreover, the Bruson-Verbier cable car puts the 4 Vallées skiing area within easy reach.






One of the largest lift-linked areas in the world, Verbier is part of the 4 Valleys ski area giving skiers access to 412 kilometers of downhill skiing on 205 pistes. Verbier is the western part of the 4 Vallèes, a Swiss mega ski resort comprising Bruson, La Tzoumaz, Nendaz, Veysonnaz, and Thyon/Les Collons ski resorts too. Skiing in and around Verbier can be broken up into four areas, namely: Verbier, La Tzoumaz/Savoleyres, Bruson, and Mont Fort. Thanks to the Mont Fort cable cars to interlink them all, a world-class freeride haven has been created making it the largest fully interlinked ski area in Switzerland. If 410 kilometers of ski trails, limitless off-piste, and more than 2,500 meters of skiable vertical aren't enough to satiate the hardest of hardcore skiers and snowboarders, then nothing will.


THE SAVOLEYRES / LA TZOUMAZ

The Savoleyres/La Tzoumaz area has sunny open pistes great for beginners and lower intermediates on the Verbier village side and better snow-quality trails in the shaded side down to La Tzoumaz. It is great in poor weather and when the snow has degraded on Verbier's south-facing slopes. Le Nord chair lift provides a short but sweet, moderately steep ridgeline speckled with trees. Downhill enthusiasts will get their adrenalin pumping on easy or advanced trails from the top of the Savoleyres gondola lift or from the Vallon d'Arbi at an altitude of more than 7,500 feet. Try freeriding in the Vallon d'Arbi or take on the challenge of the Audi Quattro funslope obstacle course. Tobogganers can fly down the famous toboggan run or can test their sled speeds in the arena of the Savoleyres competition stadiums.




VERBIER, CHASSOURE-TORTIN AND MT GELE

Around Verbier village is a sensational sunny place for beginners and intermediates up to Savoleyres, with plenty of easy slopes and wide runs to cruise down. The runs soften up nicely in the afternoon, thanks to the south-facing orientation. The immediate Verbier sector includes 1,500 meters of skiable vertical for all abilities up to Mont Gele. Experts should head for the challenging ski terrain of Chassoure-Tortin and Mt Gele, a mountain with no marked pistes. Within sight of Mont Gele, the serious freeride routes on the intimidating Bec des Rosses (used in the Freeride World Tour competition) will challenge the best skiers and riders.



THE MONT FORT


Finally, the Mont Fort sector is part of the 4 Vallees interlinked ski area and not strictly part of Verbier. The terrain is mainly off-piste freeride and advanced routes, although a major intermediate trail does link back into Verbier. The Mont Fort sector of the 4 Vallees ski area offers the largest array of easily reached advanced and expert terrain of any ski resort in the Alps. When combined with the Verbier sectors Mt Gelé and Tortin itineraries, the possibilities are simply vast. The Mont Fort sector can either be accessed via La Chaux from Verbier or via Tortin from either Verbier or Nendaz and then taking the Mont Fort tram from Col des Gentianes tram to an altitude of 3,330 meters (10925.2 feet).



BEGINNER SKI AREAS

The three nursery areas in Verbier ski are easily accessed from the center of the resort and can be found relatively close together on the piste map.

- 1. LES ESSERTS is the largest of the beginner ski areas in Verbier (with one drag lift and two magic carpets at your disposal). With its short, gentle slopes conveniently situated right next to the Hameau restaurant terrace, Les Esserts is undoubtedly the most popular spot for beginner skiers and families alike. It is also home to the longest magic carpet in Switzerland.
- 2. LES MOULINS has one short drag lift and is the smallest of the nursery ski areas in Verbier, with a slope of just 318 meters in length. It's situated right in the heart of Verbier and the École Suisse de Ski uses it exclusively for their Kids' Club program.
- 3. **LE ROUGE** nursery ski area is served by one drag lift with two slopes that run from the top of the village. The variable speed drag lift here gives beginner skiers and snowboarders access to a slightly more inclined slope, the perfect place to progress after spending time on Les Esserts.
- 4. LA CHAUX After feeling more confident on these nursery slopes, the La Chaux area further up the mountain is a good place to progress. There are nice, slow blue pistes here which tend to soften up in the afternoon given their south-facing orientation. This area is accessible from the Médran via La Chaux Express lift and is also serviced by a four-man chair, making it a great place to practice what you've learned at ski school.



BRUSON

The lower Bruson ski area is across the valley via gondola from Le Chable. Bruson ski area is a lovely little tree-lined ski area situated opposite Verbier in the Val de Bagnes. Bruson can be easily reached via two gondolas from Verbier which take you down in the valley to Le Châble and then up to the ski area. The skiable vertical on the pistes is around 620 meters (1,600 meters to 2,220 meters), so It's well worth the effort, especially if the weather up in Verbier is bad. If the snow level is good, ski routes here reach into the valley all the way to Le Chable.




LE GRENIER | FRENCH

Le Grenier is Verbier's traditional alpine restaurant set in the Chalet d'Adrien as well as La Table d'Adrian. Authentic flavors on the menu are prepared by Sebastiano Lombardi. It's time for veloutés, peasant soups, braziers, large cocottes, frog legs, raclette and fondues, stews, vanilla cream and large old–Fashioned tarts. In a rustic decor of stone and wood, the Grenier offers traditional cuisine also served on the terrace at lunch time.



LE ROUGE | FRENCH

Dishes are created from the fresh, bountiful produce of the region. The dinner menu contains options such as roasted sea bass fillet, Iberico Pork Presa, and delicious Thai sauteed noodles! There is also a selection of organic and vegetarian dishes. For a starter, check out the perfect organic poached egg with cauliflower mousseline, black truffle, pecans, and oyster mushroom crisps. Le Rouge also has an impressive wine list and a selection of cocktails. All this makes Le Rouge one of our favorite Verbier après ski spots.



LA CORDÉE | FRENCH

La Cordée is a chic alpine lounge bar with champagne, afternoon teas and cocktails. This stylish lounge bar is within a luxury four-star superior hotel is just a short walk from the Place Centrale, in the heart of Verbier. The bar features comfortable sofas, cozy log fire in the winter and a chic interior to create a sophisticated yet welcoming atmosphere. As well as a full range of traditional beverages such as beers, wines and spirits, they also have a selection of divine homemade cocktails. They also offer delicious afternoon teas which you can enjoy with champagne! The perfect way to indulge after a day on the slopes.



LA TABLE DU "22" - TABLE D'HÔTES I CLASSIC

It is well worth venturing to this discreet and exclusive fine dining table d'hôte concealed by a secret door behind the bar. A handpicked group of 15 or so guests are welcomed by the owner himself, who is then on hand throughout the meal to ensure that everything runs smoothly. The kitchen sends out crafted and elegant classic dishes based on excellent regional ingredients – all with a subtle Mediterranean touch. An intimacy and a feeling of friendly hospitality reign here. You'll need to book well in advance.




LA GRANGE | SWISS

La Grange is set in the center of Verbier. You can enjoy an array of seasonal produce, fish, and grilled meat for lunch and dinner. Gourmands gravitate to La Grange's eclectic mix of local and French dishes. The ambiance is upscale yet relaxed and the cuisine is delectable. Consider starters like the wild sea bass tartare with chili, red onion, lime, and fresh coriander or the terrine of duck foie gras and onion confits. Entrées are just as mouth-watering with choices like Emmental veal filet mignons with chanterelles or pork ribs grilled to perfection. If there is still room for dessert, the white and dark chocolate mousse with bitter orange coulis is a popular choice, as is the palette of in-house-created sorbets.


EAT-HOLA TAPAS BAR | MODERN CUISINE

CHEZ DANY | SWISS






APRÉS SKI



LE ROUGE APRÈS SKI

This classic après ski spot ticks all the boxes, with a prime position on the piste, soulful house music, cocktails and a killer view. This restaurant and bar has delicious food and a great ambiance. End your ski day with a rich truffle fondue for the table and a delicious glass of wine. As the afternoon proceeds, move to their terrace and enjoy a classic yet sophisticated apres ski experience. The panoramic terrace is one of the best places in town to catch the last of the sun.






If a rowdy, *plein air*, wear-your-boots-to-the-lodge type of atmosphere is what you're after, then this is the spot. There's live music every night, and the party gets going around mid-afternoon. However, the aprés ski hotspot turns into a posh lounge bar at night.

W OFF PISTE

Kick off the winter season in style at and be a part Verbier's vibrant social scene at W Off Piste. Ski down the slopes straight to this posh après-ski bar and join the party. Nestled in the heart of Place Blanche, at the foot of the slopes, the outdoor après-ski bar invites you to mix, mingle, and energize after a dynamic day. Winter offerings include signature cocktails, like the W Hot Wine and other warming sips and season-less favorites: classic cocktails, shots, champagne, beer, wine, and more.



CARVE SUSHI BAR

Sushi and après ski are a match made in heaven, and Carve Sushi Bar knows it. Restaurant by day and club by night, this is one of the most memorable places in the Verbier après ski nightlife scene. Standing out among the traditional Swiss bars and restaurants, enjoy beautifully created dishes and delicious drinks, all before the lights go down and the music turns up.



ICE CUBE VERBIER

A subsidiary and neighbor of Le Mouton Noir, Ice Cube is the perfect pit-stop for hungry skiers. A place not to be missed at 2,200 meter top of the Ruinettes gondola, Ice Cube Verbier is the perfect place for a snack break (with burgers, salads, snack boards, paninis and nuggets), or to enjoy a drink while admiring breathtaking views from the terrace. Stop off for a breather before you head down the slopes on your way back to your luxury chalet.





The crêpes at mountain pit stop Le Mouton Noir are made by chefs who have come all the way from Brittany. They're traditional and made right in front of you, with something for everyone, from cheese, ham, and egg, to Nutella, vanilla ice cream, and salted caramel sauce. And the gaufres (crispy shell, soft center) topped with chantilly cream and chocolate sauce come highly recommended too.



PUB MONT FORT


If you're looking for a friendlier bar, then you aren't going to find one. Verbier après ski at its best, Pub Mont Fort is perfect for a quick pint and a bite to eat. A central location with space for all, you'll find people of all ages and backgrounds mixing here, and they even show live sports on the screens. If you are looking for a lively bar to kick back in after a hard day on the slopes, then the Pub Mont Fort behind the Médran ski lift is a favorite of party-loving seasonaires and is a fantastically rowdy place to start off your night with a happy hour from 4–5 p.m.



IGLOO DU MONT-FORT

Situated at 3,330 meters above sea level, the highest point of the 4 Valleys ski area, the Mont-Fort Igloo offers a breathtaking view over more than 110 summits. you can admire the breathtaking view From the Weisshorn to the Matterhorn and the Mont-Blanc, your gourmet break promises to be spectacular. The Igloo serves snacks and a wide range of drinks. Make sure you try the champagne fondue or a Swiss Rock coffee, a specialty made with espresso, apricot schnapps, cane sugar, and whipped cream.





THE FARM CLUB | NIGHT CLUB

Founded in 1971, the Farm Club is one of the oldest nightclubs in the Alps and certainly the most iconic in Verbier. Glamorous and intimate, the mythical Farm Club is where the whole of Verbier meets. Always frequented by international clientele and European royalty, the atmosphere is festive and timeless, just like the Valais resort. Since its inception, the whole planet has passed through the mythical door, bringing the club to the most beautiful international capitals. A night out during your stay is without a doubt a must while in Verbier, just make sure to wear your best alpine chic.



LE FARINET | LOUNGE BAR & NIGHT CLUB

Described as a landmark in Verbier for a night out, the cocktails are handcrafted, and the DJs are international. Le Farinet is one of those Verbier nightlife scenes you cannot help but gravitate to. And being open until 4 a.m. means plenty of time to enjoy that cocktail. It's one of the only Verbier bars to feature live music. The Farinet Lounge Bar is the perfect venue to unwind in style. It offers more than 30 signature cocktails and an international gin menu, all expertly crafted by its mixologists. There is plenty of space to relax by the charming open fire, drink well and enjoy dishes from a carefully crafted menu.



LE CROCK NO NAME | BAR


W LIVING ROOM | LOUNGE BAR

THE ARTS

FONDATION GIANADDA

East of Verbier, Martigny is a simple drive through awesome mountainscapes and has a few things to hold your attention for an afternoon. The undeniable highlight is the Fondation Gianadda, a sizeable exhibition hall constructed in the 1970s. This stages regular temporary art exhibitions, and to give you a sense of the standard, there were shows for Munch, Hodler, Monet, and Cézanne in 2017 alone. There's also a permanent collection of vintage cars, as well as artifacts from when Martigny was a Roman settlement. For many visitors, the best bit is outside, where the sculpture garden has pieces by Rodin, Jean Dubuffet, Max Ernst, Alexander Calder, Chagall, Joan Miró, and many more 20th century artists.



BEL AIR FINE ART VERBIER

The first gallery of "Bel Air Fine Art" was opened in Geneva in 2004. Since then, exhibitions can be visited all over the world. One of them is in Verbier. The gallery in Verbier is open daily and exhibits unique modern art.





The May Sky Gallery features mountain art and photography by two local artists, Tracie May and Melody Sky. In addition, the work of other artists is exhibited regularly.





Land Art is a contemporary art movement involving the use of natural materials to create works intended for outdoor exhibition. Michael Heizer, born in California in 1944, is one of the best known artists within this new trend, and his works are exhibited all over the world. In the Val de Bagnes, his work, Tangential Circular Negative Line Sculpture, is on show close to the Mauvoisin Hotel at the foot of the dam.



CINÉMA DE VERBIER

This cinema has 400 seats on two floors and a relaxing lounge. Independent and classified, the cinema of Verbier was built in 1956 by the architect Alexandre Bujard and then operated by his family which continued to perpetuate the film tradition since 1998. The 440-seat hall with a 150-seat balcony is one of a kind. Its Rococo style has evolved over time without changing its early look despite several changes in projection techniques (abandonment of 35-minute film in favor of a 4K digital projector and 3D) and sound (change from stereo sound to Dolby 5.1). The cinema proudly presents the program consisting of the latest releases in original versions with subtitles or in French. The cinema is proud of its judicious choice of good and auteur films for all audiences.



THE ESPACE ALPIN (ALPINE SPACE)

The Espace Alpin, lin the heart of the Hameau de Verbier, brings together more than 3,000 objects that take visitors on an exciting journey through the history of Alpine societies. Designed and built in 1994 by the architect Pierre Dorsaz, it presents his vision of the mountains to us by addressing strong and identifying themes: life in the mountain pastures, working in the vineyard, crafts, housing, fauna, but also the hydroelectric industry, the ski lifts and all the modernization of the Alps. A moment of wonder is at the heart of this important private collection.




THE BAGNES MUSEUM

The Bagnes Museum has taken up residence in Le Chable, the capital of the commune of Bagnes, in a place steeped in history: the former cure located near the parish church. The building took its current form in the 17th century, while parts of the walls date back to the beginning of the 13th century. The venerable building, enlarged and refurbished over the centuries, was renovated and transformed into an exhibition space in 1984. Local artists and thematic exhibitions have since regularly taken place there. A room decorated with a remarkable mural painting (Crucifixion, 1627), paneled rooms with molded ceilings (16th–17th centuries) an astonishing painted ceiling from the beginning of the 18th century, and numerous soapstone stoves make an old cure a setting of choice for the exhibitions of the Museum of Bagnes.







From the novice to the professional, guests are privy to a dizzying array of diverse slopes, from quaint bunny hills to the infamous Mont Fort run. Fun for the whole family or the weathered thrill-seeking athlete, Verbier's four valleys set the platinum standard for snow sports. Ideal for the snowboarder or the ski purist, Verbier lines up iconic runs navigating truly remarkable 'marked' off-piste territories such as the Col des Gentianes Tortin and the Mont Gele. From Verbier's principal lift station, the Medran, there are a number of intermediate ski areas, such as La Chaux and Lac des Vaux. No stranger to those seeking to kick up the powder with style, the large terrain park in Thyon provides plenty of rails, jumps, and even an airbag jump. Beginner boarders can make use of the resort's nursery run at Les Esserts.



HELI-SKIING

Beside being and off piste and freeride mecca, Verbier is a major player in the practice of heli-skiing in the Alps. In addition to private outings, from mid-January, a group heliski outings are being organized.

- A few minutes flight from Verbier: Trient Glacier, Petit Combin, Rosablanche, Pigne d' Arolla, Wildhorn are among the drop-off points located around the resort and offer long and unforgettable descents in an authentic high-mountain setting, far from the crowds that rule the slopes!
- A little further: Petersgrat, Gstaad, Monte Rosa, Cervinia, Valgrisenche, Courmayeur.





Powder hounds will revel in the off-piste skiing to be had in back-country Verbier – it's some of the best in Europe. People go all dreamy-eyed at the very mention of powdery and utterly beautiful Vallon d'Arby, with its snow-capped trees, or the lesser-skied Backside Mont Fort. Resurrecting a fairytale vision of winter wonder, free skate, play a game of Eisstock, or taking a leisurely glide along a magical ice path before a diamond-studded night sky. Wonderful family moments await with a refreshment bar for hot drinks and tasty snacks awaiting the little ones. A robust selection of deserts goes down swimmingly with a fine aperitif.



TOBOGGAN RUN

Offering exhilaration for all ages, Verbier's La Tzoumaz Toboggan run is the longest in all of French-speaking Switzerland. Thrills abound along an invigorating 2,300-foot altitude descent, zipping past hairpin bends in the middle of the forest. Each turn down this Toboggan run is rewarded with superb views over the Rhone and the Valais mountains from the comforts of the cable car journey. From the intrepid rider sledder bringing a competitive edge to those indulging in a more leisurely pace, this crowd-pleasing activity delights far and wide.





The world-class Verbier Snowpark is situated in La Chaux above 2,260 meters with a sunny south-facing aspect and associated big air views towards the Grand Combin. The park is accessed via a modern combi gondola /chairlift, the Chaux Express. The Verbier Snowpark is the venue for loads of Big Air competitions. It is full of jumps and rails plus even a giant airbag to cushion your fall when you go for big air and you don't quite make it.



ADAPTIVE SKIING IN VERBIER


Verbier is a fantastic place to visit for people with disabilities, who can enjoy everything that it has to offer both in the town and mountains. If you'd like someone to accompany you on the slopes, the ski schools will have highly experienced and qualified adaptive instructors providing automated adaptive tuition, guiding and equipment for all types of skiers, boarders, beginners or full-time athletes. Instructors and the resort are passionate about ensuring you gain the ultimate snow experience whatever your ability. The lift company can accommodate the following equipment on most of the lifts throughout the ski resort: Uniski, Dualski, Dualski with pilot and a Tandem-ski with pilot. People with disabilities have access to the entire skiing domain. You are advised to book at least 15 days in advance and then to confirm one week before arrival, to ensure that the most appropriate equipment is available for your lesson.



SPAS

If skiing isn't quite your style – or if it is, and you need a serious come-down after you come down the mountain – spend some time exploring Verbier's spa scene. From sleek and modern to classic Swiss, there's something for everyone.



- Spa Nuxe du Chalet | Set inside the Chalet d'Adrien is an unassuming, luxurious spa using exclusive products from the French skincare brand Nuxe. There's an entire hydrotherapy circuit with saunas, steam rooms, and pools, but we suggest springing for the full-body gommage scrub.
- Chalet Spa Verbier | A quintessential Swiss spa with impeccable design, service, and a supreme sense of mountainside serenity. Bring a book and spend the afternoon going between the cedar-lined sauna and the heated pools. C'est sublime.





FESTIVALS & EVENTS

Verbier plays host to some exciting spectator events such as the Verbier High Five, where gifted amateur skiers can take a chance at showing off their skills by competing alongside professional skiers including world champions, Xtreme Verbier which is the breathtaking final of the Freeride World Tour as well as the Patrouille des Glaciers, which is an endurance race from Zermatt. Verbier also has the XSpeed Ski Open Race finals where you can watch the fastest speed skiers in the world hurtle down Mont Fort at speeds of around 200 km/hr. If you are holidaying in Verbier during the spring or summer months, then there are plenty of other sporting events such as the Trail Verbier Saint–Bernard, which is an extreme endurance race for athletes or the Grand Raid mountain bike race as well as stages of the Tour de France, Tour de Suisse and Romandie and the Rallye du Valais motor race.



POLARIS FESTIVAL

The Polaris Festival is an Electronic Music Festival held over one or two weekends. Over the course of the Festival, international visitors and Verbier locals come together to dance and party with some biggest names in Techno and EDM. With a breathtaking backdrop, multiple indoor and outdoor stages, and late-night clubbing, this festival is set out to be one for the books. This electronic music festival bumps the beats 2,200 meters up at the Le Mouton Noir ski resort in Verbier. Ski, ride, and dance the weekend through thanks to a stellar line-up of world-renowned artists.



THE PATROUILLE DES GLACIERS

This is a ski mountaineering race held every second year at the end of the ski season. The Patrouille des Glaciers, in short, PDG took place for the first time in 1943 as a performance race for Swiss military patrols. The Patrouille des Glaciers is a historical, national and international military race, open to civilian, elite, and popular competitors and it's the toughest team competition in the world. The start is in the middle of the night when a crowd of athletes storms across the start line. For ambitious ski mountaineers, it is nearly expected that you will have participated once in your life. The course follows the world-renowned "Haute Route" from 7ermatt to Verbier over 53 kilometers (33 miles) and 4,000 meters of vertical (13,123 feet). The race's distance, the high Alpine terrain, as well as the historic background contributes significantly to the legend of PDG. The Patrouille des Glaciers is not just a race, it's a human adventure for three, a journey through history, mountains, sport, friendship, and emotion organized by the Swiss Army.



SWATCH XTREME VERBIER

The highlight of the season, the very last and most eagerly awaited stage of the Freeride World Tour takes place on the legendary face of the Bec des Rosses. After four competitions around the globe, the best freeriders in the world meet in Verbier to compete for the title of world champion.

It is the most prestigious extreme skiing and snowboarding contest and the final competition in the season of the FWT (Freeride World Tour). Verbier's reputation as an off-piste destination of the highest order is underlined by this competition in which the world's best freeriders test their skills on the steepest slopes, cliffs, and gorges. As one of the big annual events in the resort, Swatch Extreme Verbier pulls in crowds of up to 6,000. There are also concerts, DJs, and autograph sessions to check out all week long.



VERBIER ART SUMMIT

Organizers of the Verbier Art Summit believe it's time for art and culture to play a dominant role in the world. They are a non-profit organization aiming to empower the art ecosystem to be a positive social change facilitator, connecting thought leaders to key figures in the art world to generate innovative ideas. Through a series of talks and debates with an invited group of leading art world stakeholders, new visions and initiatives are born making a positive change and building global solidarity. Talks provide a unique chance to be inspired by leading international art world figures on topical issues. The summit educates, provokes, and inspires its members and the wider community. Key insights of each summit are shared digitally and documented in an annual publication. The public can attend free talks and cultural events and participate in talks and live Q&As.




VERBIER FESTIVAL

For two weeks in late July and early August, classical musicians and visitors descend on Verbier for this international music festival. The festival aims to build a community of exchange between great masters and young artists from all over the world and to be a leader in its field by providing meaningful music education programs. For 50 budding soloists, the Verbier Festival Academy is a learning experience, bringing them into contact with luminaries as varied as Martha Argerich, Lera Auerbach, Julian Rachlin, Piotr Anderszewski, and Anoushka Shankar, all of whom have attended the festival since its inception in 1994. Audiences are welcomed with a distinctive and exhilarating blend of events, both large-scale and intimate. The festival sets the gold standard for the training of emerging soloists, chamber and orchestral musicians, singers, and conductors.



THE TRAIL DU VELAN

The Trail du Vélan is a one-day event with different-length races starting in the little village of Bourg St Pierre. The Cross du Velan event takes place above one of the most stunning valleys in Switzerland, Entremont valley and it was first held in 1977 in dedication to two local guides, both of whom lost their lives in the mountains. There are two Trail du Vélan – a 45km qualifier and a 21-kilometer race. Runners can do the 44.1-kilometer route as a two-person relay team, switching at Azerin, the midway point. The Petit Cross is the kids' event and covers 500 meters, 1,000 meters and 1.7-kilometer race distances.



KERMESSE

Kermesse is Swiss National Day. Since 1891, this day has been celebrated as Swiss National Day. The date refers to a historic alliance concluded in 1291 by the three cantons of Uri, Schwyz, and Unterwalden. This alliance became the focal point around which the Switzerland of today was built over the next 500 years. In Verbier, the Kermesse de Verbier runs the show celebrating its national day with various activities taking place on the Rue de la Poste from the July 31 until the early hours of August 2. At the market, expect beautiful craft stalls, interactive entertainment including clowns, barrel organ, and fairground activities. Public and private buildings are decorated with national, cantonal, and community flags, and the bakers produce special bread rolls with a small Swiss flag on top. Like most of Switzerland, Verbier finishes things with a spectacular fireworks display and concert.



THE GRAND RAID CRISTALP

In its 24th year, the Grand Raid Cristalp has established itself as one of the most arduous MTB (mountain bike) marathon events on the calendar. If not overly technical it is certainly a test of endurance. The race carries decent UCI ranking points and therefore draws a strong field of professional riders; It is a mountain bike race from the town of Verbier to Grimentz. The race leaves from the center of Verbier and takes you on a 125-kilometer course which after 5,200 meters of ascent finishes with a massive descent into the town of Grimentz. As opposed to most road rides Cristalp's ride profile resembles the jagged profile of an ECG scan when the patient takes a turn for the worse. No flat sections and no respite. In 2022 the e-bike category opened on start in Verbier and Nendaz, it is now possible to register from Verbier and cover 125 kilometers by e-bike.



CHRISTMAS

With so many families visiting Verbier for the festive season, Christmas time in Verbier makes for a truly memorable and magical experience. Early December sees much vin chaud, hot chocolate and music accompany the big Christmas lights 'switch on', a sign of the beginning of the festivities. There's a giant Christmas tree at Place Centrale and authentic festive markets running throughout December. The first lifts open from early November and as Christmas approaches, the full lift system opens, which is generally early December. This is marked by the much anticipated "Santa Ski" which is a momentous day, bringing around 2,000 Father Christmas skiers to the slopes.





Verbier is renowned for its NYE celebrations. There are always fireworks, partying in the square and flying Champagne corks. The town is full of revelers popping the said corks. The restaurants are busy, so it would be best to make a reservation to ensure you can get a table, and many of the bars and clubs are ticket-only, make sure you've planned ahead.





No matter where you go in the world, summer conjures up family outings, making s'mores by an open campfire, sipping a glass of sangria in the sunshine or swimming at the lake, beach or pool. These months are special no matter where you travel – even if your chosen destination is more well–known for its winter activities. Summertime always has magical moments in store – festivals, events, celebrations. So, put on your Chanel bucket hat and your Fendi aviator shades and truly enjoy those fleeting summer months.



MOUNTAIN BIKING

Each year Verbier metamorphoses from a winter wonderland to a majestic technicolor paysage brimming with *Sound of Music* splendor. Just the same, world-renowned ski runs thaw to become the world's leading biking tracks, riddled with noble alpine wildlife from marmots to the local chamois. From June to September, the valleys' robust network of cable cars navigates to more tracks than one may ever hope to explore in a single holiday. The sheer breadth of routes accommodates all skill levels, while Verbier's gorgeous slopes and dramatic drops have made it a particularly beloved destination for the intermediate and professional mountain biker.





Verbier's two world famed golf courses, Les Esserts and Moulins, enjoy impeccable reputations. A mile-high above, along the green of Les Esserts, each stroke is rewarded with stunning views of the surrounding mountain ranges spanning Combin, Rogneux, and Mont Blanc. Take in the lush flora and technicolor vegetation invigorated by the crisp Alpine air as you navigate this challenging 18-hole facility. Down in the resort Village center, there are plenty of opportunities to practice your short game along the Les Moulins pitch-and-putt course.




HIKING TOURS

Hidden beneath a pristine layer of fresh snow lies a dizzying network of signed trails and footpaths spanning nearly 5,000 miles. Just as much a skiing destination as it is a hiking destination, Verbier's enchanting landscapes and natural bounties are best enjoyed on two feet. Navigate past rolling hills and fragrant larch forests and divulge in far-reaching vistas loaded with the sensation of thrill and discovery. Close encounters with noble Alpine wildlife from wild ibex and marmots push the bounds of reality, leaving adventurers with a profound appreciation for the region's sublime beauty. From the epic marathon of the Sentier des Chamois trail to the family-friendly Lac de Tseuzier route, Verbier's hiking options are left virtually inexhaustible.



HORSEBACK RIDING

Little else comes close to the romance of an equine outing. Let the mesmerizing syncopation of horse, donkey, or pony hooves be your vehicle for soaking in the pastoral beauty of the alpine countryside. Soak up spellbinding vistas and technicolor hues plucked from the *Sound of Music* accompanied by a noble steed. If a relaxing escapade doesn't satiate your craving, Val de Bagnes delivers fantastic packages that bring guests closer to your stallion, from dressage to jumping lessons.




LA RESERVE DE HAUT VAL DE BAGNE

A region of breathtaking natural beauty, the picture-perfect Upper Val de Bagnes villages are a must-see, offering an unmatched portal into the storybook enchantment of rural French-speaking Switzerland. Hike along the Dranse de Bagnes and discover time-forgotten villages that dazzle with a refreshingly simple and authentic way of life. This corner of paradise traverses the quaint settlements of Lourtier, Fionnay, Sarraeyer, and Bonatchiesse, not least known for their fantastic culinary offerings. A preserved natural landscape containing several nationally protected areas, the Haut Val de Bagnes is home to some exceptional alpine flora and numerous animal species.



VIA FERRATA AT MAUVOISIN GORGE

Get up and close with some of the Alps' foremost natural wonders, and take the Via Ferrata to the dramatic Mauvoisin Gorge. Halfway between hiking and climbing, the Via Ferrata allows guests to adapt to an exciting and ever-changing topography that will have adrenaline pumping through veins. A ner half mile course navigates across a succession of monkey bridges, foot baths, and ladders over the trickling Alpine waters of the river Dranse. As rewarding as it is exhilarating, the Via Ferrata is a must-experience Verbier summer adventure.





Verbier has plenty of exciting rock climbing routes. Some of them are perfect for beginners whereas others will challenge even the best climbers! It is the perfect opportunity to discover the wilderness in the Bas-Valais area. If you are already an experienced climber you will be able to tackle the mountain side rock and enjoy stunning views. Some of the best and loveliest rock climbing spots in the area of Verbier include La Pierre Avoi, Chemin and Orny.



TRAIL RUNNING

While Verbier is best known for its skiing, in the summer, you'll find over 500 kilometers of signposted trails across Verbier heights and Val de Bagnes. These hundreds of kilometers of trails can be combined into a never-ending array of trail running adventures. If you're looking for a loop run with world-class views, you can't go wrong with the Verbier Crest Loop. This loop run from downtown Verbier passes thundering waterfalls, climbs mountain peaks, and runs along the shores of pristine alpine lakes, in addition to miles and miles of high-alpine singletrack! Fresh air, breathtaking views and alpine trails all come together to push you to your limits. All routes are created by trail experts and open to everyone willing to have a go.





Stand-up paddle boarding (SUP) has become the fastest growing watersport in the world, including the mountain lakes of Verbier. It can be a fantastic full body core workout, or a leisurely way to explore, they provide a whole new way to experience the water in the outdoors. Paddle board hire and lessons can be arranged in Champex-Lac, a short drive from Verbier.




E BIKES



PIERRE AVOI

The majestic Pierre Avoi mountain, emblematic of Verbier, overlooks the Rhone valley and is well known amongst local climbers and hikers. While the vertiginous north-west face offers a range of climbing routes of various levels of difficulty, the east face is easily accessible from above Verbier. This mountain is a popular hiking destination. A short hike from Savoleyres will take you to the foot of the final, rocky ascent to the top, which is climbed using ladders and chains. The view from the top is spectacular and bear in mind that if you climb it in the evening, you will be rewarded by a breathtaking sunset.



BERRYLAND | SAINT BERNARD DOGS MUSEUM AND THE BEERY FOUNDATION

The St. Bernard museum "Musée et Chiens du Saint Bernard" was founded in 2006 by the Bernard and Caroline de Watteville foundation. The special attractions here are, of course, the world-famous St. Bernard hospice dogs. The ground floor houses the kennels and space where the dogs rest Kennels are connected to an outdoor enclosure, allowing the dogs to play freely while keenly observed. You can learn all about this breed's role in saving lives after avalanches and stroke these admirable four-legged friends or watch them as they run around the park premises. The most renowned of these St Bernards was a dog named Barry, who supposedly saved the lives of more than 40 people. The museum is part of The Beery Foundation which oversees the largest and oldest breeding program of the famous St Bernard dogs since its creation in 2005, with about 20 puppies born each year at the kennel.




TOUR VAL DE BAGNES

Arrange for an exotic car through LVH to drive from Le Chable to Val de Bagnes on a road lined with stunning little hamlets. Val de Bagnes villages are a favorite destination for nature lovers and those searching for simplicity and authenticity. Travelers will come across villages with melodic names. Bagnes patois is still spoken here in some traditional homes. Lourtier, Fionnay, Sarreyer and Bonatchiesse, as well as being little corners of paradise, are perfect places where visitors can forget time and indulge in slow food. A preserved natural landscape containing several nationally protected areas, the Haut Val de Bagnes is home to some exceptional alpine flora and numerous animal species.



3D SCULPTURE PARK

In the heart of the Swiss Alps, the Verbier 3–D Foundation is a non-profit cultural organization dedicated to promoting contemporary art, environmentalism and education through its Artist Residency and Sculpture Park. Founded in 2010 by New York-based artist Madeleine Paternot and Verbier-based artist Kiki Thompson, the pioneering organization creates an experimental and educational Artist Residency and Sculpture Park at an altitude of 2,300 meters (7,546 feet), inspired by the stunning Alpine landscape of Verbier, Switzerland. Situated between Les Ruinettes and La Chaux the 3D sculpture park features sculptures from international and local artists who have each designed an art pisces adorn the mountain. The sculptures are scattered along a winding route that offers fantastic panoramic views over Verbier. The sculpture park is free to visit and starts at the bottom of La Chaux.




MOUNT GALE

The summit of Mont Gelé is famous for being the starting point of the itinerary runs marked on the official piste map (Itinerary runs are officially designated off-piste routes, marked on the piste map as yellow lines, a single line of yellow poles in the snow marks the direction of an itinerary route. Itineraries are bounded 20 meters on each side of the yellow poles. There are two itinerary runs, one run, "La Grande Journée" descends to Tortin on the opposite side of the mountain to the cable car, and another one in the direction of La Chaux and cabin Mont-Fort. Once there take time to appreciate the fantastic 360-degree view, as the Mont Gelé is the only place you can see the entire 4-Vallées ski area from one location.




MONT FORT AND SUNRISE HIKE

The highest peak in the 4 Valleys area, Mont Fort offers both ease of access and extraordinary beauty. Reaching Mont Fort, perched at an altitude of 3,300 meters, should be on your list of experiences while in Verbier and watching the sunrise should be higher on that list. A succession of cable cars and gondolas take you from La Tzoumaz, Verbier, or Nendaz to the Mont Fort. Enjoy the 360-degree panoramic view of the most beautiful peaks of the Alps (Matterhorn, Dent Blanche, Grand Combin, Mont-Blanc), for a magical, emotion-filled moment. From the summit, you can then hike or mountain bike, watch the sunrise, take part in a yoga session or enjoy a fondue. As of autumn 2020, Europe's highest zip line links Mont Fort to the Col des Gentianes is an absolute highlight.



MONT 4 ZIPLINE

The magnificent Mont 4 Zipline starts at 3,330m above sea level, making it the highest in the world and the longest in the Alps. The descent takes you from Mont Fort over the Tortin Glacier to Les Gentianes. The descent is 1.4 kilometers long and can reach speeds of more than 100 km/h. The meeting point is at restaurant Les Gentianes (zipline arrival platform) at the appointed time. The journey to the starting point takes place by chairlift/gondolas and two cable cars. It is important to be in Siviez or Verbier with the confirmation or key card one hour beforehand. This activity is only open to persons over seven years (minimum weight 30 kilograms, maximum weight 130 kilograms).



HAUT VAL DE BAGNES NATURE RESERVE

Created in 1968, Switzerland's second-largest nature reserve is in Verbier's boundaries, and the summer months are the time to enjoy it on foot. The reserve boasts a classic alpine landscape of bare peaks, lakes, lush pastures, and hundreds of kilometers of hiking trails. To glimpse alpine wildlife take the six-hour Chamois Trail, which wends through the reserve. As the name tells you, if you go quietly you'll have a good chance of spotting chamois picking their way along the rocks, while ibexes and marmots also inhabit the environment and are regularly sighted from the trail.



CORBASSIERE GLACIER

To visit this most impressive glacier, take an extensive hike from the Brunet hut over the Col des Avouillons to the Pannossière hut. The crossing over the Corbassière Glacier is marked but requires good hiking boots. Stop off at Cabane Panossiere to admire the panoramic view and the Grand Combin. To learn a little about the region's history, visit the Musée des Glaciers in Lourtier, in Jean-Pierre Perraudin's old home. The latter, a keen observer, was the first to formulate the theory of the glaciers, sculptors of the valleys.





At a height of 820 feet, the Mauvoisin arch dam is an impressive structure. The dam and its power plants were built between 1959 and 1964. The dam facility has a maximum water level of about 6,480 feet above sea level and a usable storage capacity of 193 million meters squared of water. The dam is the 11th highest in the world and the sixth highest arch dam. Visits to the dam are available during weekdays.



PANORAMIC FLIGHT OVER 5 PEAKS

This panoramic flight over five peaks is a truly breathtaking experience, and well worth taking the time out from an afternoon skiing to witness some of the most staggering views across the Alps. The tour takes you over the domineering peaks of Mont-Blanc – Grande Jorasse – Grand Combin – Cervin/Matterhorn and Mont-Rosa mountains. Mont blanc, being the highest mountain in the alps, and 11th highest in the world, at 4,808.73 metres (15776.673228 feet); the Grand Combin at 4,314 metres (14153.5433 feet); the Grand Jorasses, a mountain in the mont black massif sits at 4,208 metres, and the Matterhorn at 4,478 metres (14691.601 feet), which is also most photographed mountain in the world. Have your cameras at the ready, and be prepared to be amazed by the views.



AERIAL WALKWAY




GETTING THERE

BY ROAD

The village of Verbier in the French-speaking western part of canton Valais, southwest Switzerland is:

- 170 kilometers east of Geneva (two-hour drive)
- One-hour drive from Chamonix ski resort in France
- One-hour drive from Aosta, ski resort and town in Italy

We recommend you take highways E62, E27 or A9 to get to Verbier. Take the Martigny exit and from there you stay on the canton and main streets to get straight to Verbier. It is only 25 kilometers from Martigny.



GETTING THERE

BY PRIVATE JET

Fly to Sion (the nearest private jet airport), and transfer to Le Chablé (near Verbier) by helicopter (20-minute flight) or by car (one hour). Located about 50 kilometers away, Sion Airport is the closest to Verbier but is very restrictive.


